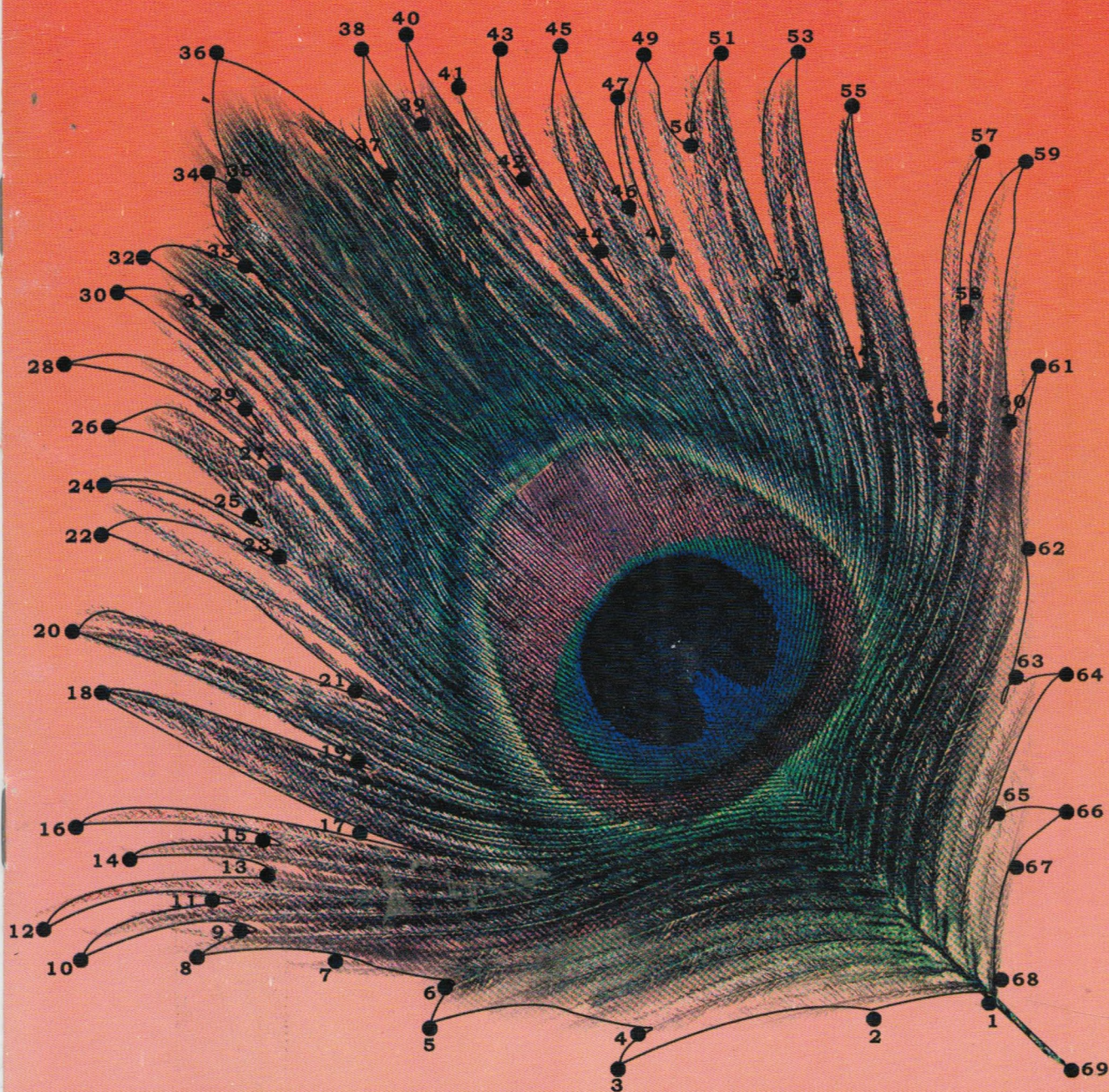

Our humble attempt is to promote India's ancient wisdom & Vedic Culture through Children's Art/Educational/Spiritual Books.

