'Forest fire' came to show its might.*

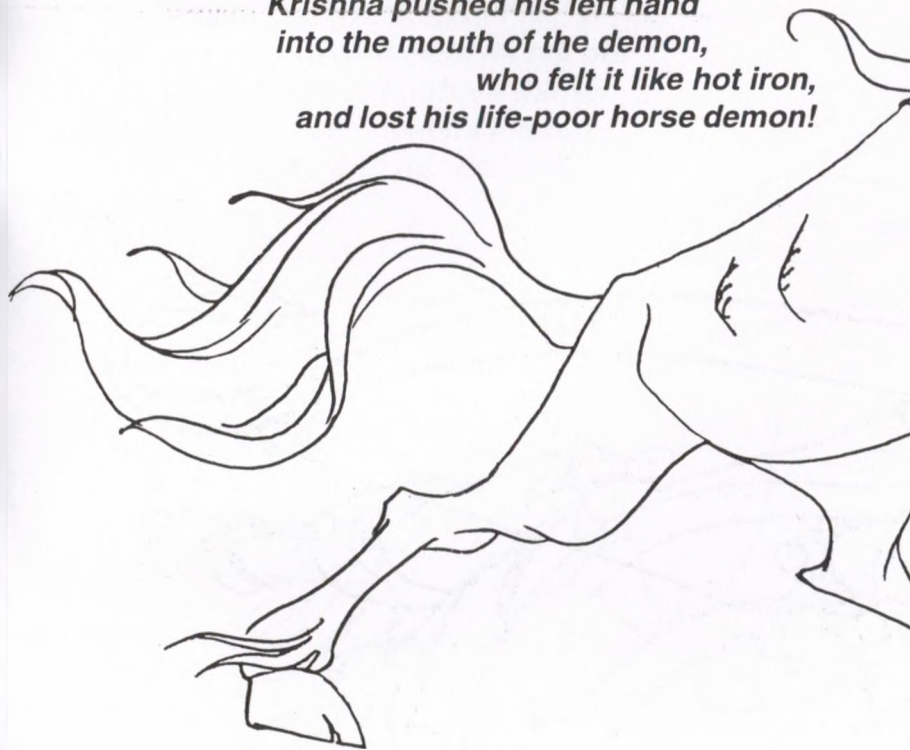
*"Dear Krishna! Save us all",

and lost his life-poor horse demon!*



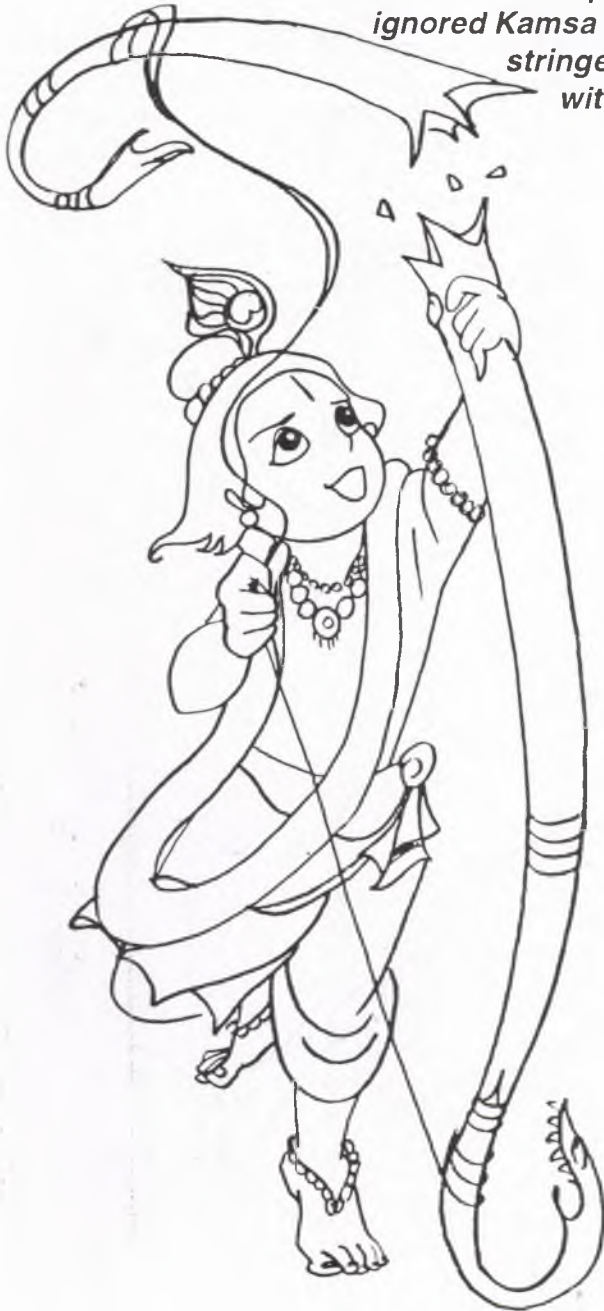


