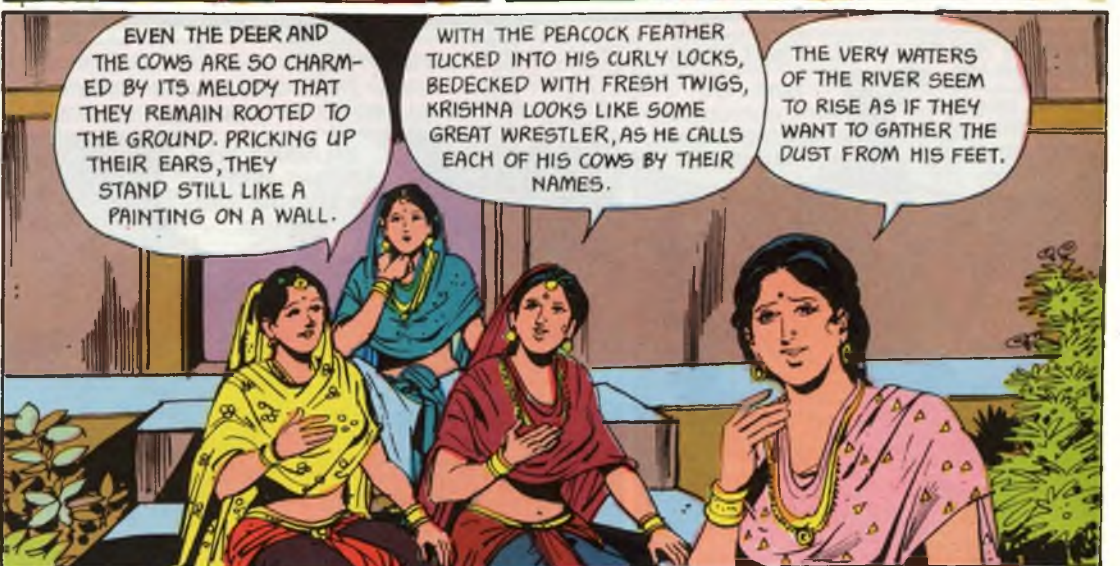


HOW SWEET ARE THE MELODIES, NANDA'S DARLING BOY PLAYS UPON HIS FLUTE.

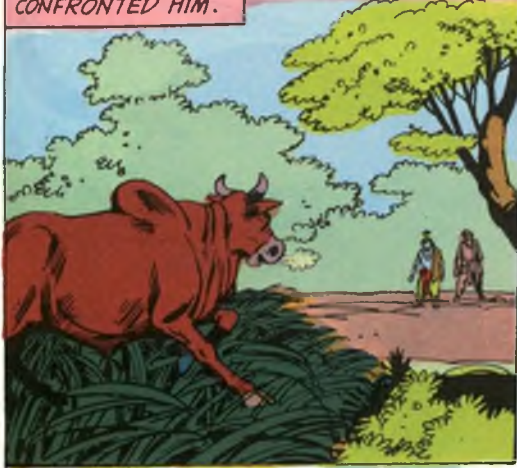

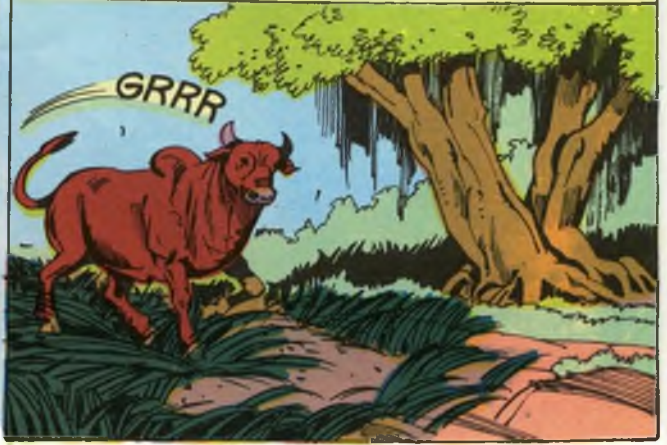
THE VERY WATERS OF THE RIVER SEEM TO RISE AS IF THEY WANT TO GATHER THE DUST FROM HIS FEET.