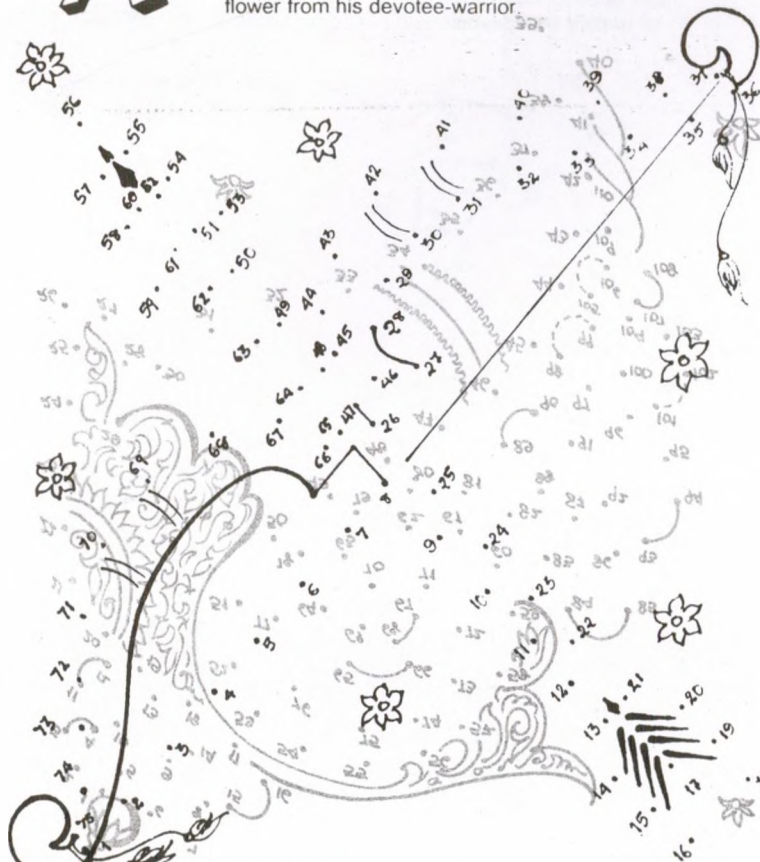

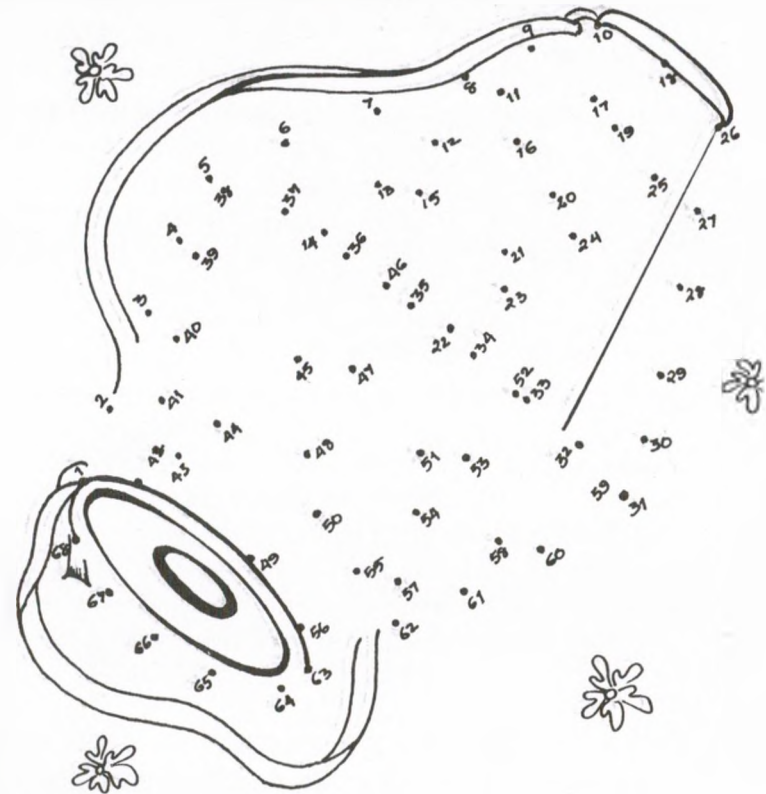
C=CONCH

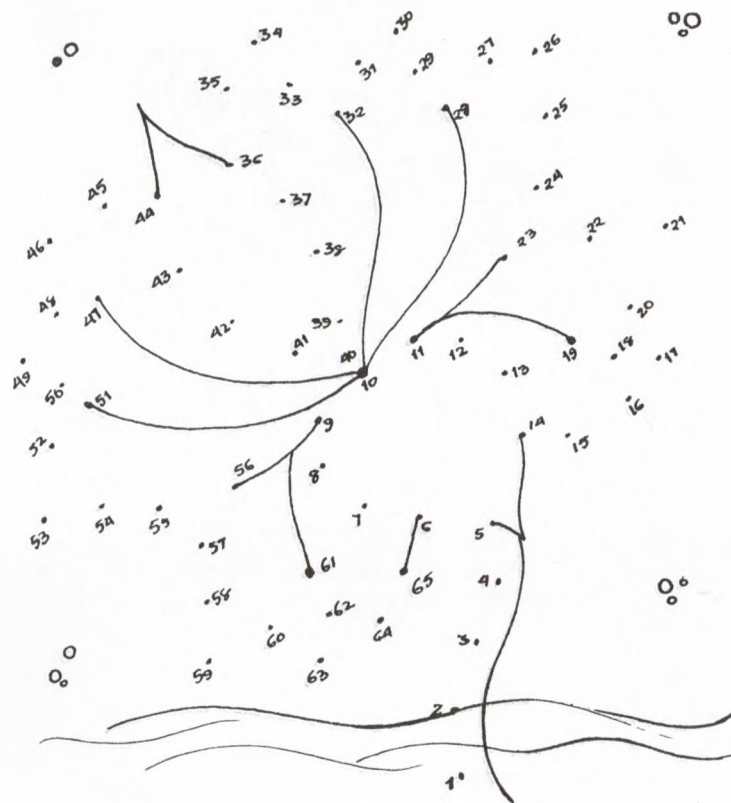
K=KRISHNA

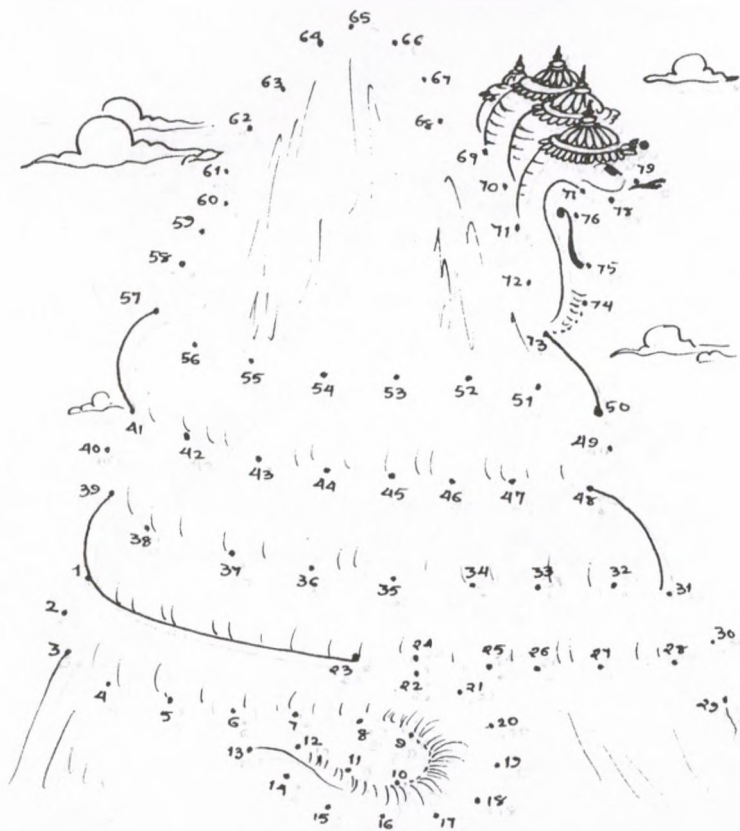

