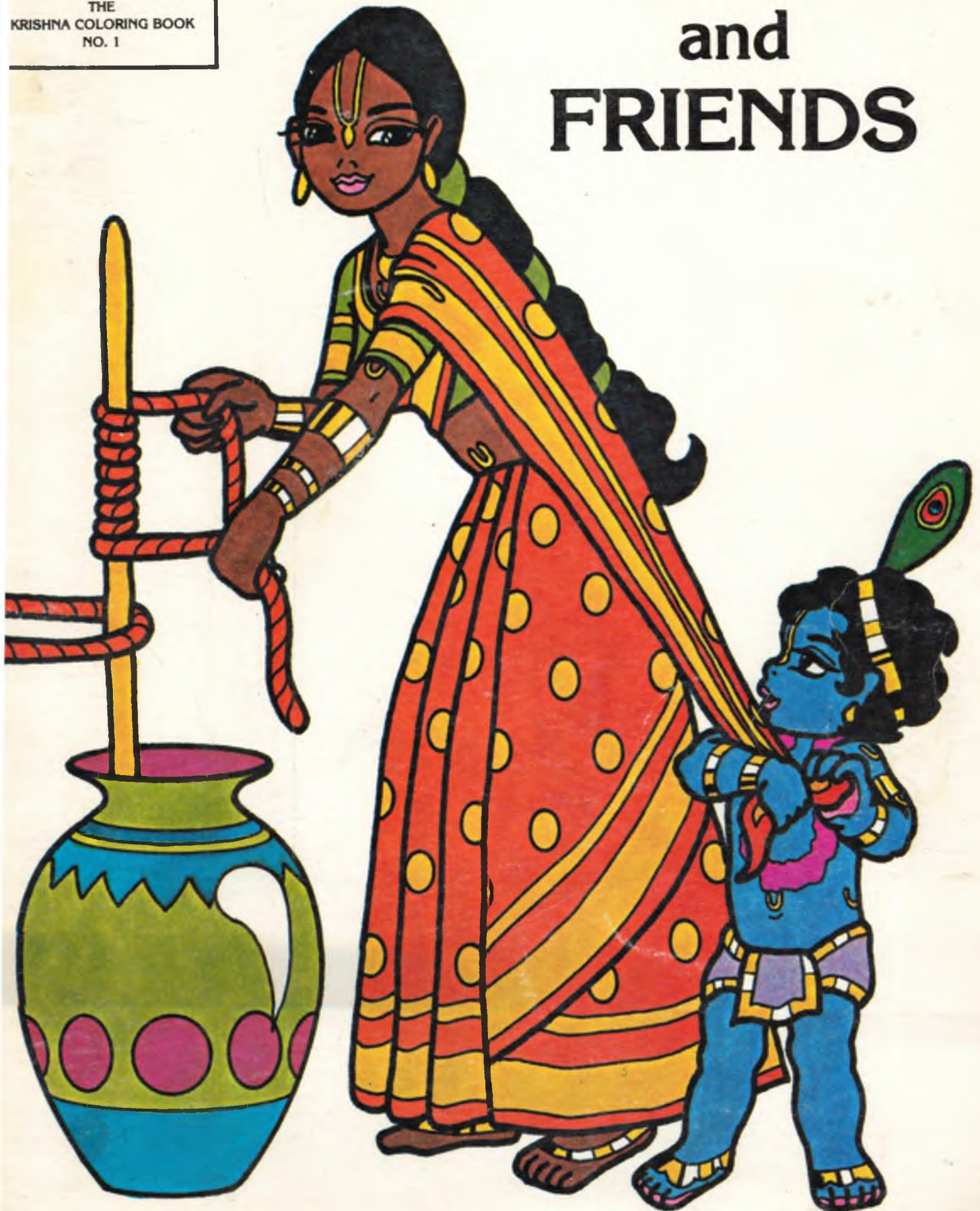

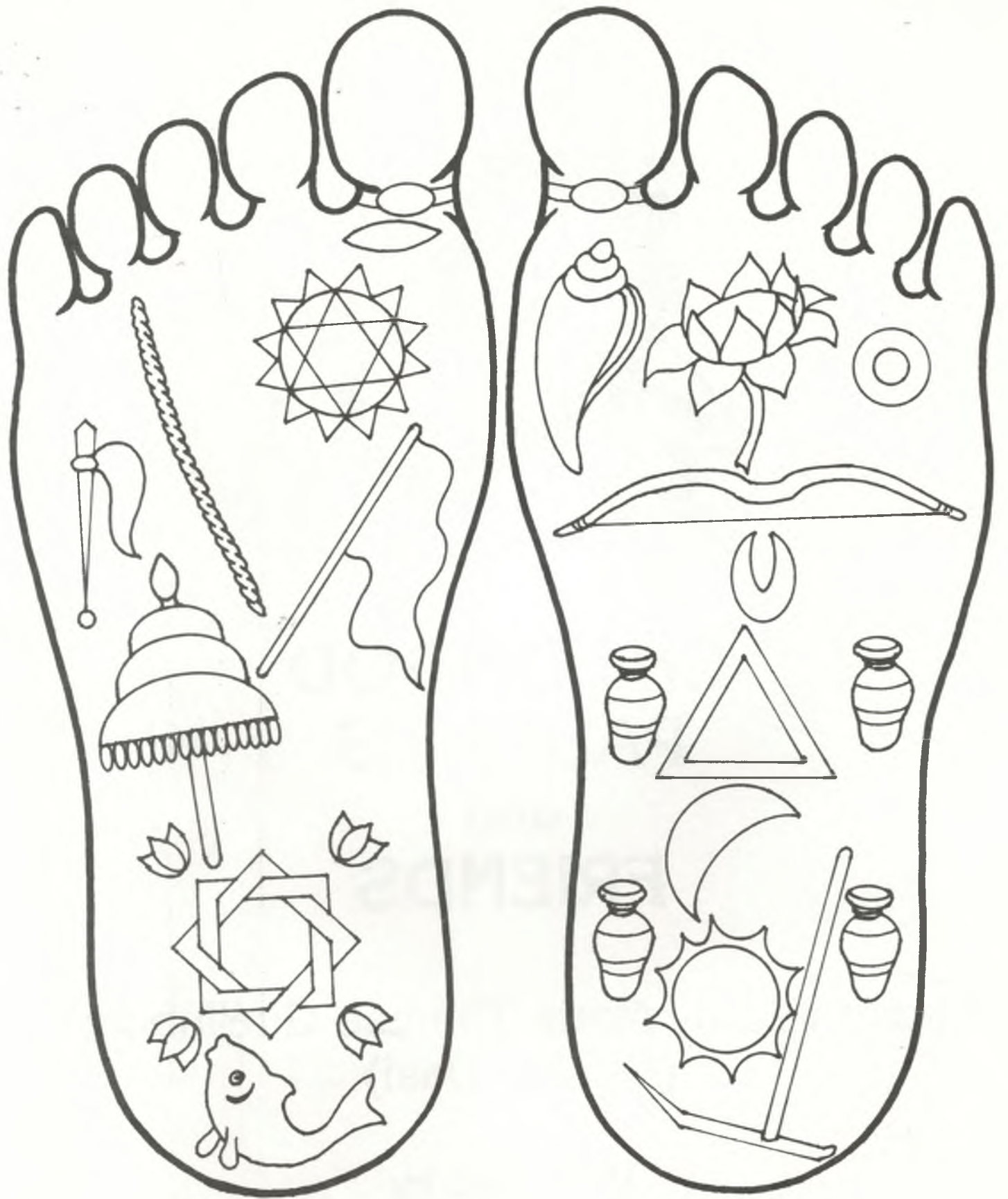

