- I b. Optional form of I a. In some cases of I, the first member of the compound minus its vertical stroke can optionally be placed above the second.

- II When the first member of a compound has no vertical stroke: First member above. Example: ত্য = জ্ব as in the word যন্ত্ৰা

- VII Special Abbreviations: \overline{X} as the second member of a compound is represented as the stroke \overline{Y} as in the word \overline{Y}

- V When elements of both are fused into a new character: Example: द्य = द्य as in the word विद्या
- VII Special Abbreviations: $\overline{\mathbf{X}}$ as the <u>second</u> member of a compound is represented as the stroke $\mathbf{Y} = \mathbf{Y}$ as in the word $\mathbf{Y} = \mathbf{Y}$