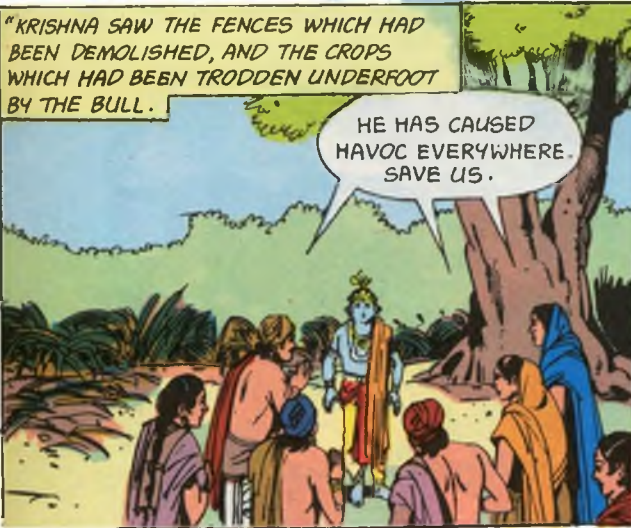

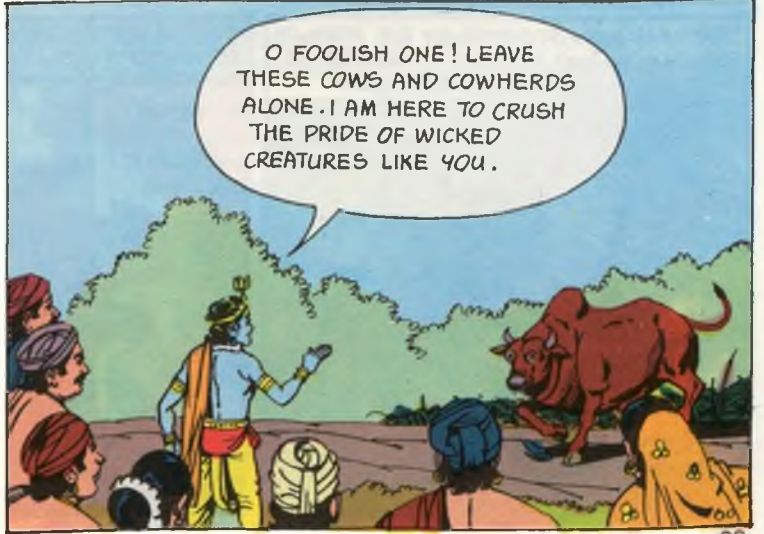

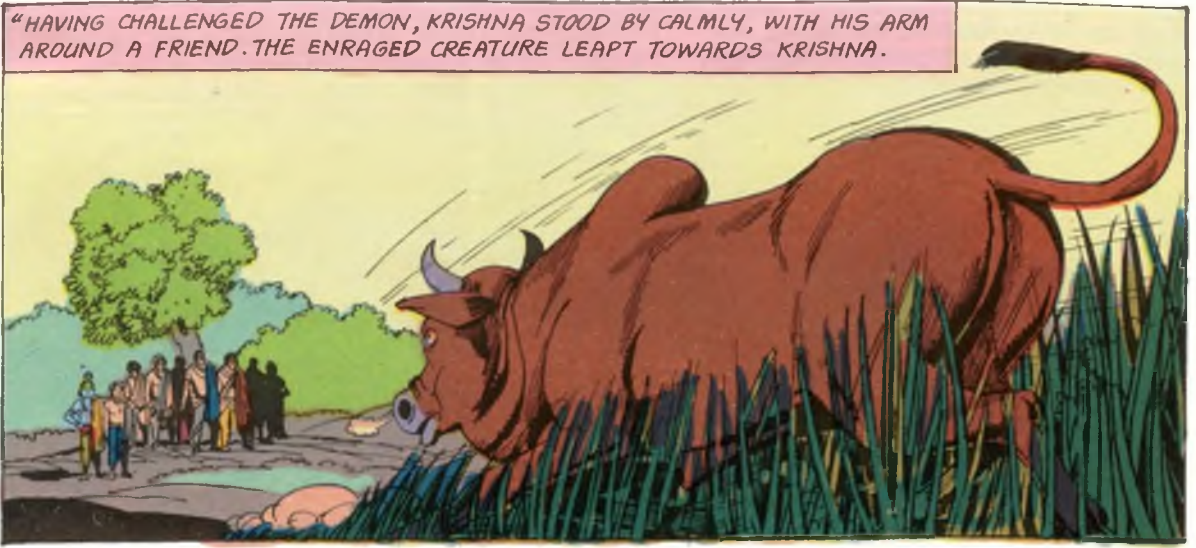


BE CALM. THERE IS NOTHING TO FEAR.