Mmmm! Krishna eats the butter



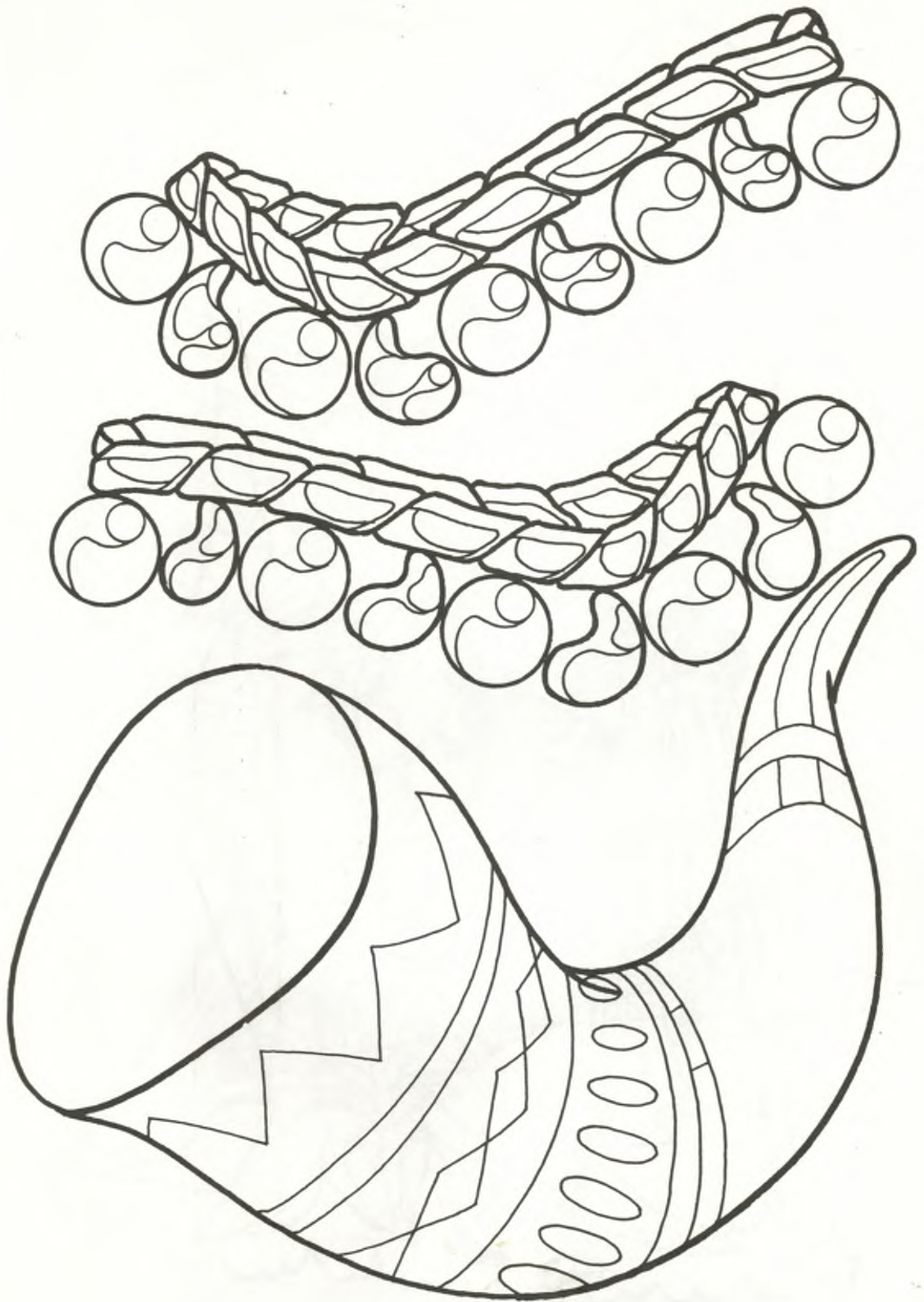
Krishna loves the cows.



The cows love Krishna.



