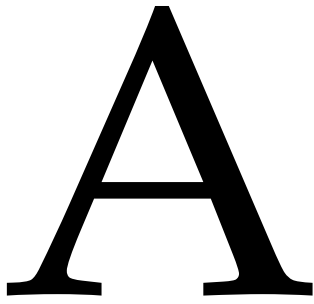
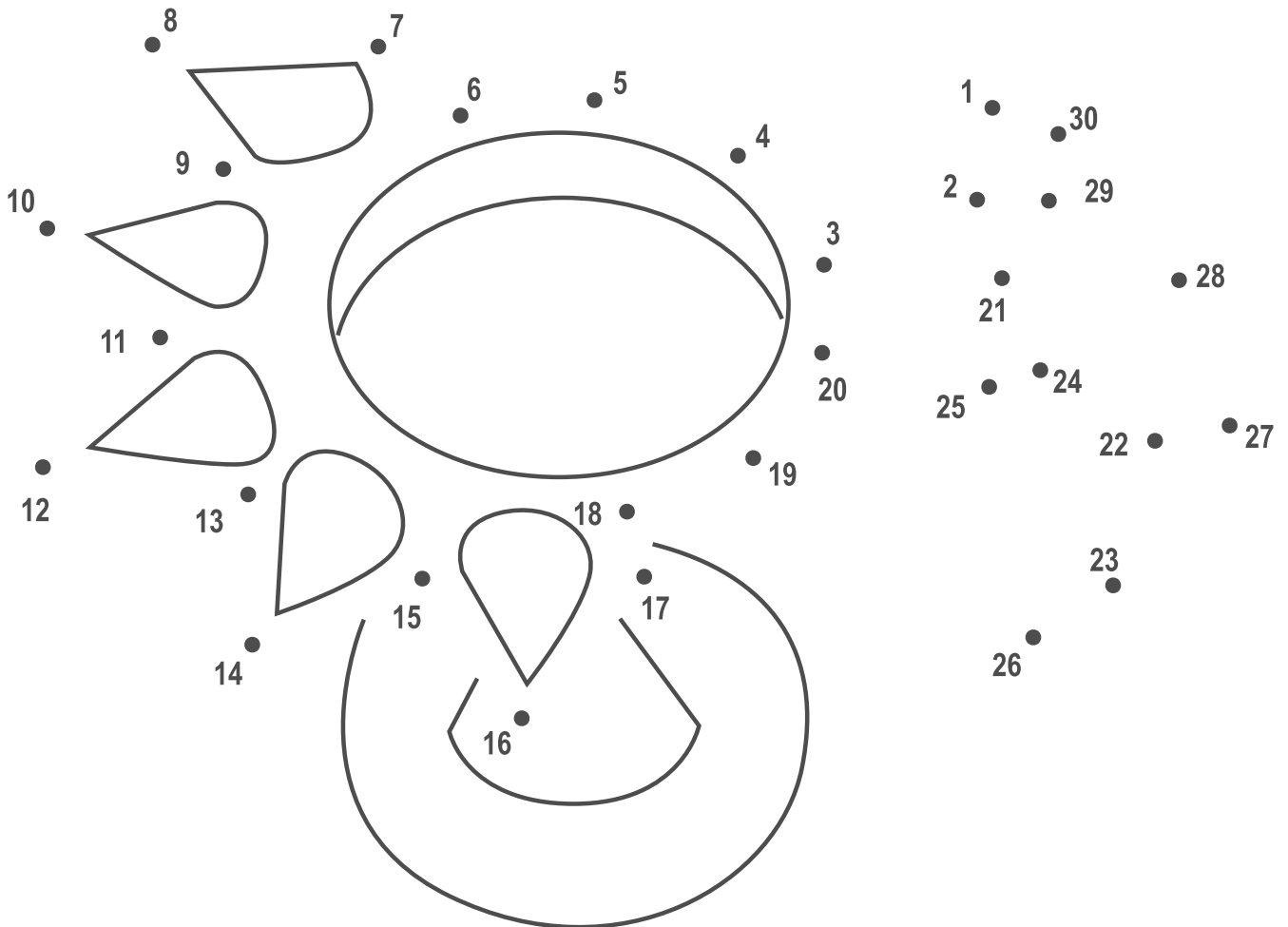

The Supreme lord

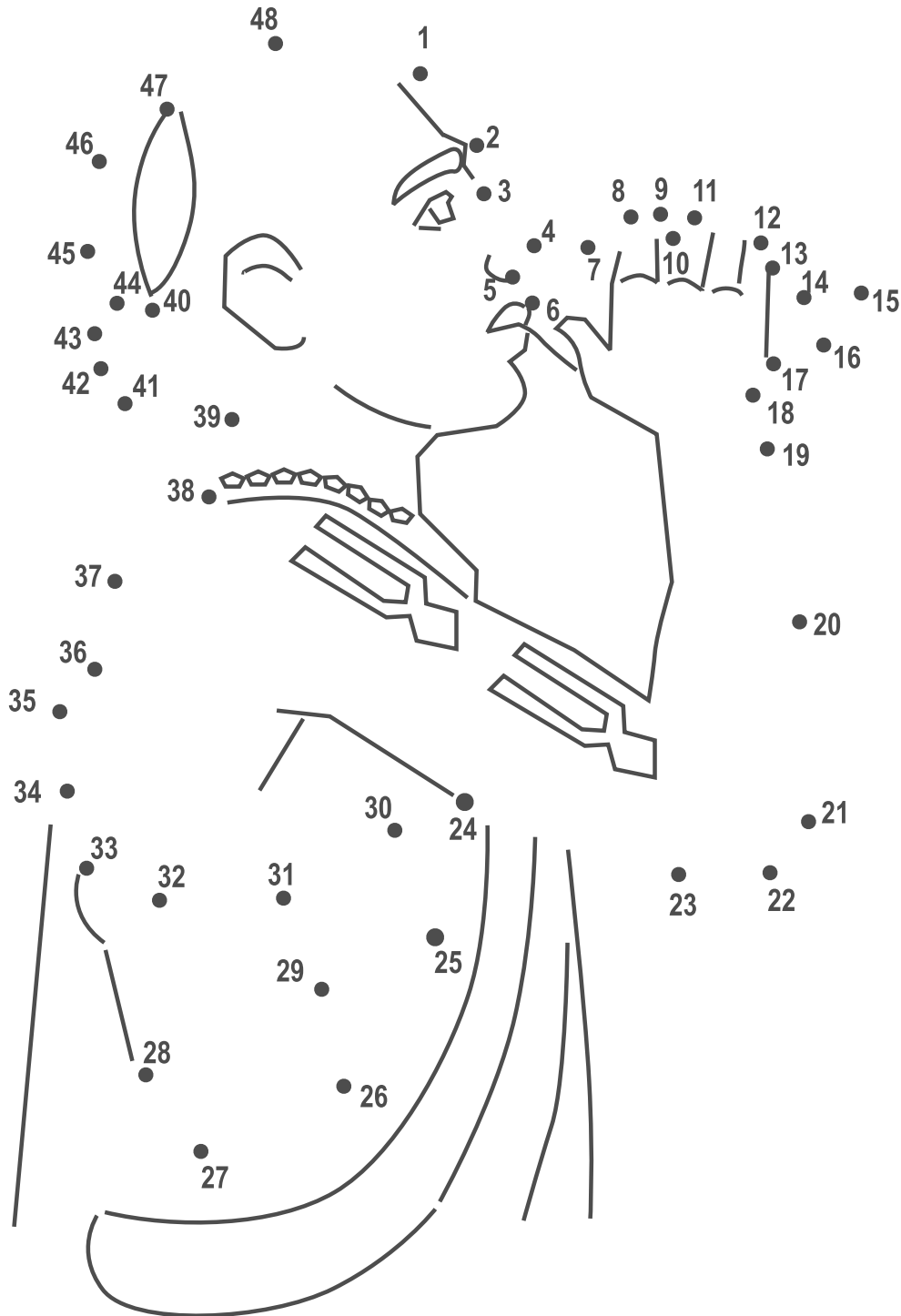

Mind, Words and Actions of Body.