"HE THEN ADDRESSED THE KEEPER OF ELEPHANTS.

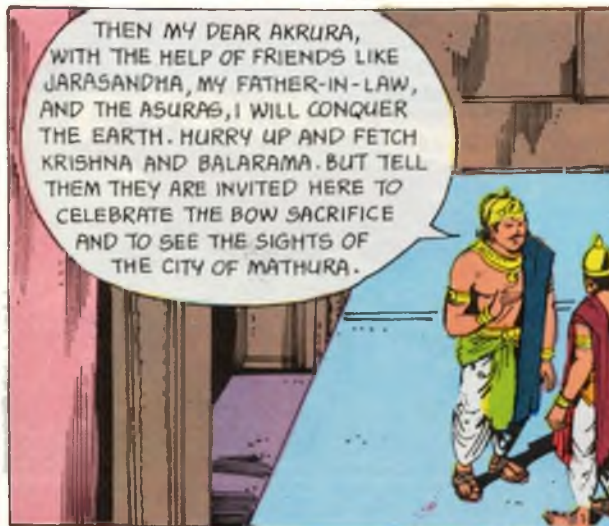
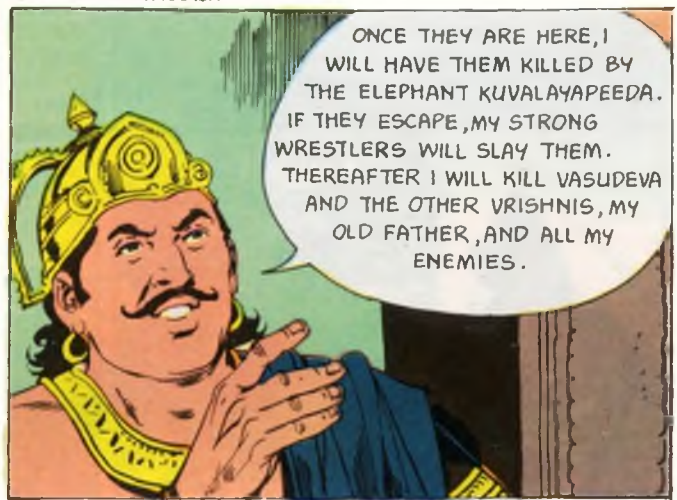


"THEN HE TURNED TO HIS MINISTERS.

