



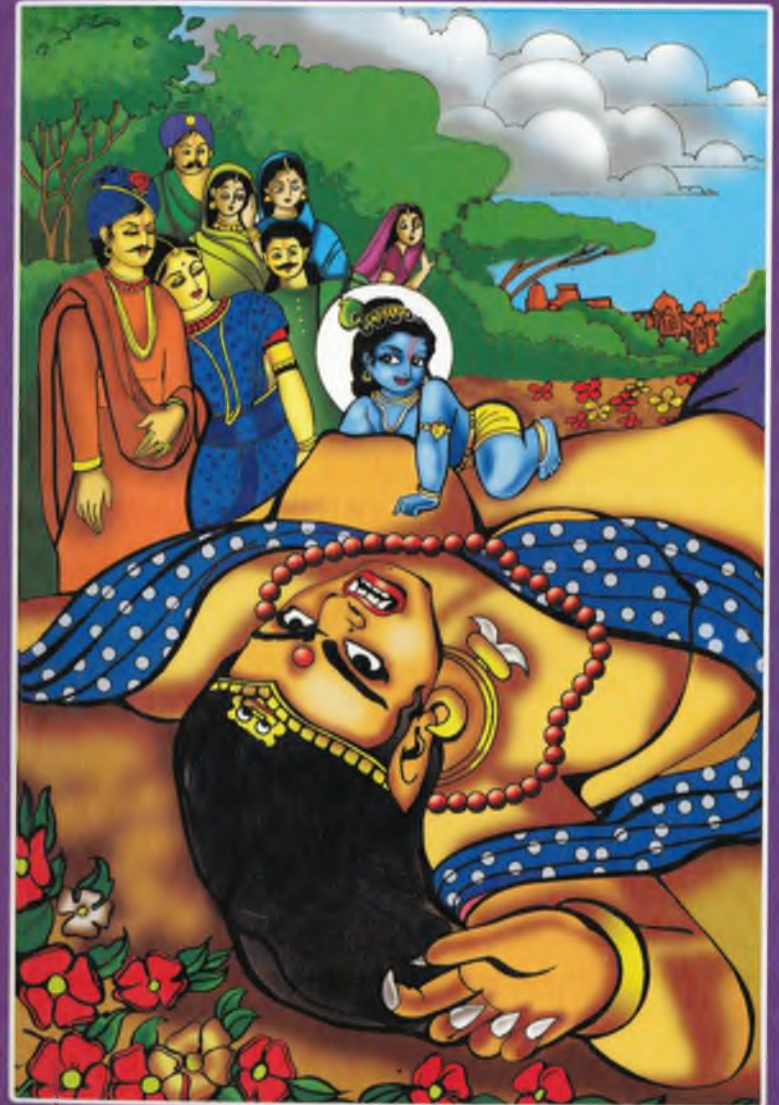

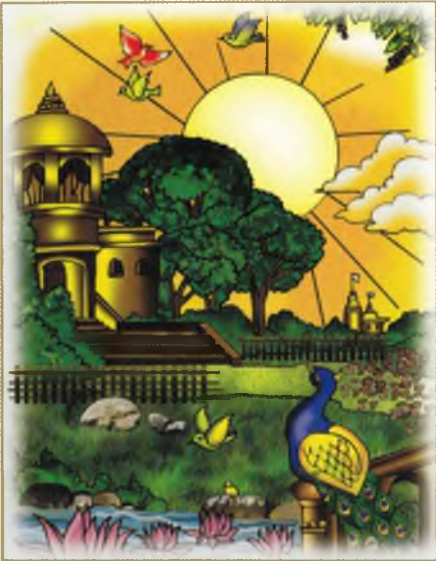