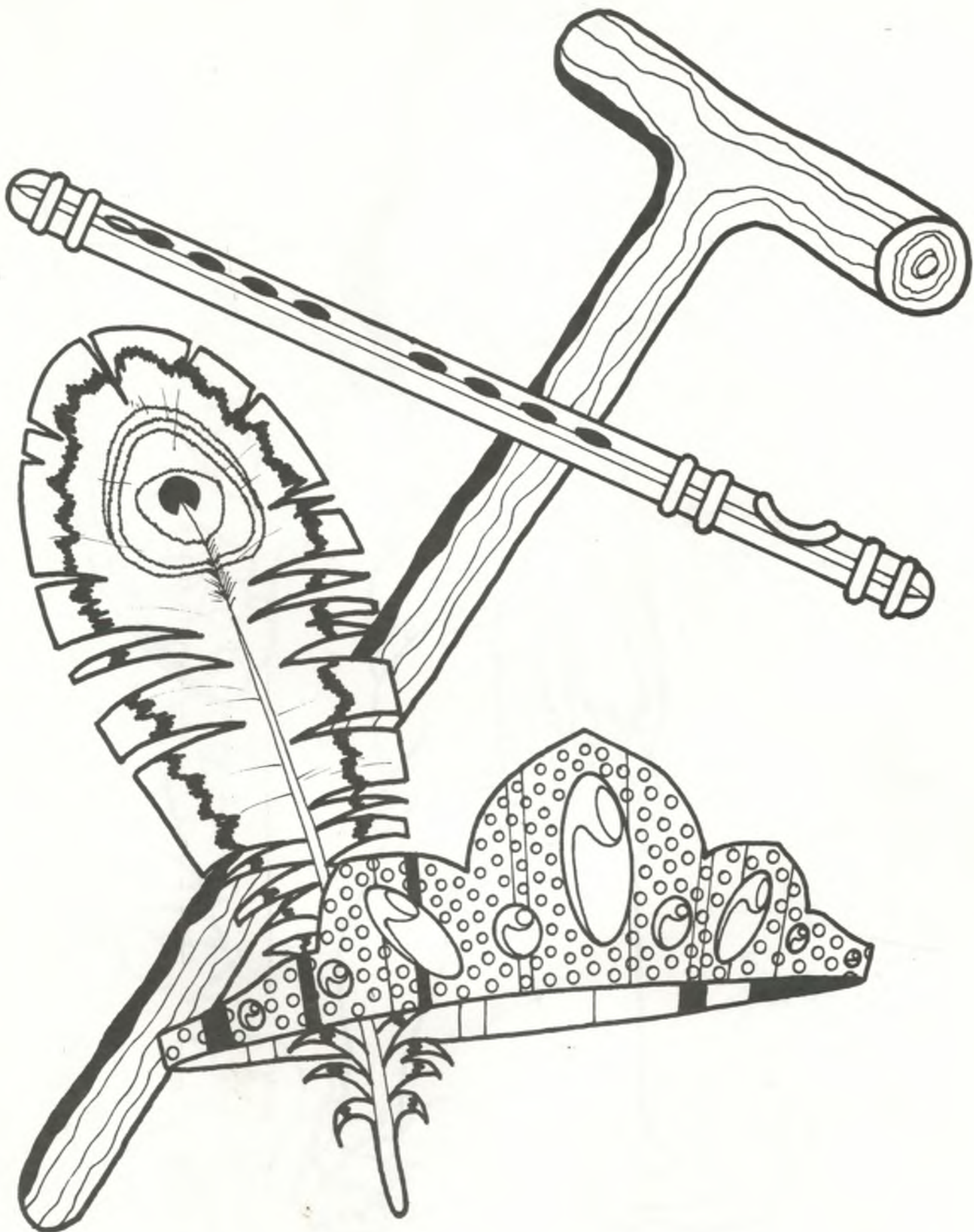
Krishna and Balaram jump high.



Krishna has ankle bells and a buffalo horn.



