

Wearing on Their mother's sari and necklace Krishna and Balarama beg Maa




Seeing that Krishna has broken pots and stolen butter, Mother Yasoda binds Him with a rope around His waist and ties Him to a grinding mortar.

Mother Yasoda feeds Krishna while telling Him "My dear boy there is no