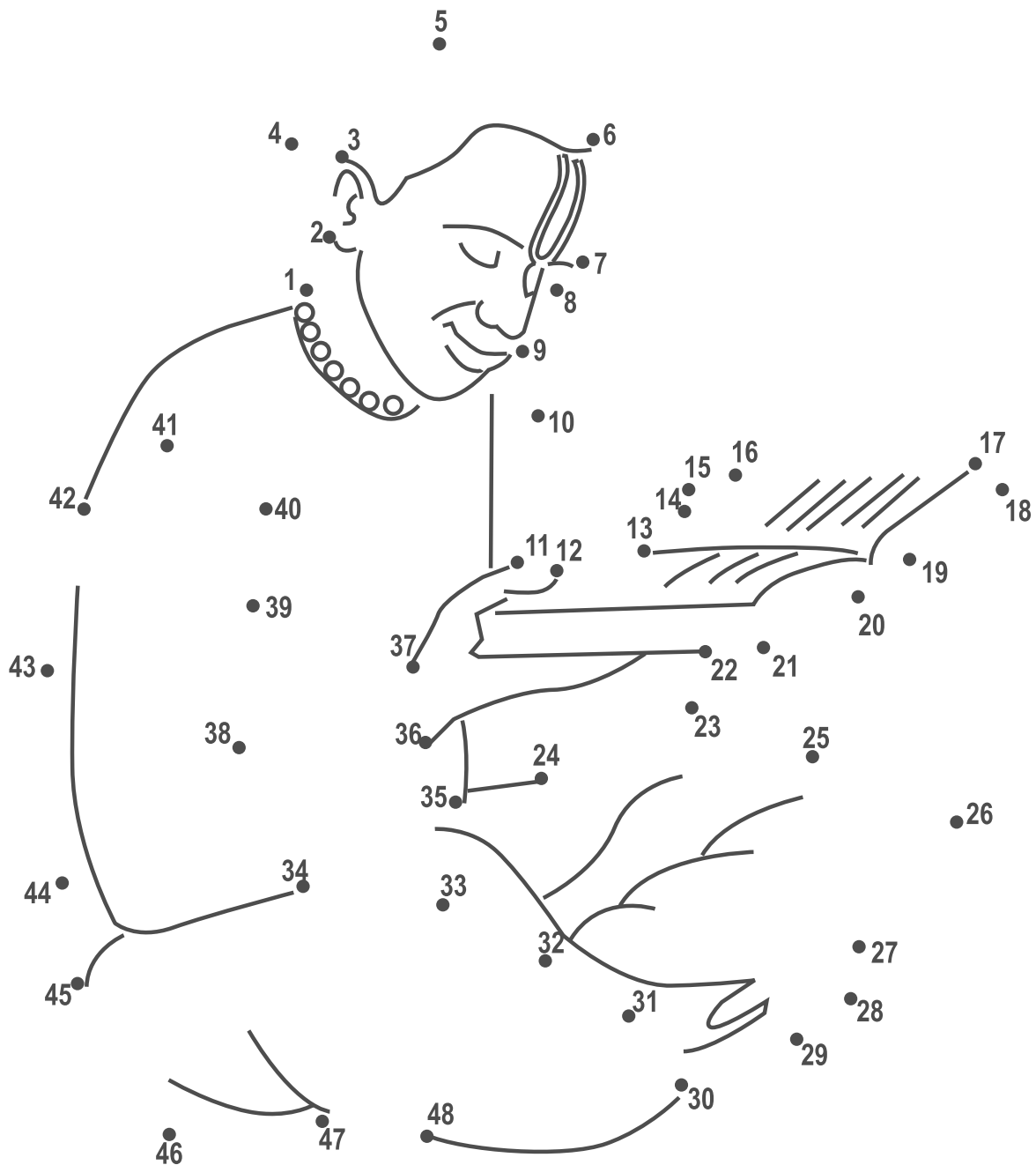

Abstinence from grains and beans is prescribed. We should chant & hear the glories of the Lord throughout the day.

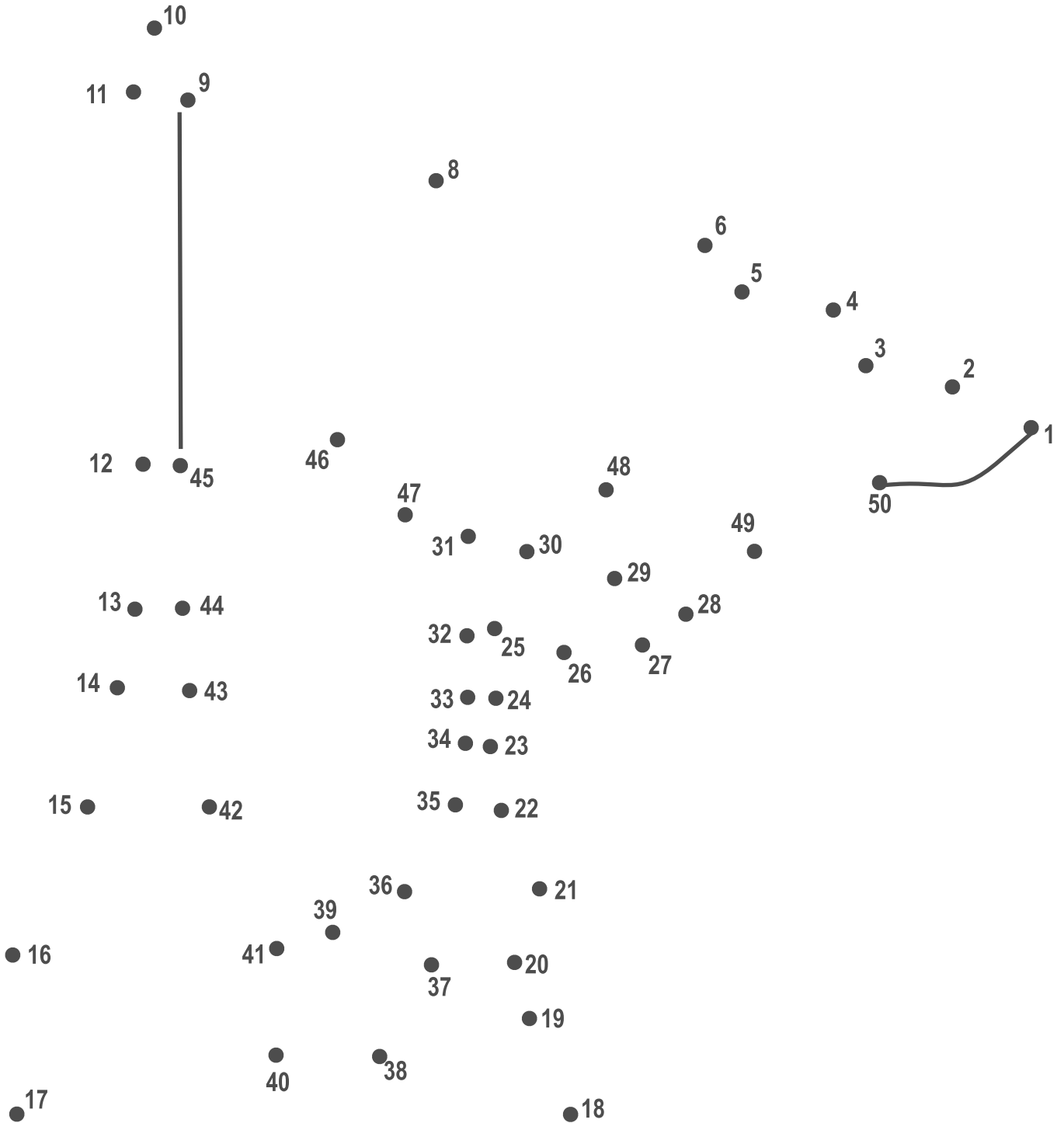

Flag on top of Temple signifies the presence of the Lord below it.

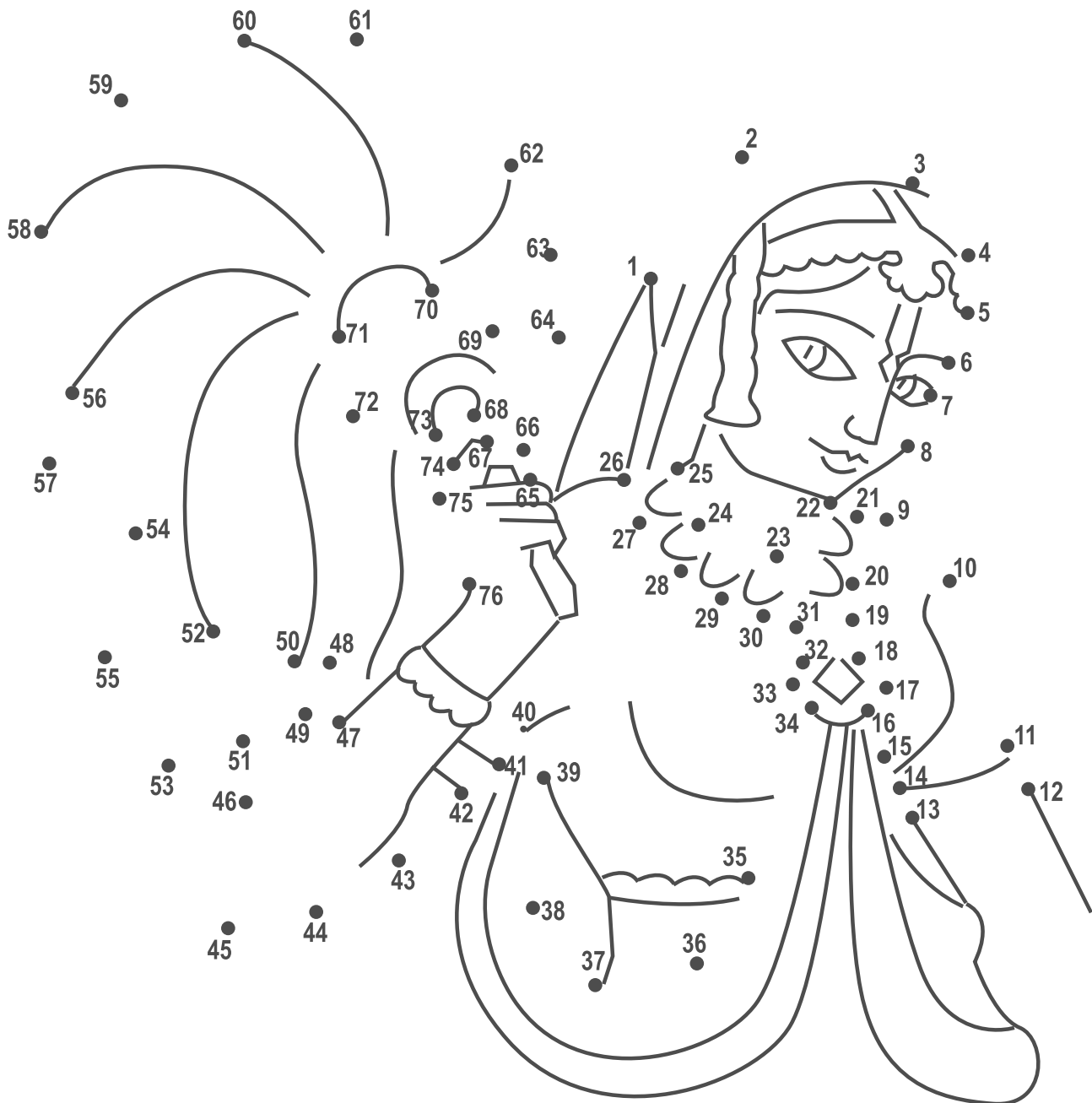

Gopis are Krishna's cowherd girl friends. They are the topmost devotees who always sing the glories of Krishna