BOW-LIFTING

along with its ' mahout '.*





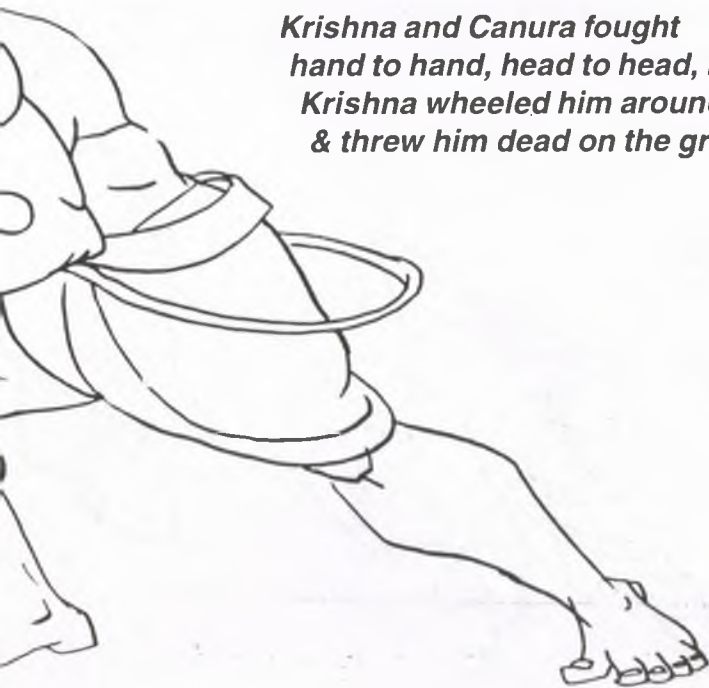


WRESTLING MATCH- I

for a wrestle-match.*

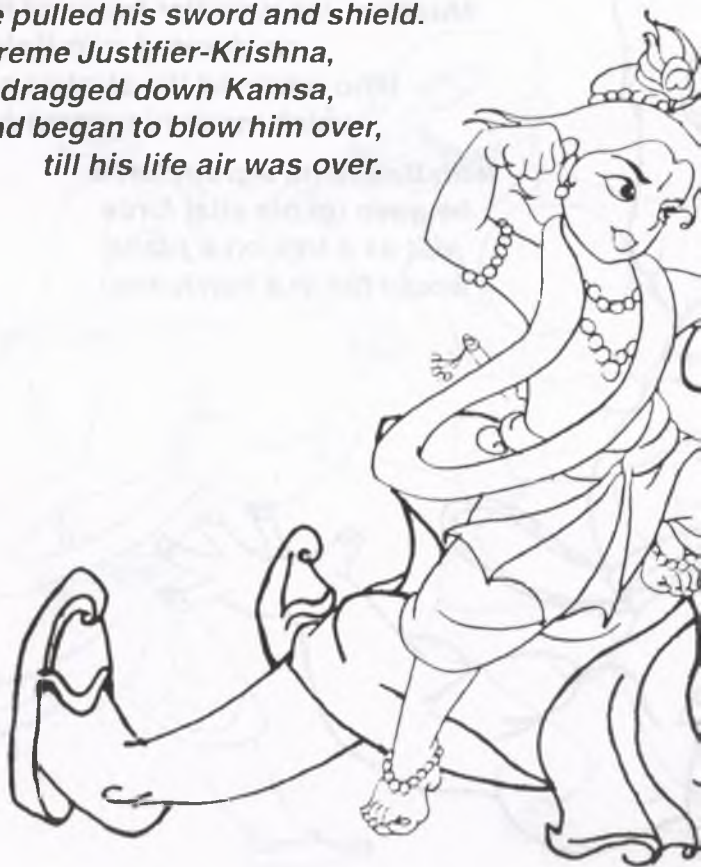
*Audience were unhappy
