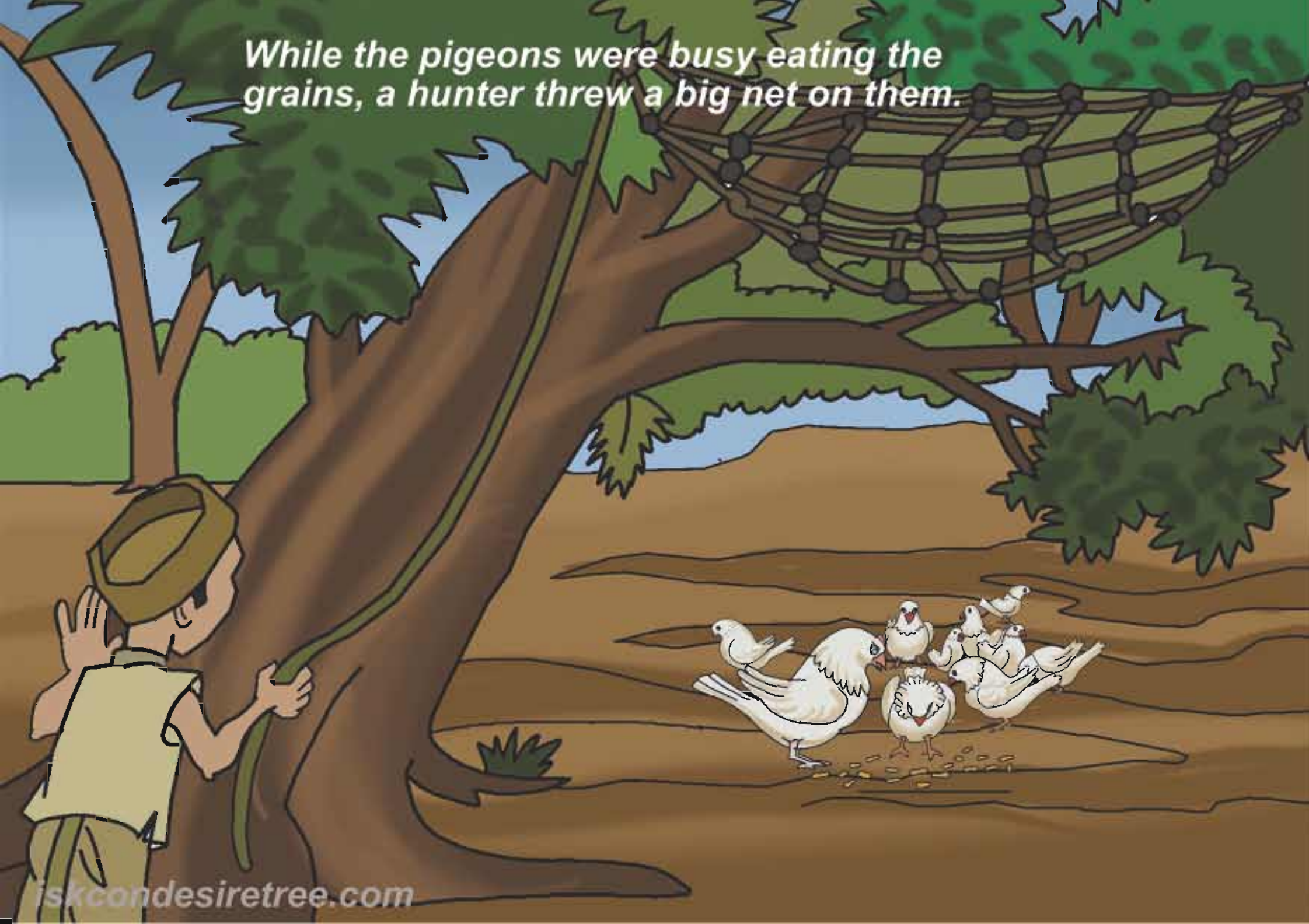
One day a group of pigeons were flying above a jungle in search of some food.



They saw grains on the ground and all of them came down and started eating the grains.




While the pigeons were busy eating the grains, a hunter threw a big net on them.



The pigeons were all caught up in the net.