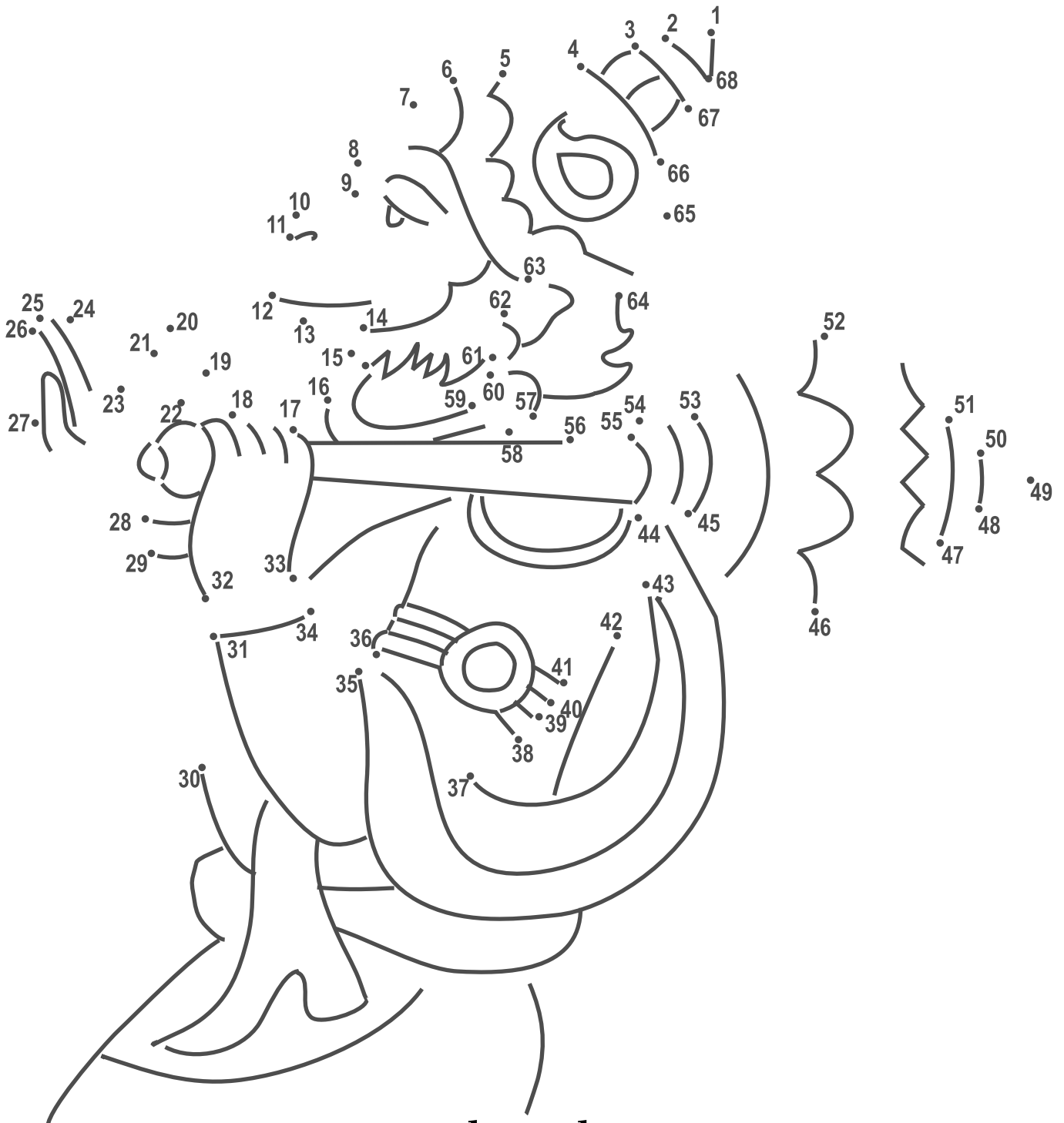

The great monkey servitor of Lord Ramachandra.