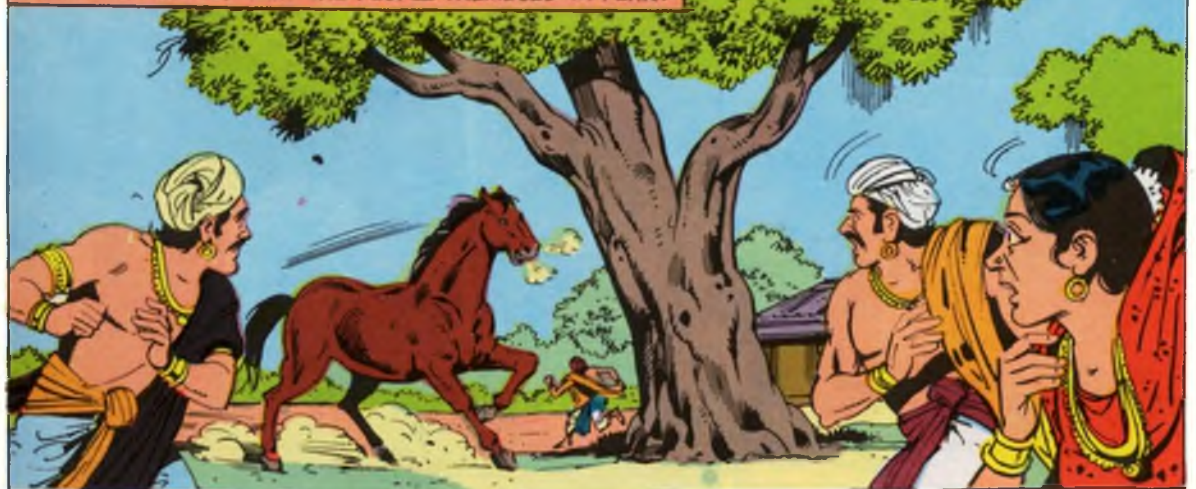


"THEN KAMSA SENT FOR AKRURA THE YADAVA, A KINSMAN OF KRISHNA.



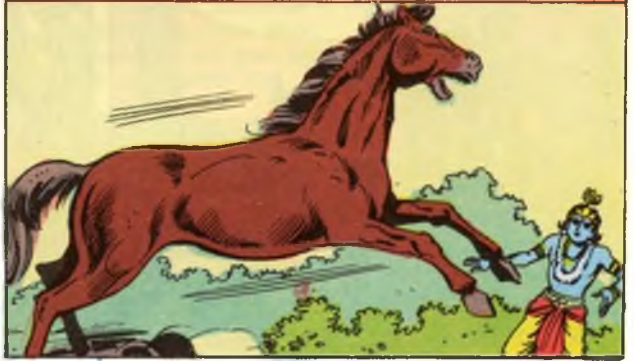

"MEANWHILE, AKRURA TOO HAD STARTED FOR VRAJA."

