

Pareekshit was the posthumous son of the valiant Abhimanyu, and the grandson of the Pandava prince, Arjuna. While yet in the womb of his mother, he was the target of the fatal Brahmastra, released by Ashwatthama, son of Drona, but Lord Krishna saved him.

It is interesting to note that according to Puranic traditions, the Kali Yuga (era) is said to have started from the year of his accession, which is also the year in which Lord Krishna left the earth, for his celestial abode, Vaikuntha.

In this book is given a mythological account of Pareekshit's death at the hands of the Naga King, Takshaka. Many scholars, including Shri R.C.Majumdar and Shri A.D. Pusalker, hold that this clash with the Nagas could be a genuine historical fact. They feel that taking advantage of the weakened condition of the successors of Dhritarashtra, after the Mahabharata War, Takshaka, the King of Gandhara, might have marched against Hastinapura and Pareekshit might have died in his attempt to check their attack. The "sarpasatra", referred to in the story might be nothing but the attempts of Janamejaya, the son of Pareekshit, to avenge his father's death.


