NOTE: A devotee does not live on the material plane - he lives in Kṛṣṇa.

TEXT 9

p 622 - sadhana bhakti (see p 623, last para) is the purification of the senses

NOTE: When one serves Kṛṣṇa without any selfish motive, one has achieved perfection in spir. life relate to pleasing teacher

TEXT 10

p 624 - land, capital and labor required for both mundane business & service to Kṛṣṇa - difference is that one works for sense grat. or for satisfaction of Kṛṣṇa.

TEXT 11

Those who can't work for Kṛṣṇa can progress toward Kṛṣṇa consc. by performing altruistic service. By the practice of giving up fruits of one's actio.

one is sure to purify his mind gradually, and w. purified state of mind understand Kṛṣṇa consciousness.

TEXT 12 The indirect method for becoming K.L. involves renouncing fruits of one's activities... then the stage of knowledge, then meditation, then understanding the Supersoul and then SPoG.

TEXT 13-14 Discuss qualities of one dear to Kṛṣṇa and what a devotee does when someone treats him as an enemy or when he finds himself in difficulty. As soon as you become a devotee Kṛṣṇa takes care - otherwise, you're under care of māyā

TEXT 15-20

A devotee doesn't extraneously endeavor for these qualities; devot. service automatically helps him develop them

Dev. serv. is the only means of realizing K.
One may accept impersonal conception as long as one has not had opportunity to hear from a pure devotee.

TEXT 5

p. 617 - uncertainty in the ultimate result of realizing the Absolute Truth

p. 617 - long practice of impers. makes one more attached, even if contacting a devotee

mail box example

p. 617 - the blissful portion of his nature is not realized by impers.

TEXT 6-7

p. 619 - if he does not render service to the Lord, he will render service to Maya.

NOTE: (p. 619) It does not matter in what kind of work one engaged, but that work should be done only for Kṛṇā. That is the standard of dev. serv.

NOTE: The devotee does not desire any other achievement other than pleasing the S.P.O.G.

p. 619 bottom - The devotee doesn't need to wait to become very experienced like the yogis to transfer to the spir. sky - Kṛṇā takes him.

p. 620 - expert swimmer in ocean can't save himself

NOTE: Simply by chanting the holy name of ~~the~~ ^{Lord}