What a great catch I have made, today is a lucky day. Since, I have been waiting for these pigeons. Let me take some rest and then I will take all these pigeons home.

On hearing the flapping sound of the pigeons, the hunter woke up and started running behind them but there was of no use to him.



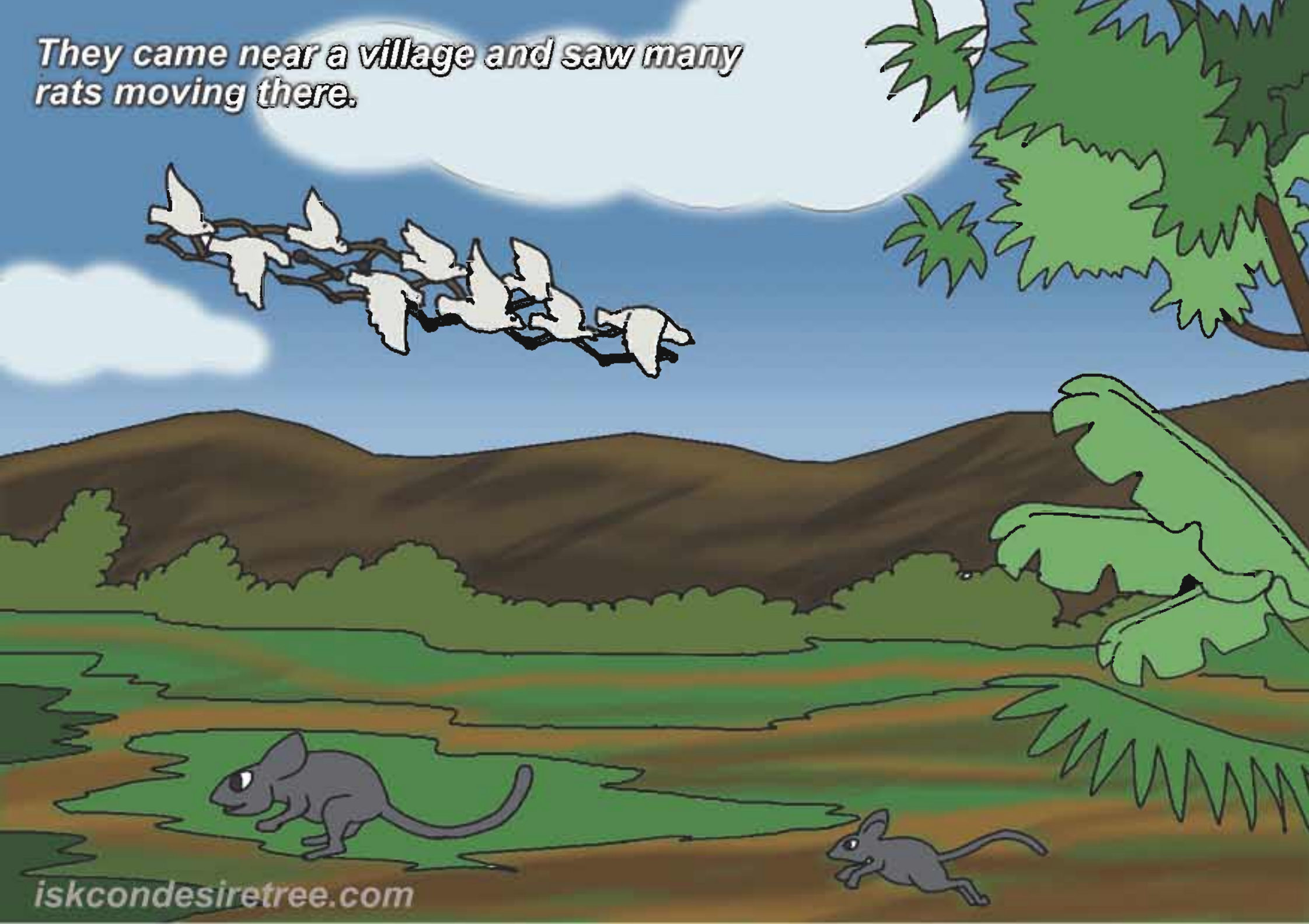



**Oh! The pigeons