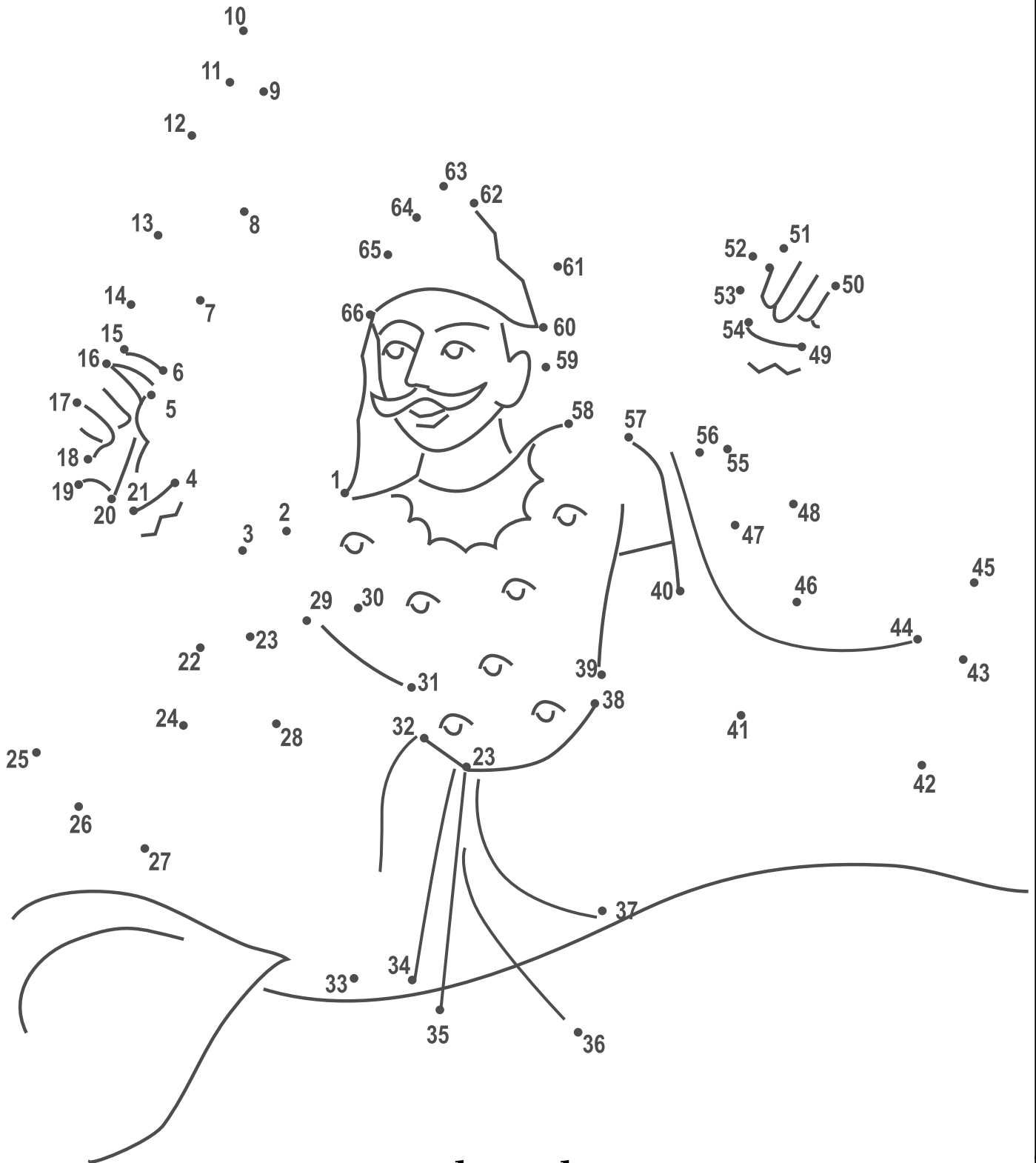

INDRA

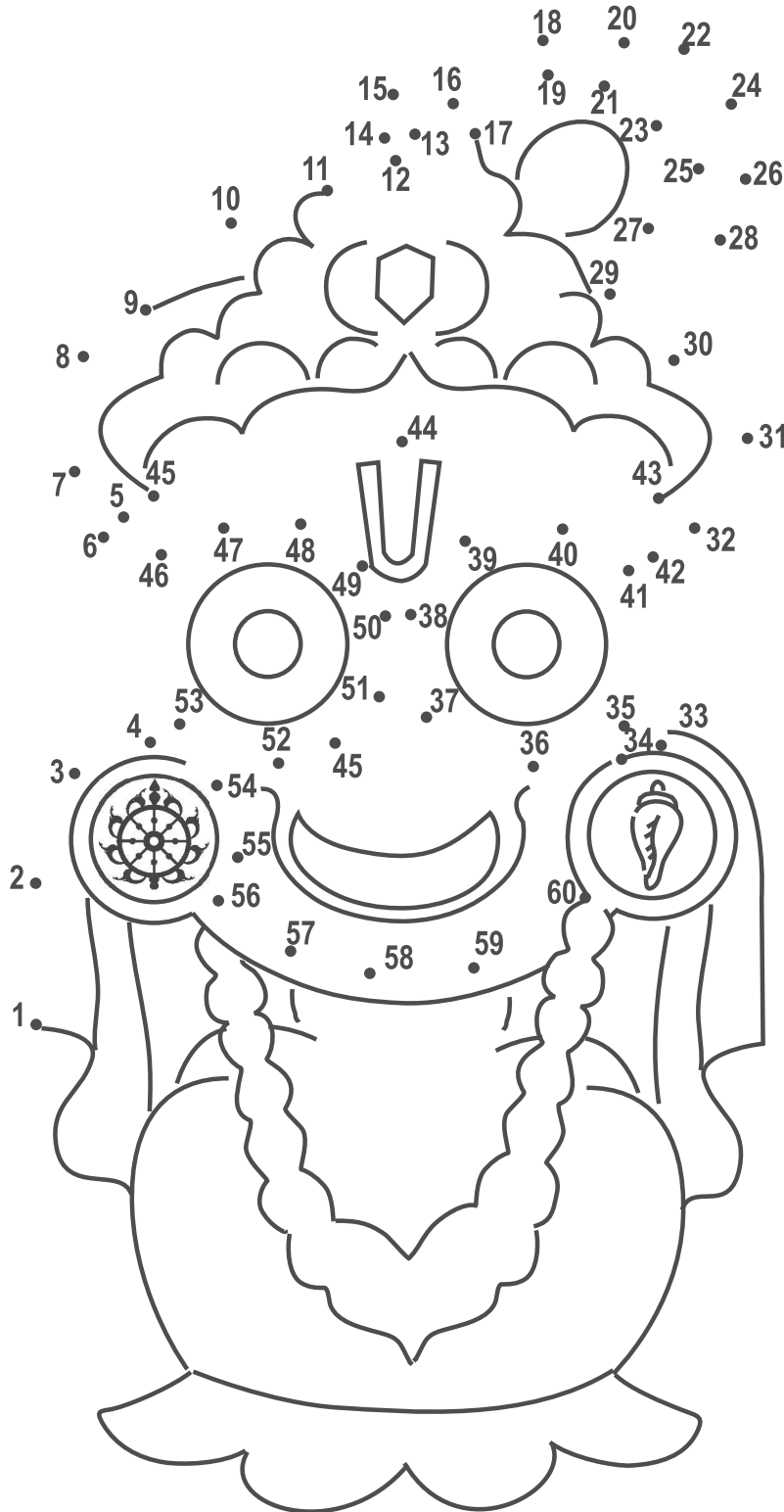
Indra the chief of the administrative demigods, king of the heavenly planets and presiding deity of rain.

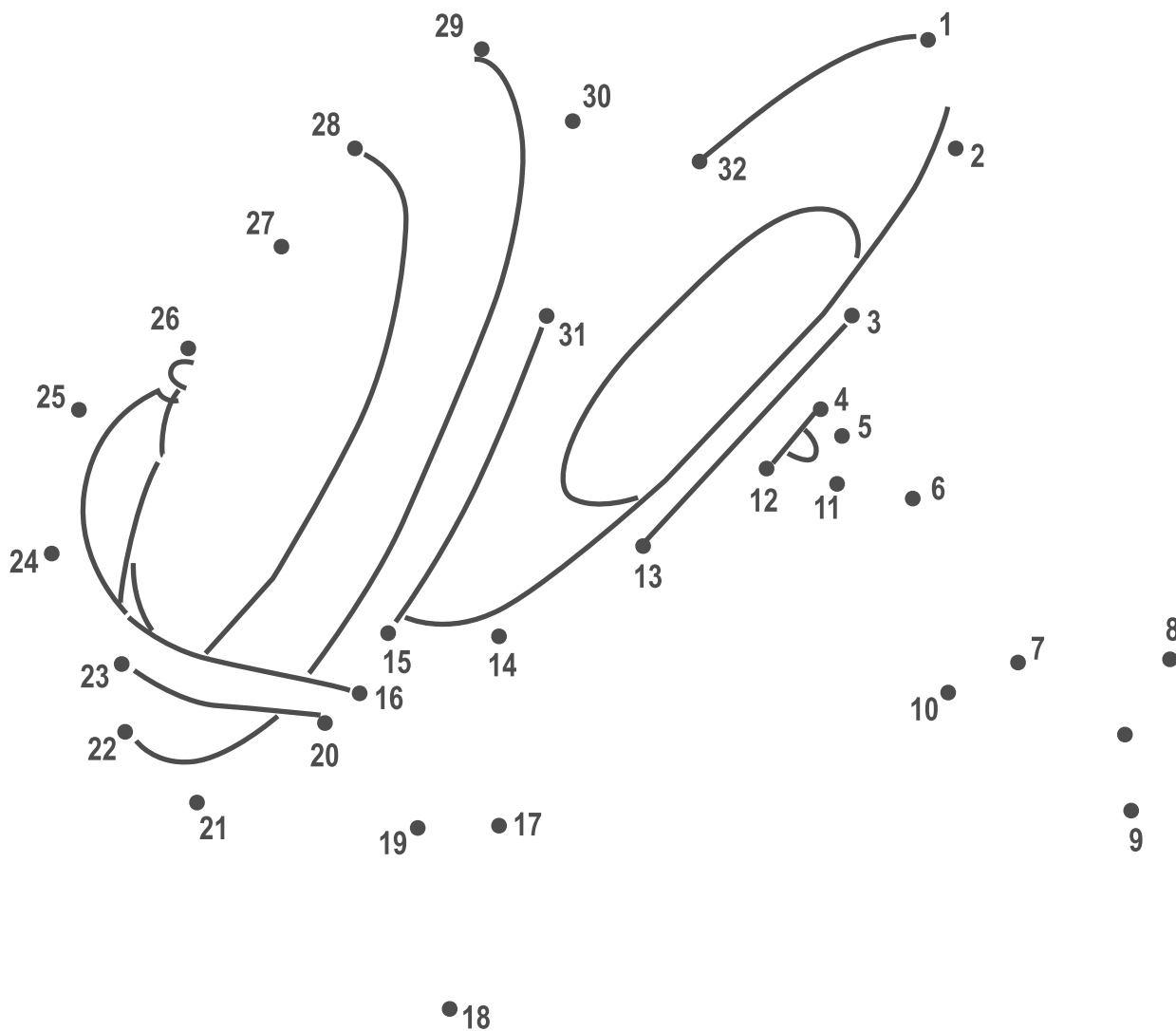

of the kirtan

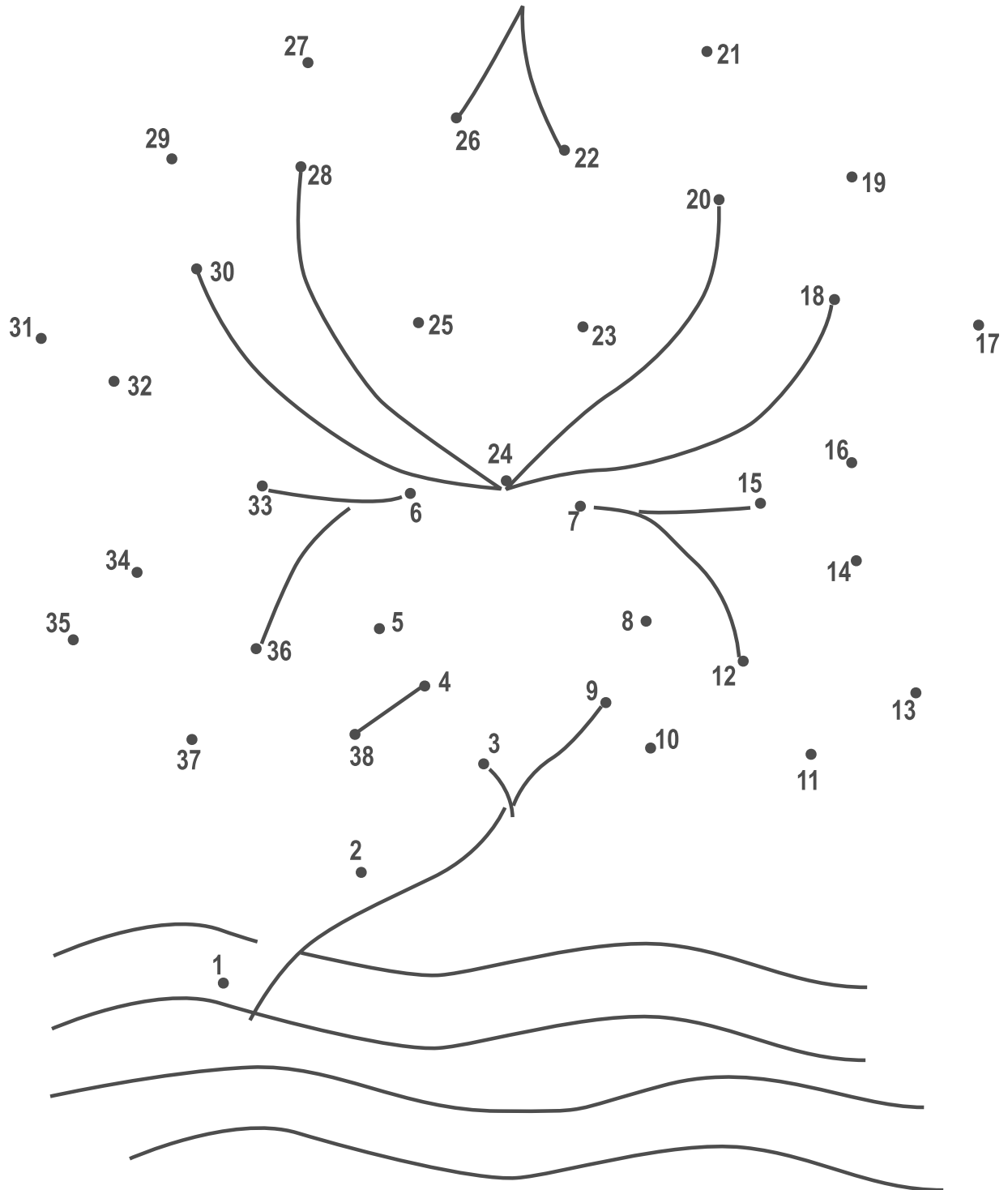

O Lord, you are always decorated with garlands of lotus flowers. Your glance is as cool as the lotus and your feet are engraved with lotuses.

