
“Dear Mother Devaki, within your womb is the Supreme Personality of Godhead.”




The great sage Narada Muni sings "Radhika-ramana-namine."



“Please hide this four-armed form which holds the four symbols of Visnu.”




The night was very dark, but Vasudeva could see everything just as in the sunlight.



Vasudeva silently entered the house and exchanged his son for the girl.




Lord Krsna played on the lap of Yasoda just like an ordinary child.




No one knew the reason the cart had fallen.




“All day, They simply make arrangements to steal our butter and yogurt.”




When He was caught, Krsna started to cry.



Krsna played on His flute while bringing the cows to the forests of Vrndavana.




Krsna had to plan how to stop the destruction of His intimate friends.




Seeing Krsna enjoying with His cowherd friends, Lord Brahma decided to play a trick.




"I am offering my humble obeisances and prayers just to please You."



Krsna would praise them, "My dear friends you are dancing and singing very nicely."




Garuda struck the body of Kaliya with his effulgent golden wings.




“We think that this apparent punishment to Kaliya is actually some benediction.”



Pralambasura looked just like a cloud with lightning carrying the moon.




After remaining in the water for a long time, the gopis felt cold and were shivering.




“My dear father, there is no need to worship the demigod Indra.”




The god of the waters was holding Nanda captive underneath the sea.