M=MOUNTAIN

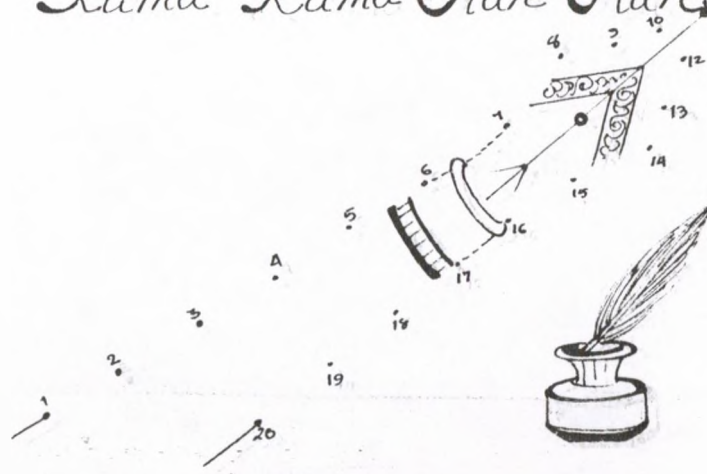

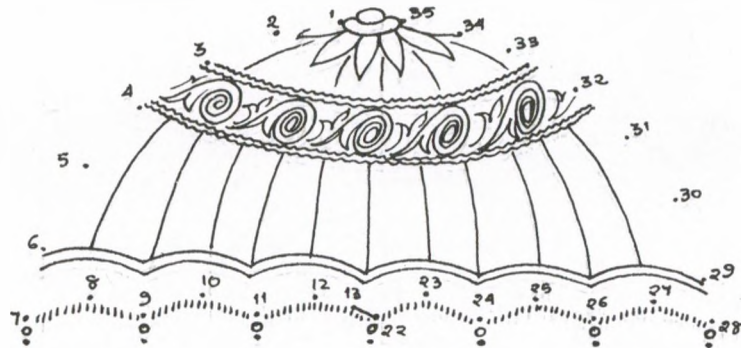
A Place of pilgrimage which is regularly visited by the devotees.