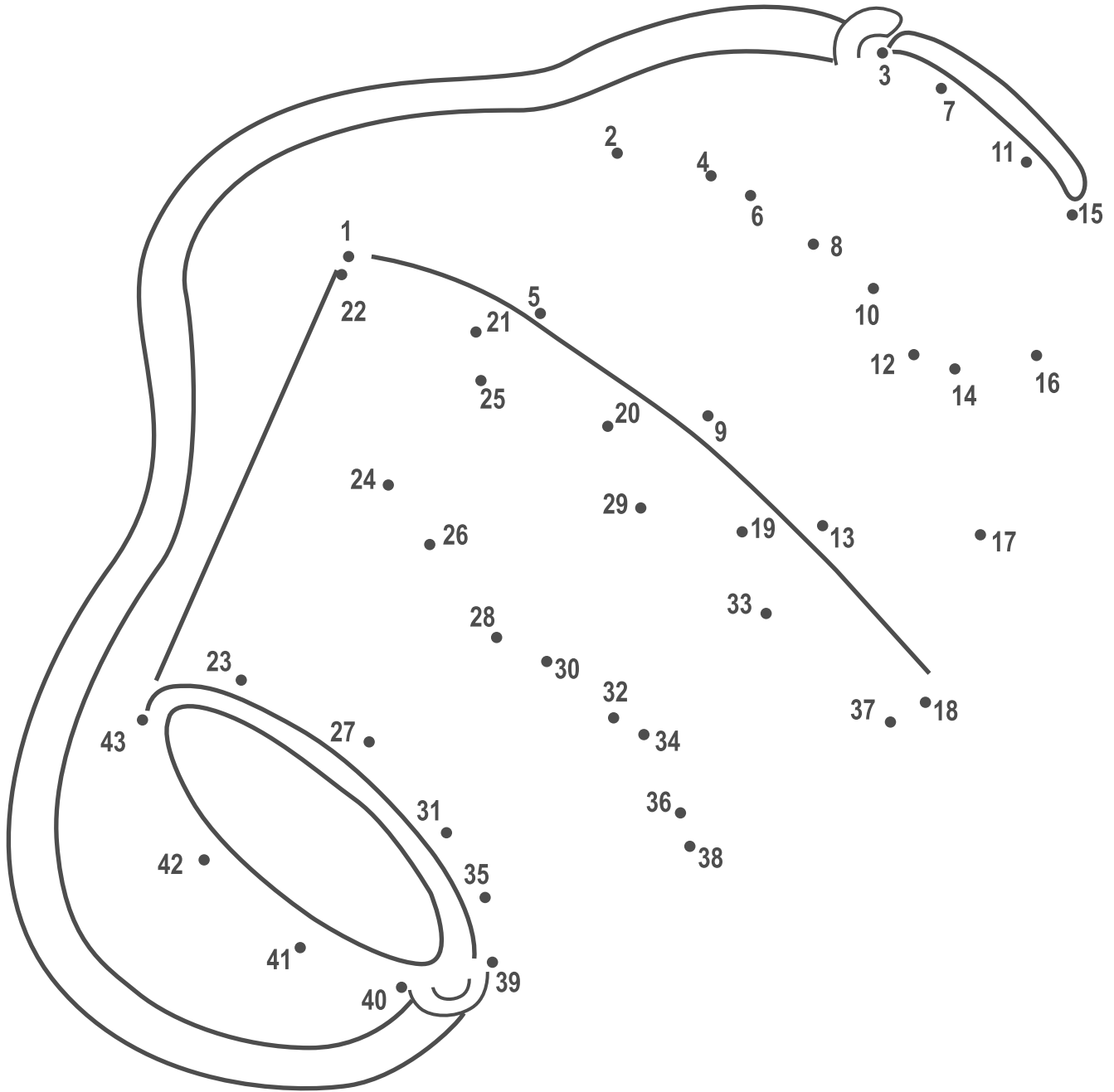

The incarnation of the Lord as a half man, half lion. He killed the demon Hiranyakasipu to save his devotee Prahlada.

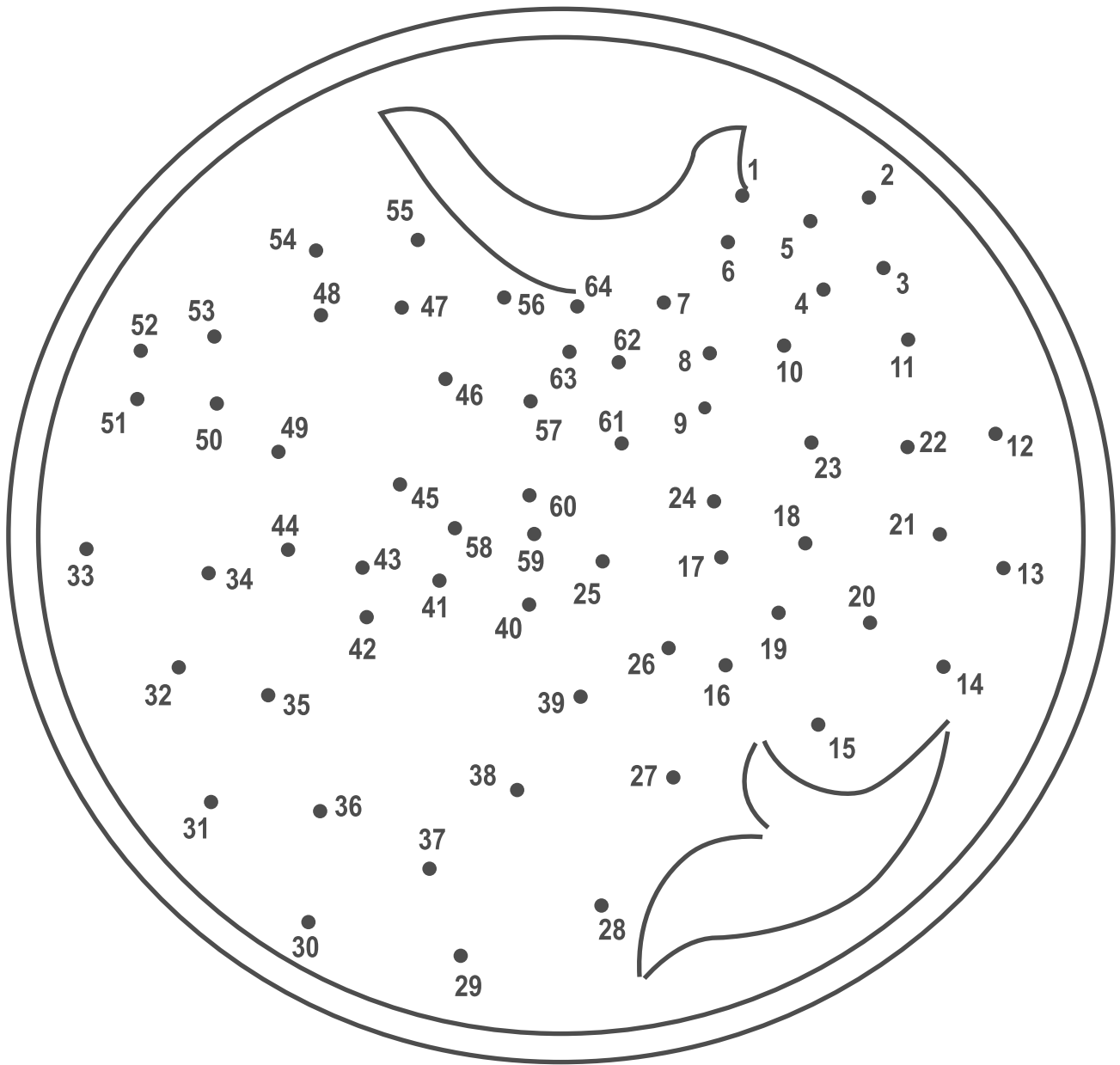

Queen Kunti was the mother of Pandavas & aunt of Lord Krishna. The prayers of Queen Kunti are very famous.