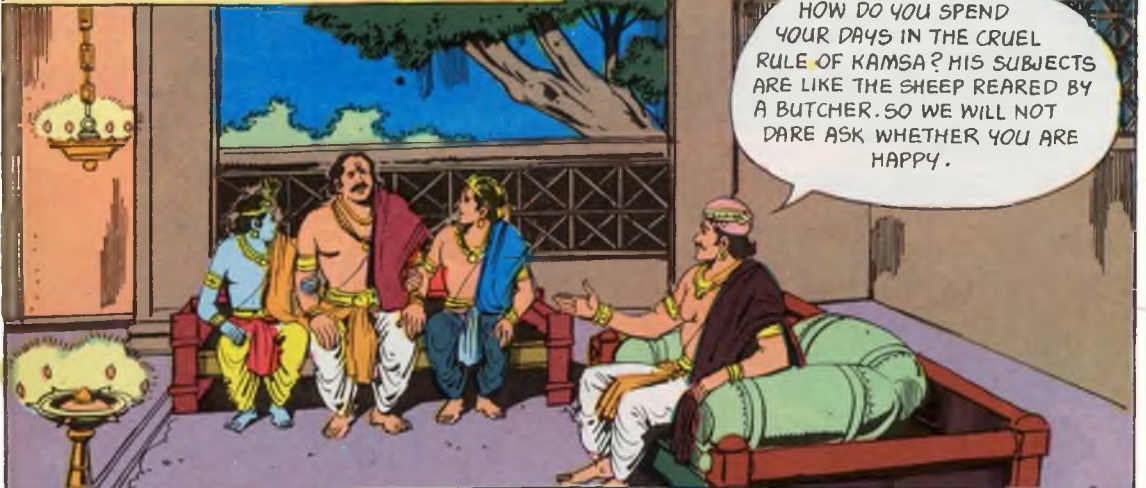

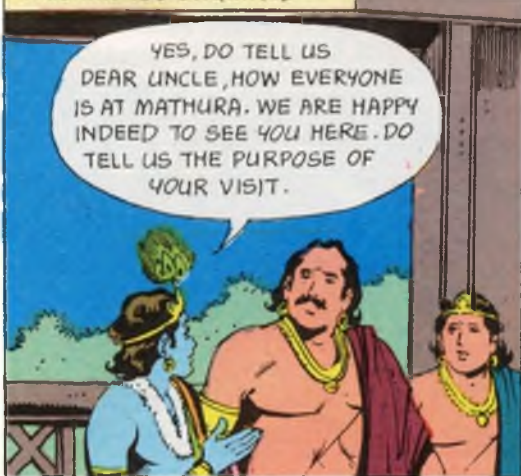

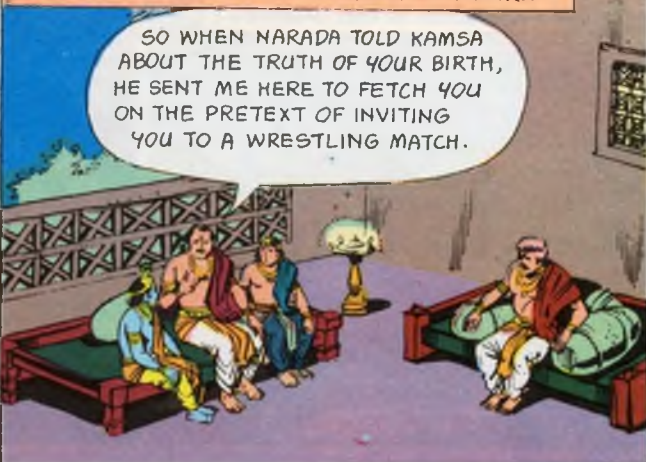

"AKRURA WAS OVERWHELMED AT THE SIGHT, AND RESPECTFULLY BOWED BEFORE THEM."

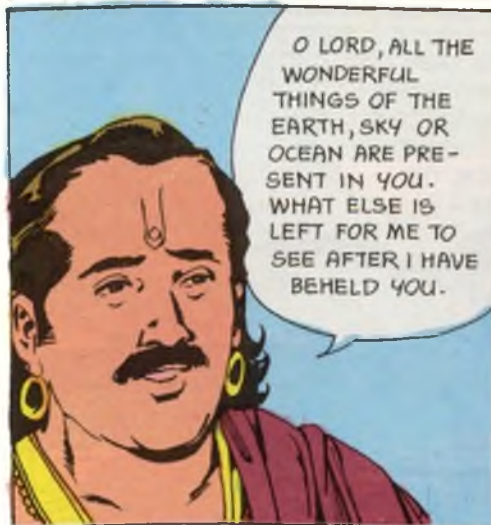

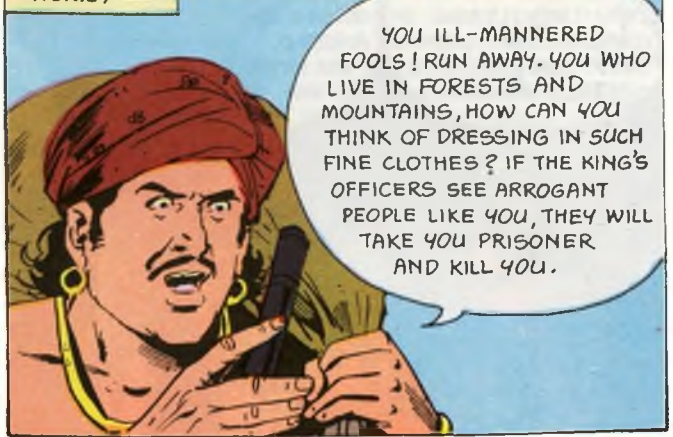
"JUST THEN, KRISHNA SAW A WASHERMAN PASS BY.