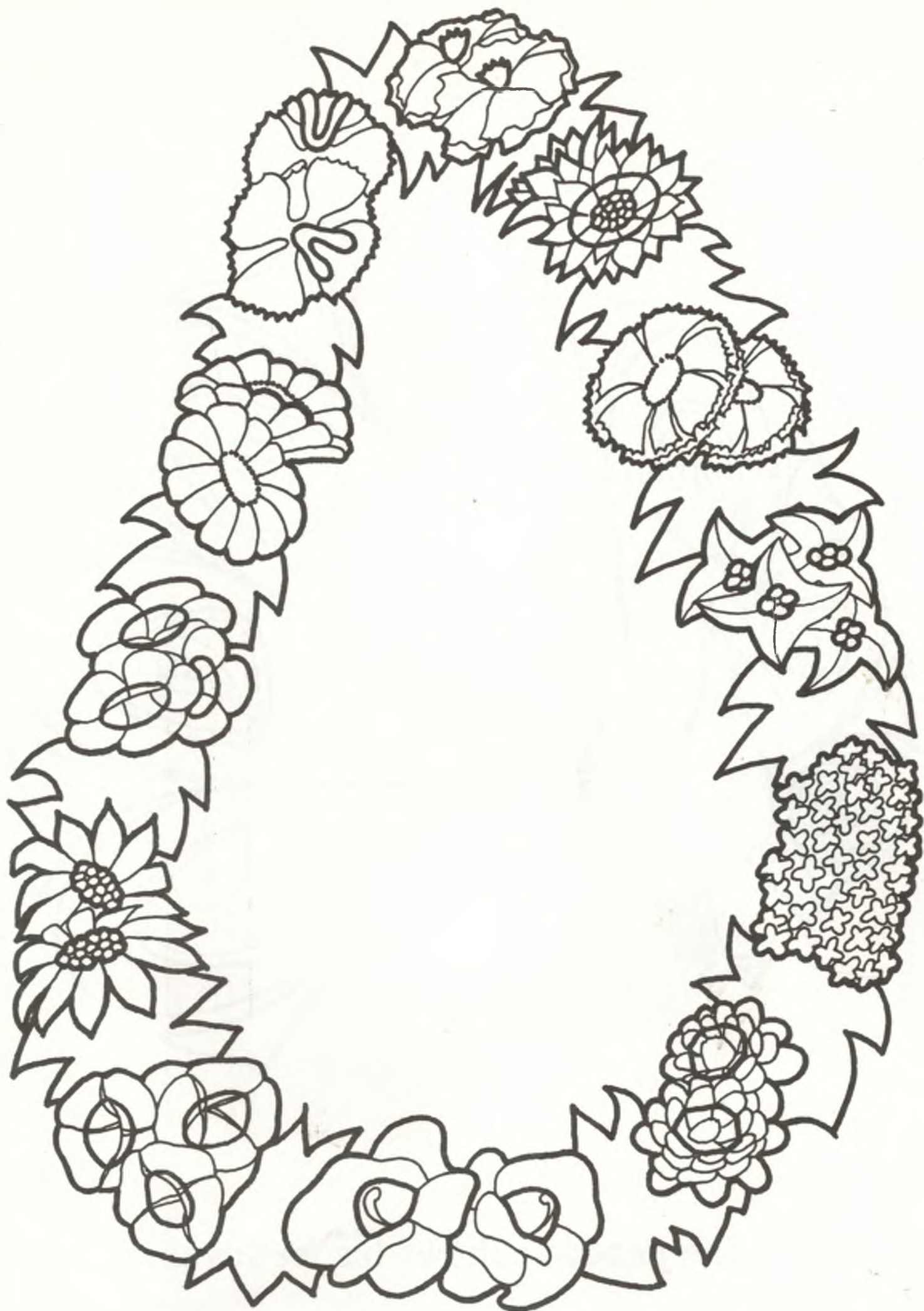
He wears a yellow cloth