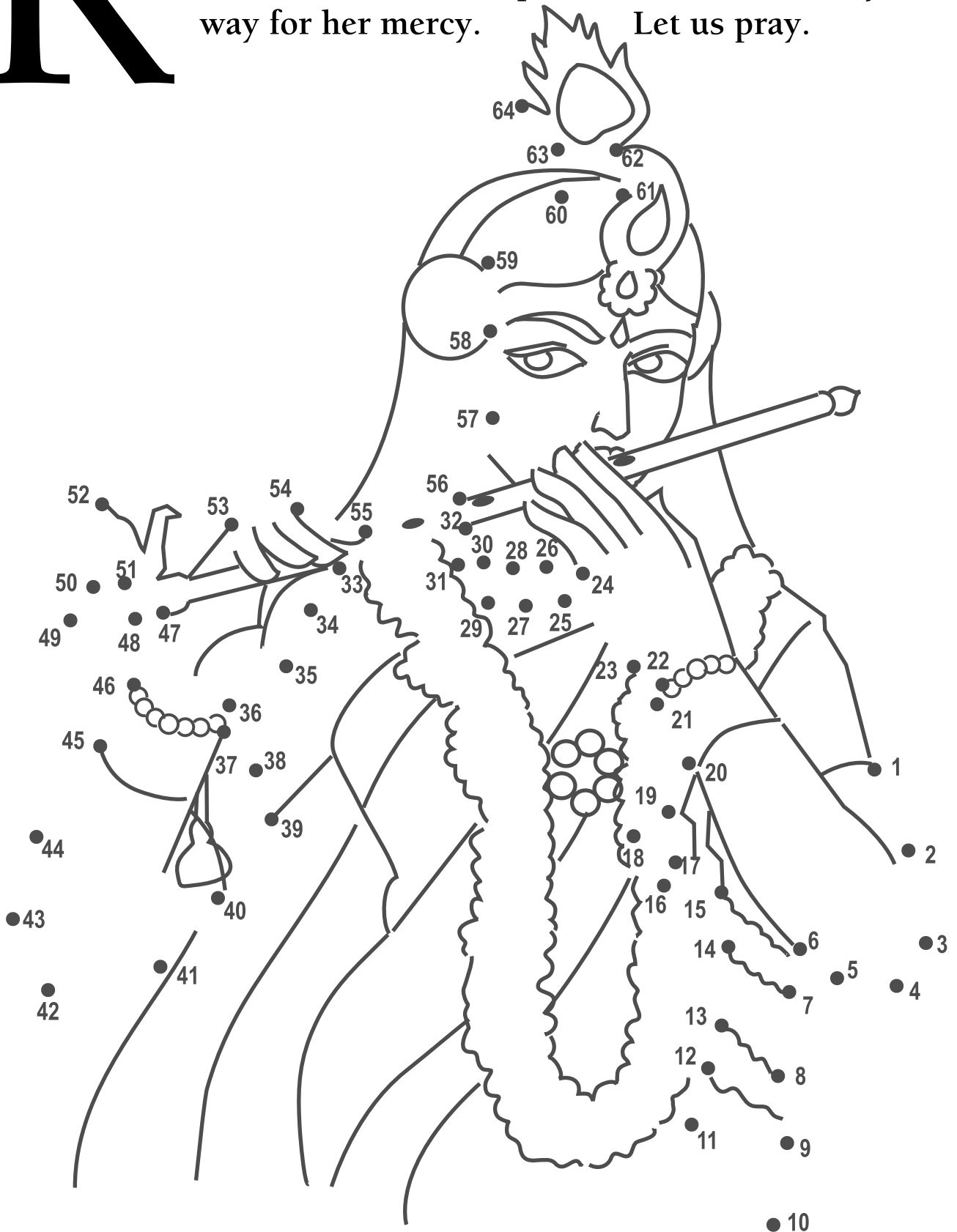

Radharani is a very special Gopi she is Krishna's dearest devotee. She pleases Krishna in every way for her mercy. Let us pray.



