



uncle's village.









Ramu lay down on the cool grass, reveling in the shade of the old banyan.

such small fruits!"






He thought of the pumpkin creeper in his backyard.

The creeper was slender but its








He thought,

'Surely the Lord has made a big mistake! The huge tree MUST have large fruits and the small plants, tiny fruits.'






The cool breeze and the soothing shade of the banyan tree slowly lulled Ramu into a deep slumber, when suddenly..