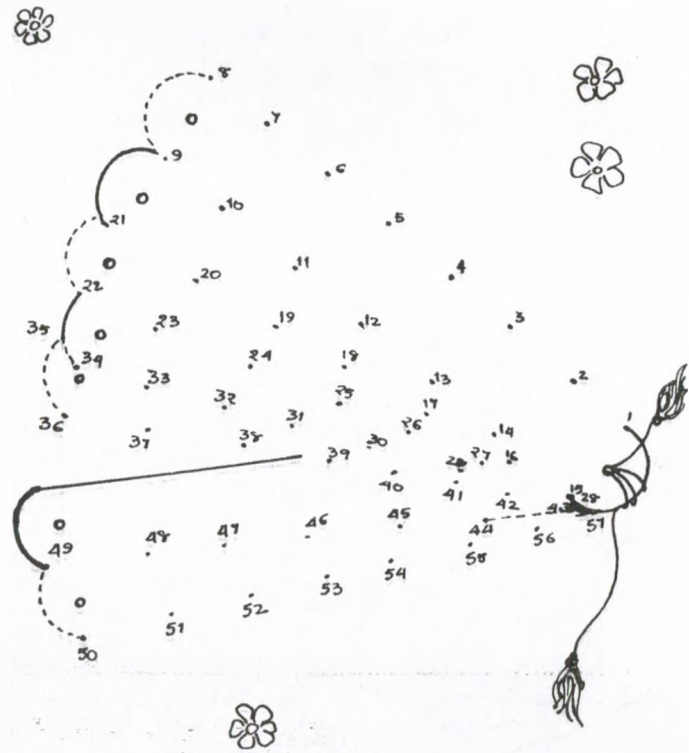

During the Vedic times, before advent of printing press, the Vedic Scripts (Vedas) were painstakingly hand-written on palm leaves and preserved in the temples.