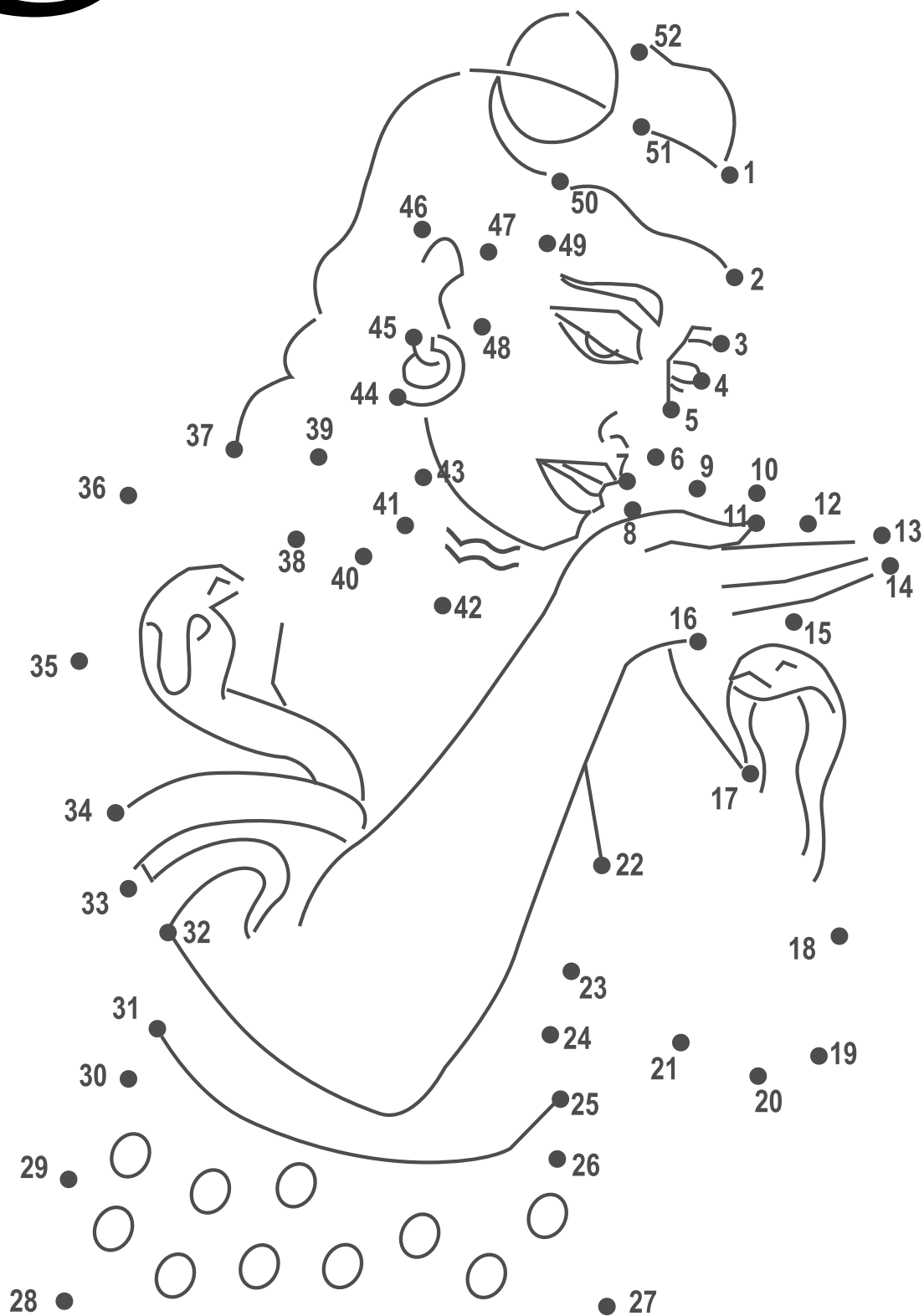

Shiva is topmost of all vaishnavas

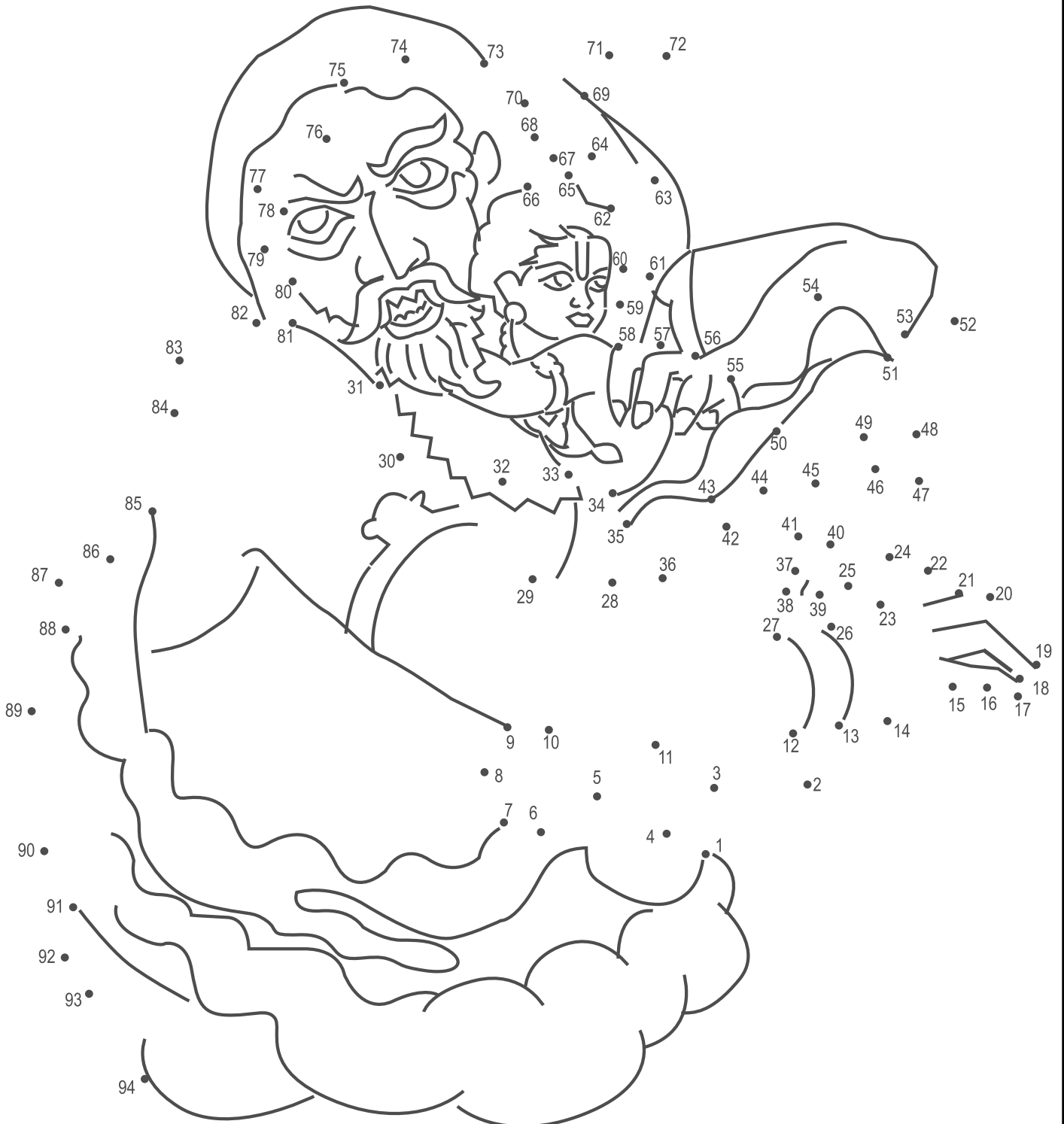

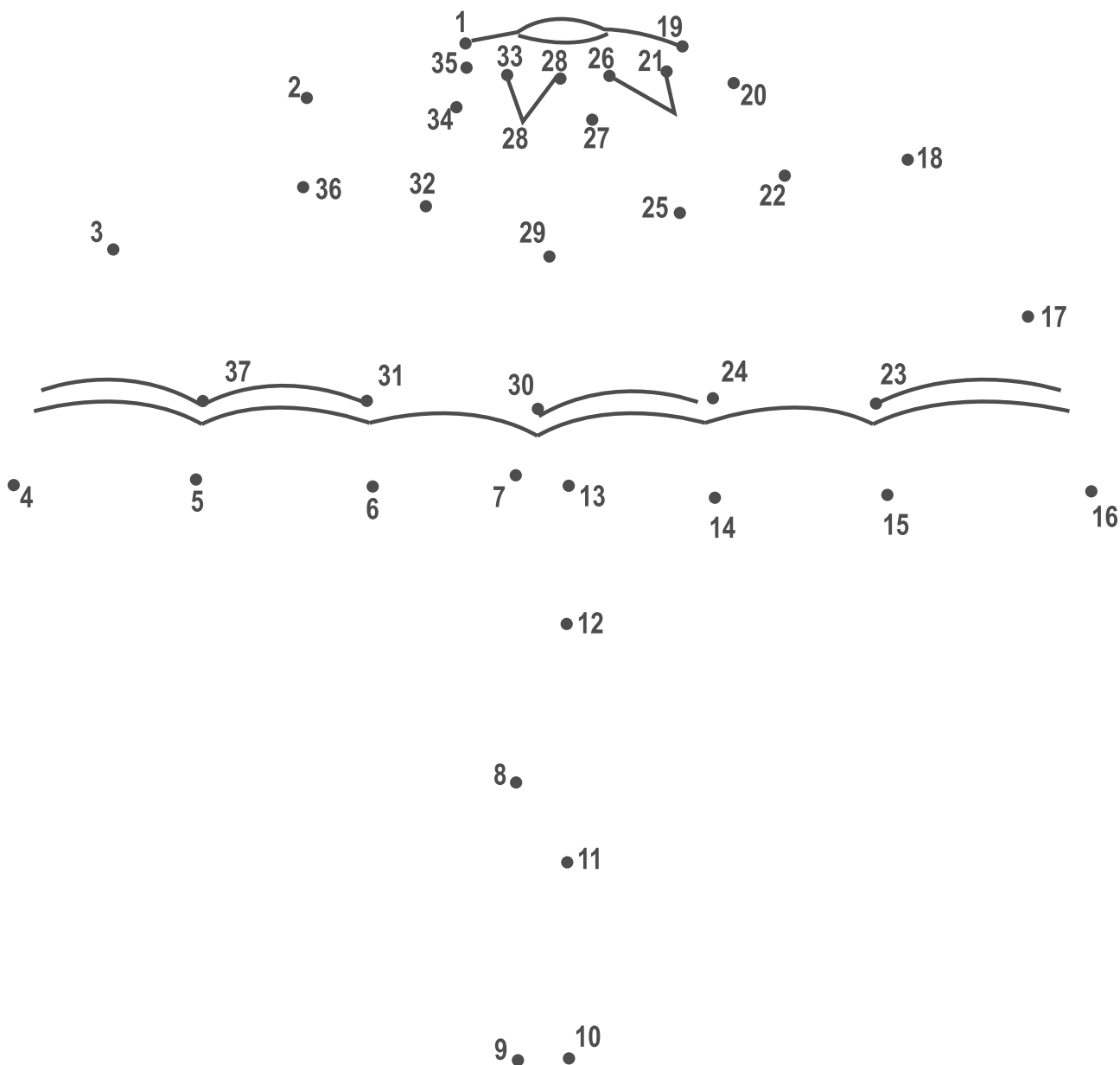

Lord Vamanadeva is always holding in his hands the Danda, the Umbrella and a Waterpot.

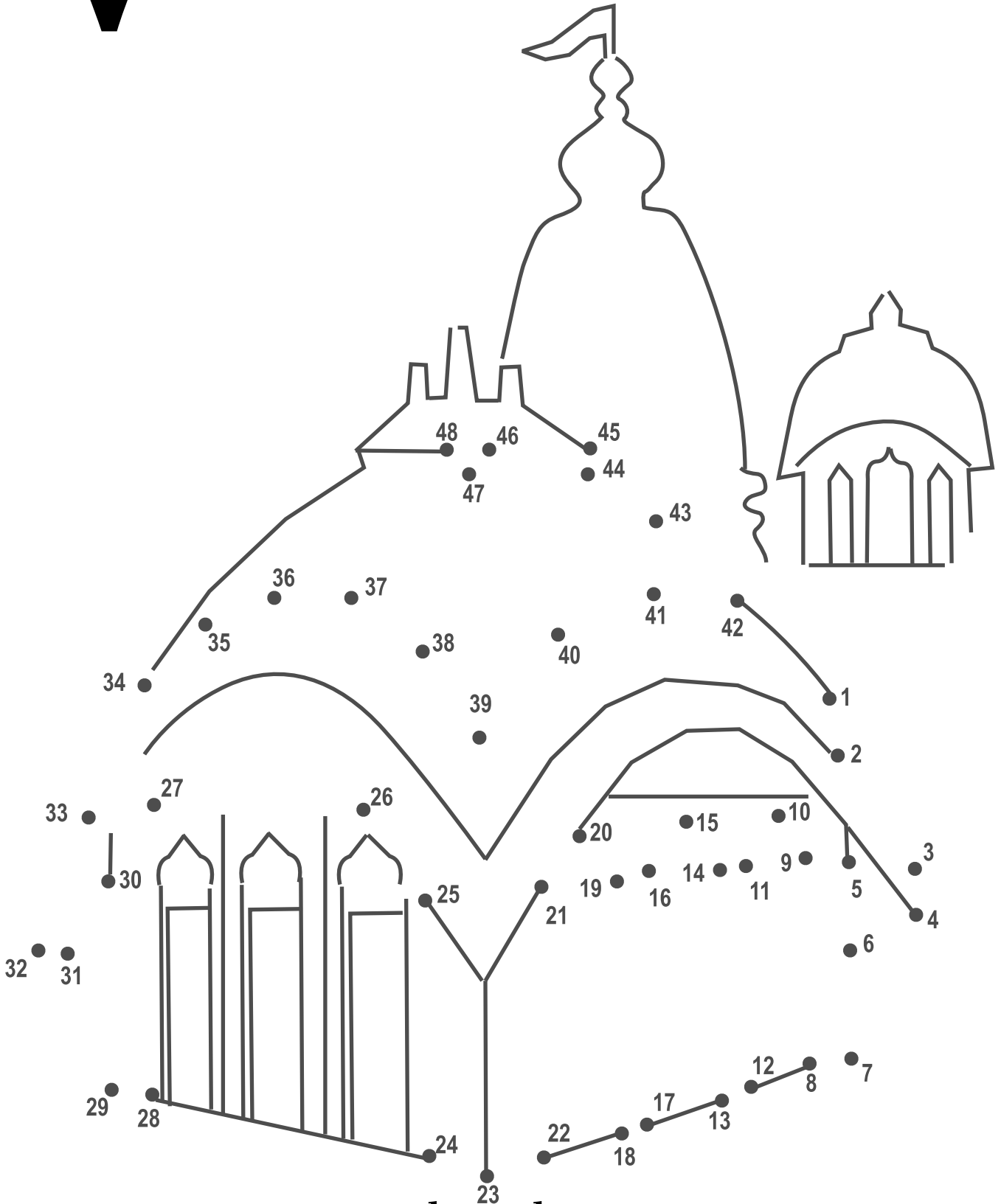

Vrindavan is the transcendental abode of Lord Krishna where he performs thousands of pastimes with his loving devotees

