

Pre-school Curriculum

1. How to offer obeisances upon entering school each day ^{and} when a guest comes in (^{what 3 things should be done})
2. How to take care of personal belongings (in cubbies)
3. How to put on shoes, jackets, swimsuits, etc. How to undress + dress themselves -
4. How to say prasadam prayer (~~#~~ Bengali + Eng.) and how to say obeisance prayer following -
5. How to eat with suci hand and to chew with mouth closed, not talking while eating, etc. How to eat neatly and to clean up after themselves when finished. How to ask to be excused, wash-up, put lunch boxes away.
6. How to share toys, books - how to take turns, how to wait patiently, how to play co-operatively together.
7. They learn fine motor skills through activities such as cutting, pasting, stringing beads, doing puzzles, sewing (cards + garlands) and coloring.
8. They learn gross motor skills through activities such as running, jumping, climbing, swimming, swinging, playing ball, balancing and throwing.
9. They ~~#~~ get an introduction into life ~~science~~ and practical skills through simple experiments (growing ^{from} seeds) to cooking class (making ^e breadsticks).
10. They learn the art of drama, through watching plays and/or acting out pastimes.
