meet her group of friends.




Vishakha, one of Radha's closest friends, accompanied Radha almost everywhere and was one of her favourite playmates.

Balaram is ever ready to face any challenge.




Watch Krishna's mystical smile! He spreads peace and joy across Vrindavan with his divine smile.

“Should I play my flute and get everybody here,” Krishna asks the bird.