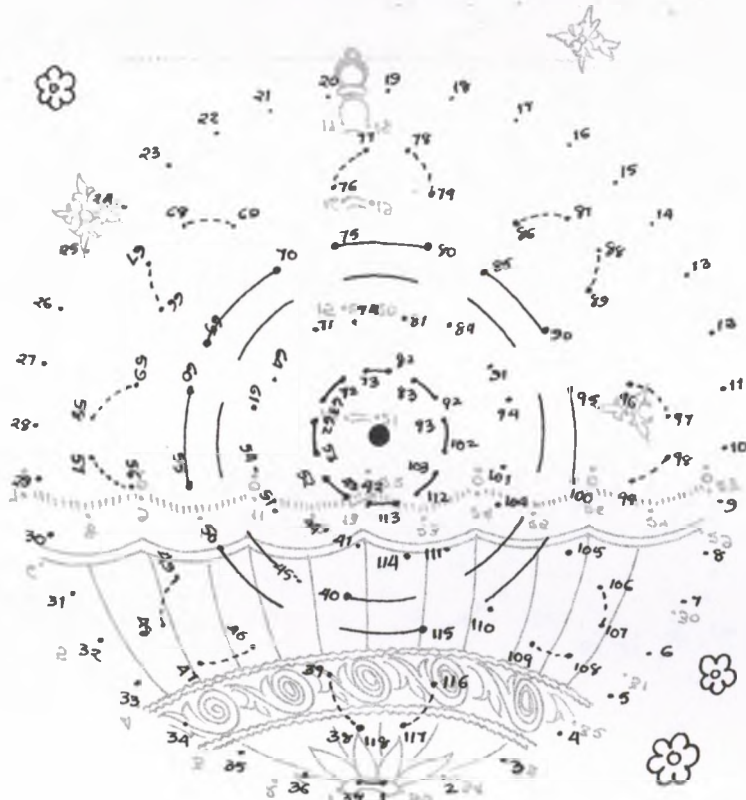

Wheel is the symbol of progress and movement. The traditional chariot-wheels were often used by the Kshatriyas in emergency as battle-weapons in the wars.



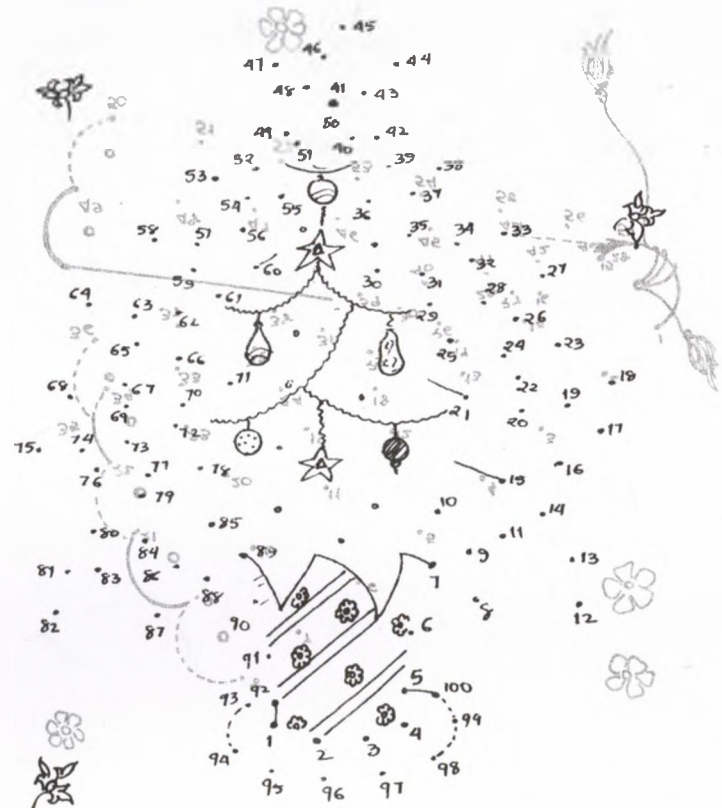
N=UMBRELLA

The birth day of Jesus Christ (who is regarded as a great Acharya) is marked by a holy plant called X-mas tree with nice illuminating decorations.

