(Even we had to refer back to the Bhagavad-gitā As It Is while proof-reading the Study Guide and we wrote the puzzles.) This book is a Study Guide and if used as a Study Guide it will fix the information in the Bhagavad-gitā As It Is firmly in your mind.

Puzzle 5 on page 6 has an incorrect diacritic for #33 Across. It should be a slash over the S rather than a dot under it. The dot under the S makes #29 Down correct. Please excuse this.