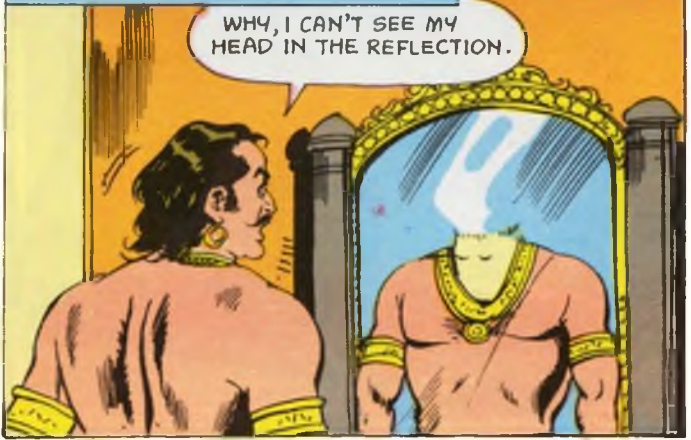

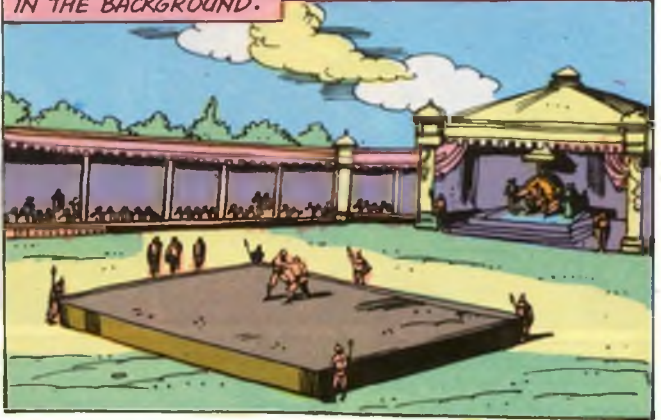
WHY, I CAN'T SEE MY HEAD IN THE REFLECTION.