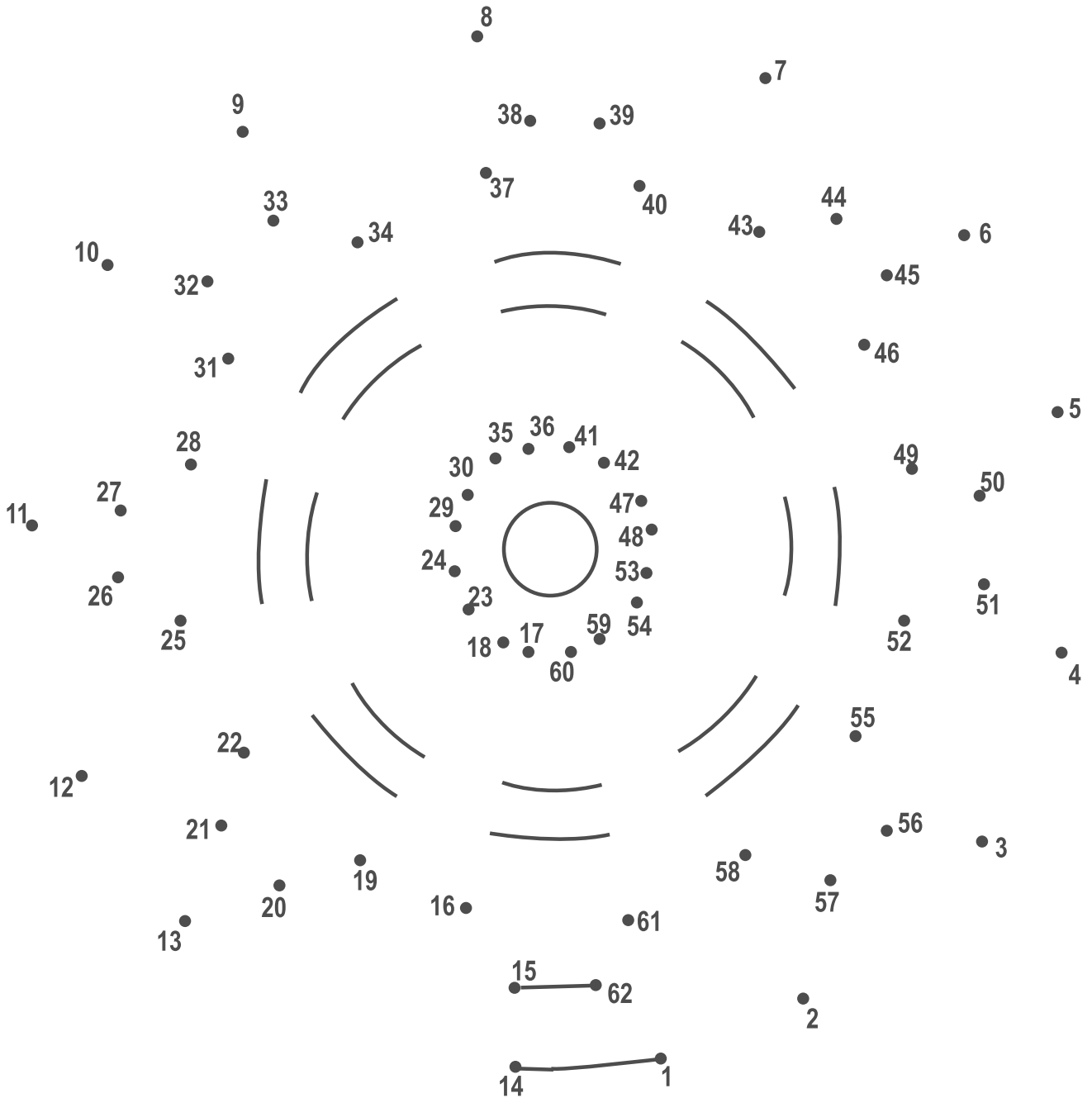

cycle of Birth and Death

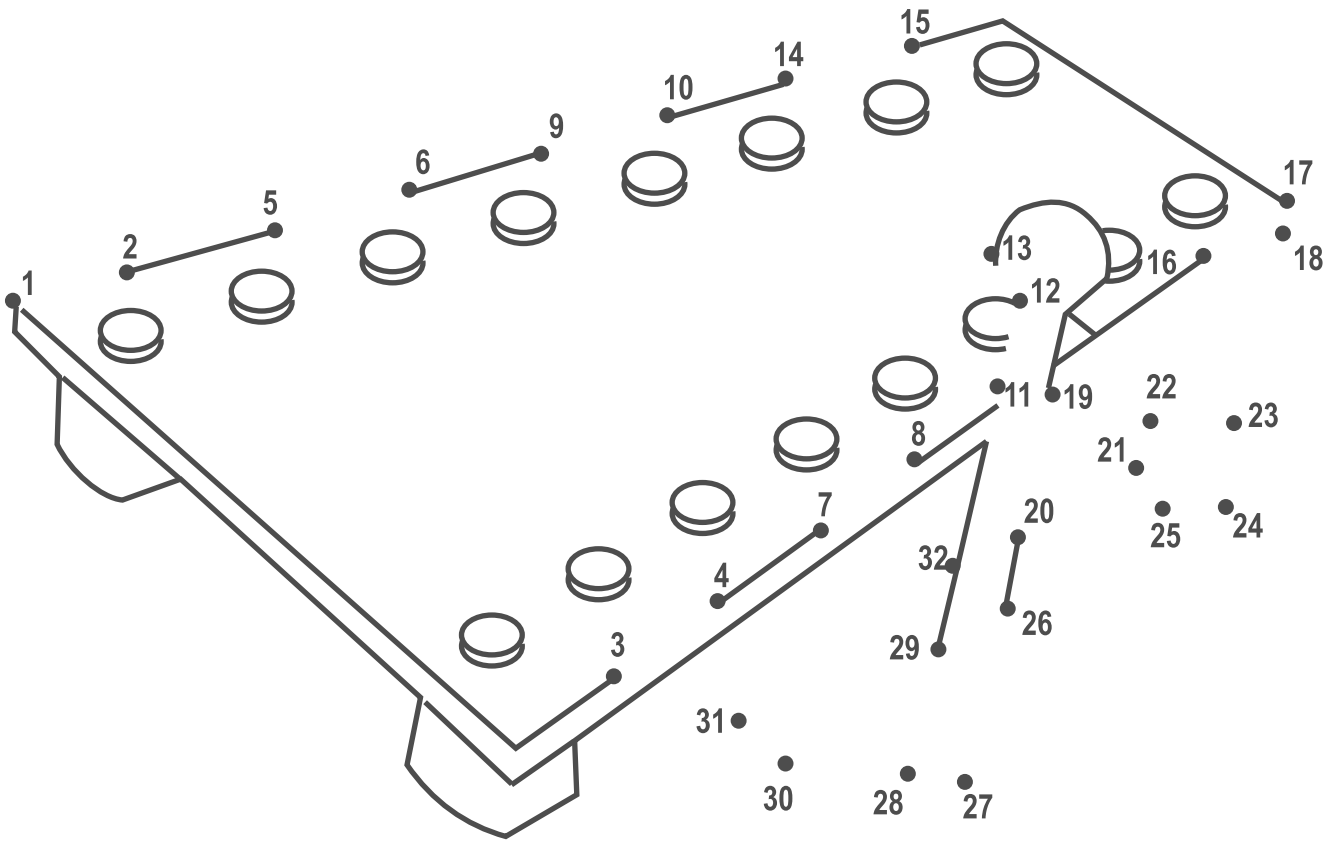

This instrument accompanies in melodious Kirtans

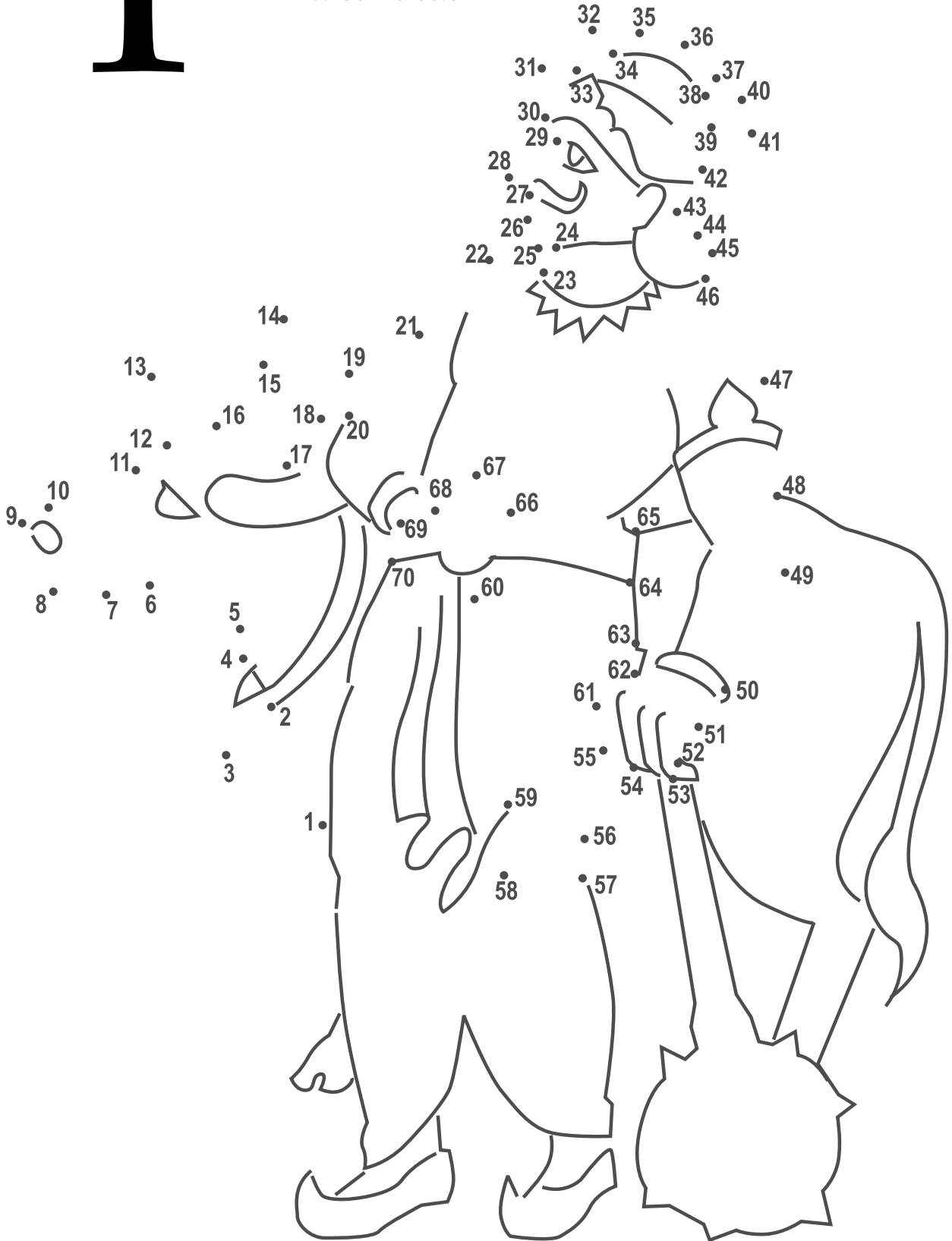
