






PURPORT:

Those who pretend to offer devotional service to the Lord while in their heart developing an urge for other motives, usually expose themselves without fail in front of real saintly persons and Vaishnavas. Whenever a person starts unexpectedly praising his own activities or makes an attempt to confirm his apparently good conduct just through criticizing others, it may be very rightly assumed that the person concerned has other motives in mind. Even if the entire population of critics criticized a real saintly person or if selfishly-motivated persons start blaspheming him, he never makes an attempt to vindicate himself. A truly devoted Vaishnava never make any protest against himself, but he never tolerates any criticism against other Vaishnavas or his spiritual master. It is believed that anyone who makes any attempt to vindicate himself must be factually a guilty person and otherwise motivated for name and fame in the general society.
