




of Vamana:4


Lord Ramachandra with His transcendental BOW & ARROW killed the




of Lakshmi:8

of Durga:13


The Divine Mother Durga or Kali holds in her hand a Trident, Sword & Shield which are the symbols of the destruction of evil.



of Worship (puja):14


CONCH, HAND-BELL, CUP & SPOON , *CHAMARA*, GHEE LAMP etc are used in Worship of the Lord.