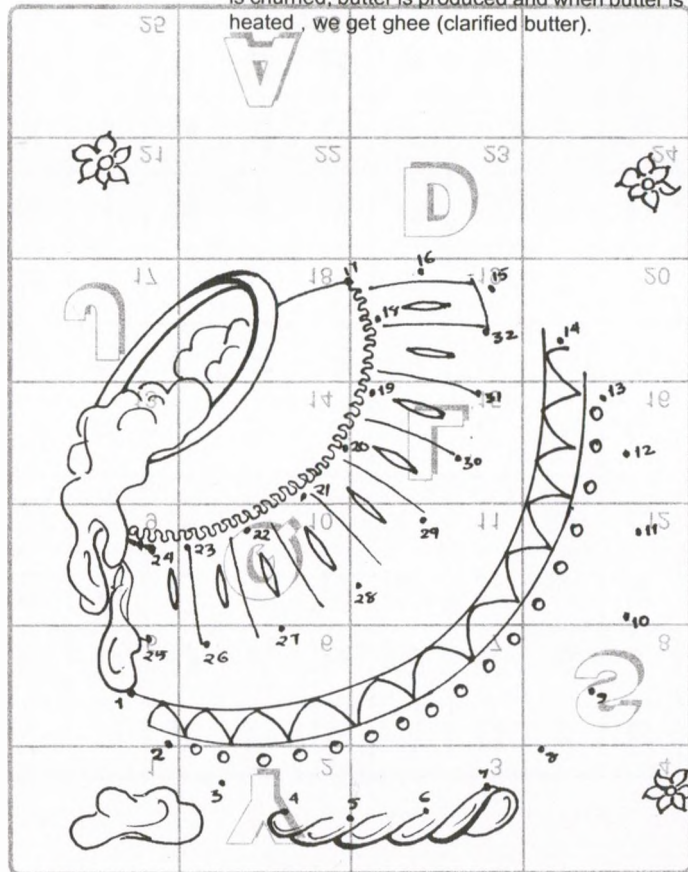


N=VEDAS (SCRIPTURES)

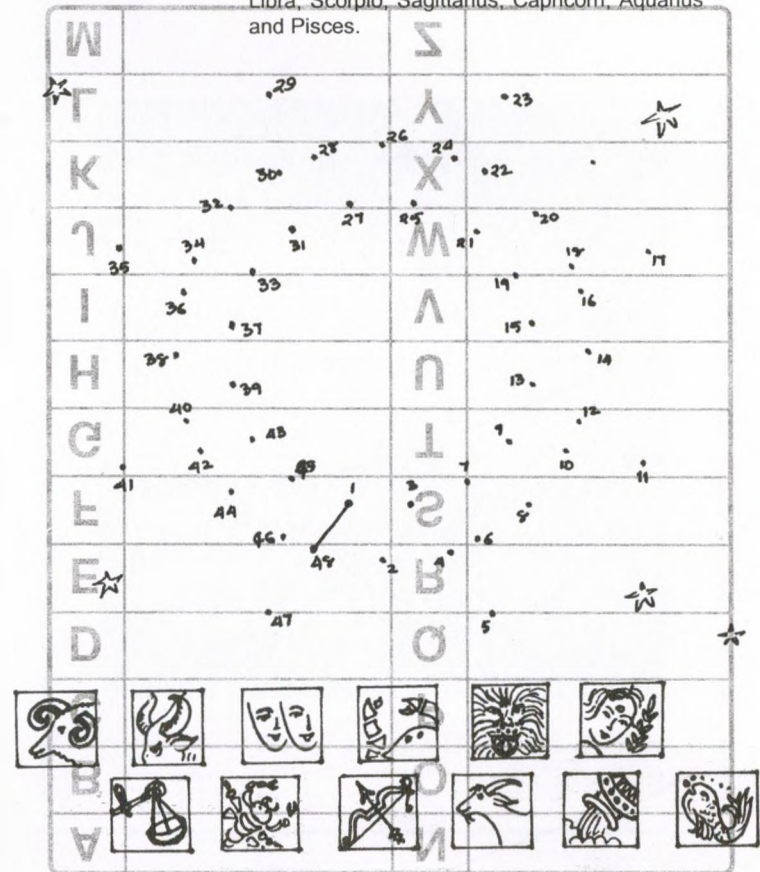