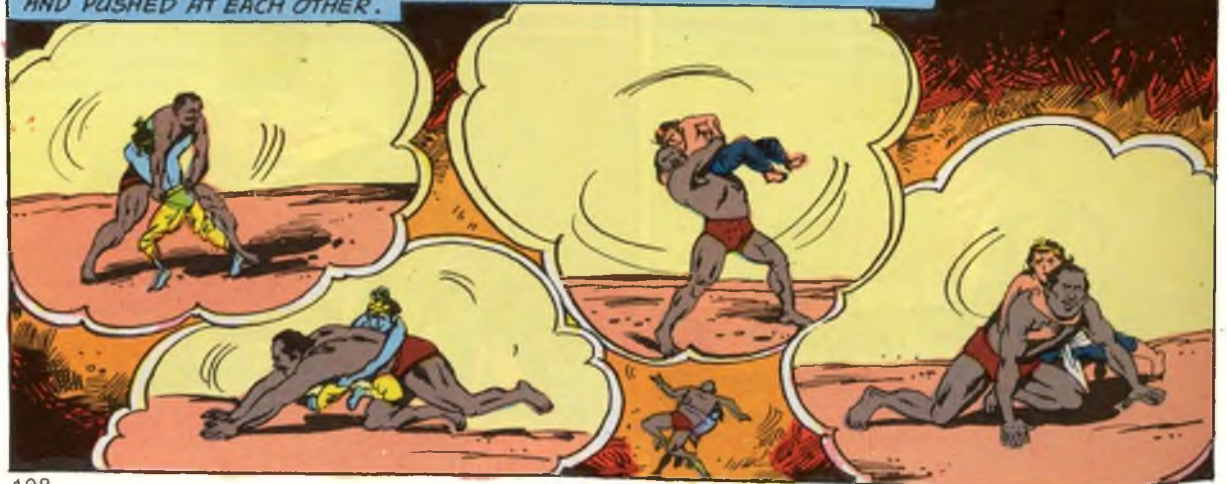
"ADDRESSING KRISHNA AND BALARAMA, CHANURA, THE ACE WRESTLER, SAID —

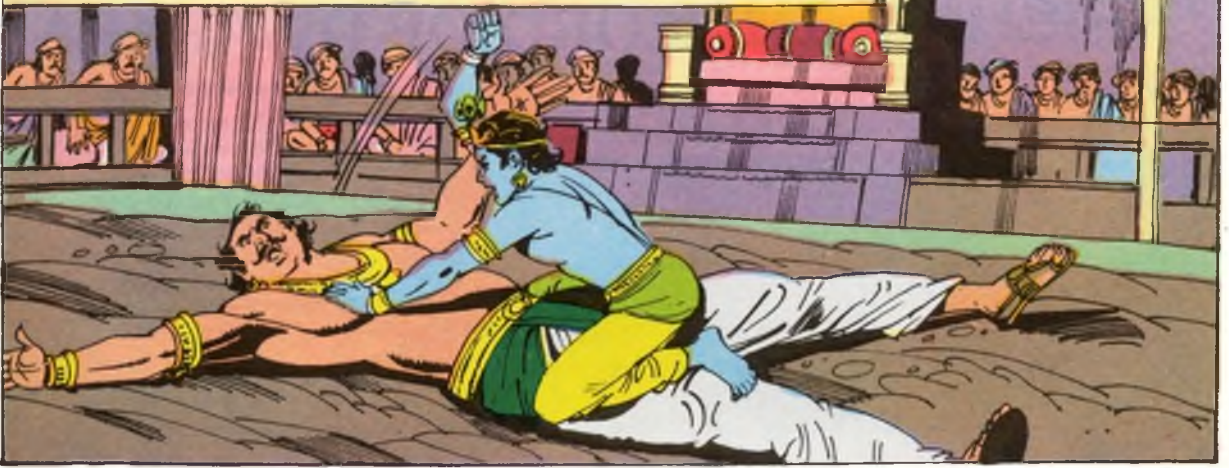

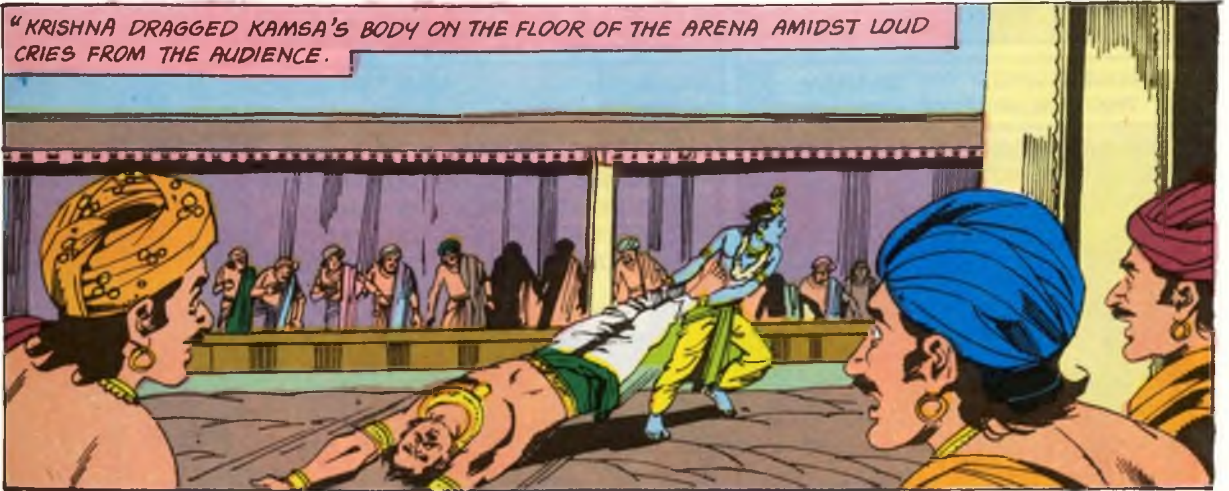

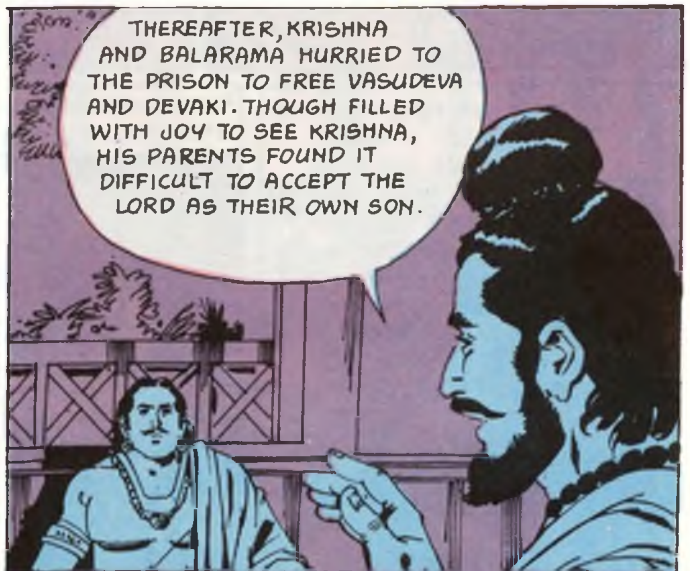
