When Subhadra came in, as Arjuna's wife, Draupadi was jealous. But she controlled it under her regal bearing.

She knew that Keechaka was dead. But her live wrath would not be satisfied till she watched the corpse on its way to be burnt.


Draupadi was the total woman; complex and yet feminine.