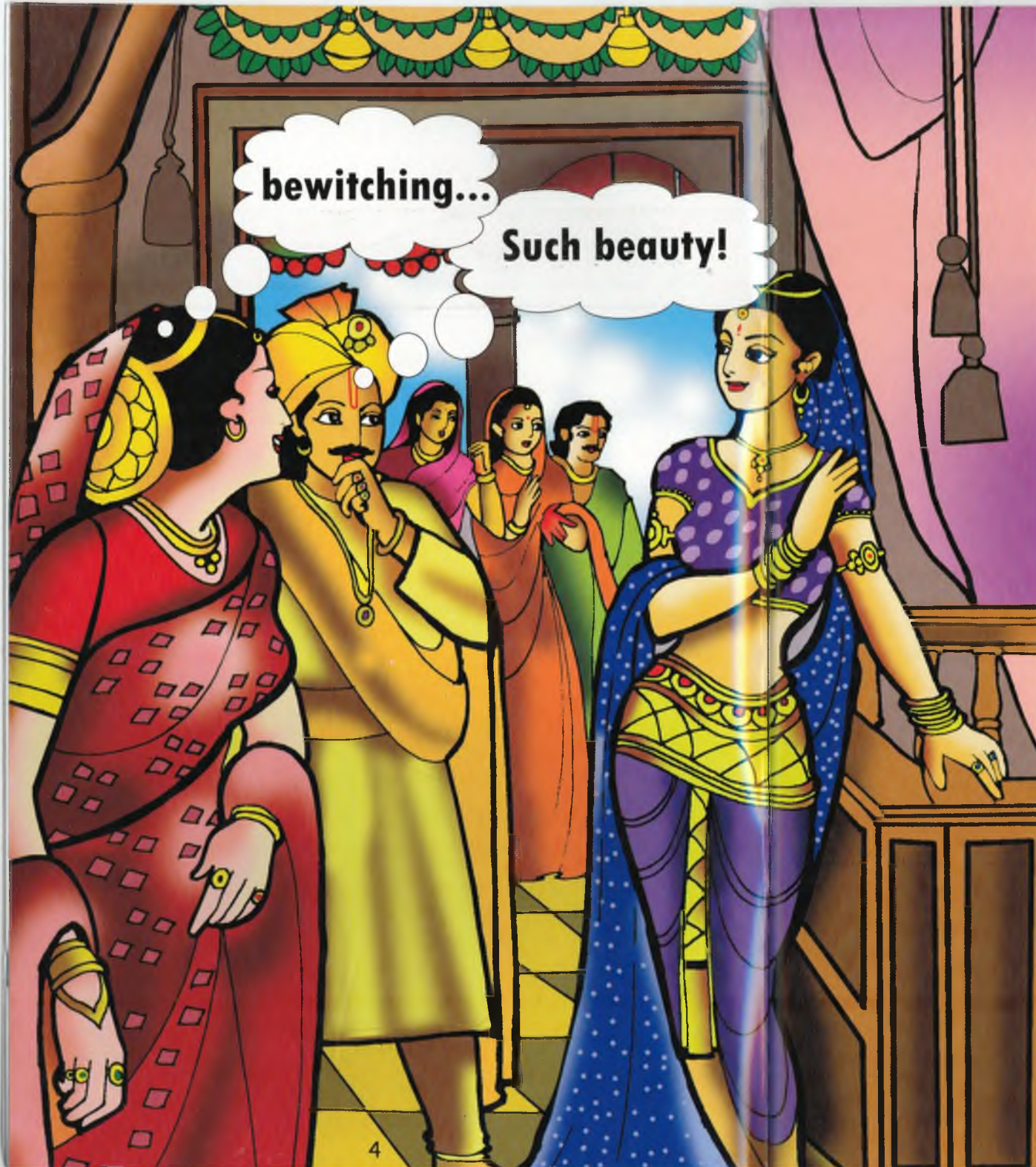
One day

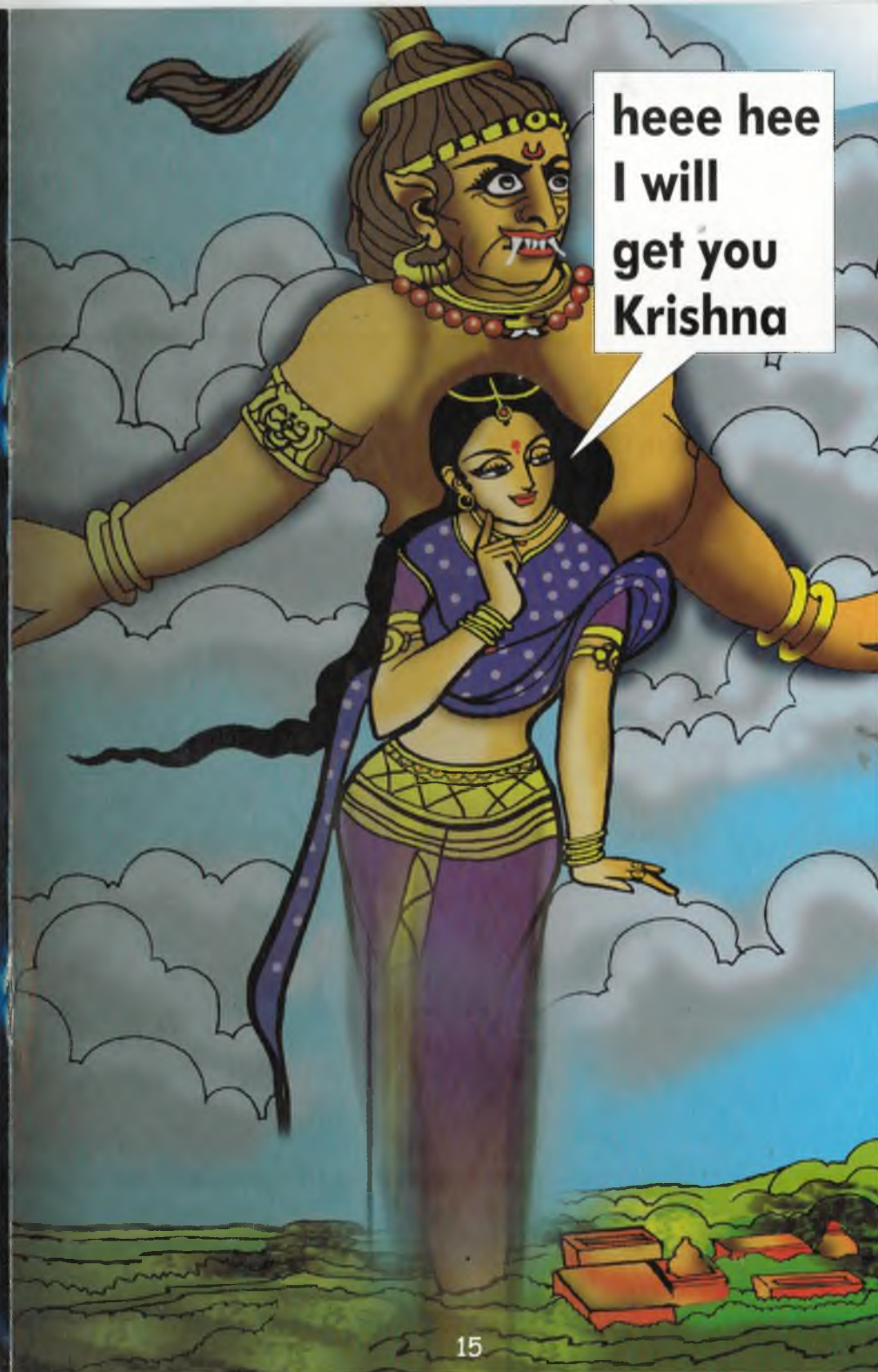


the King of all demons.

The demon's plan was to kill Krishna by feeding Him with her **poisonous milk.....**



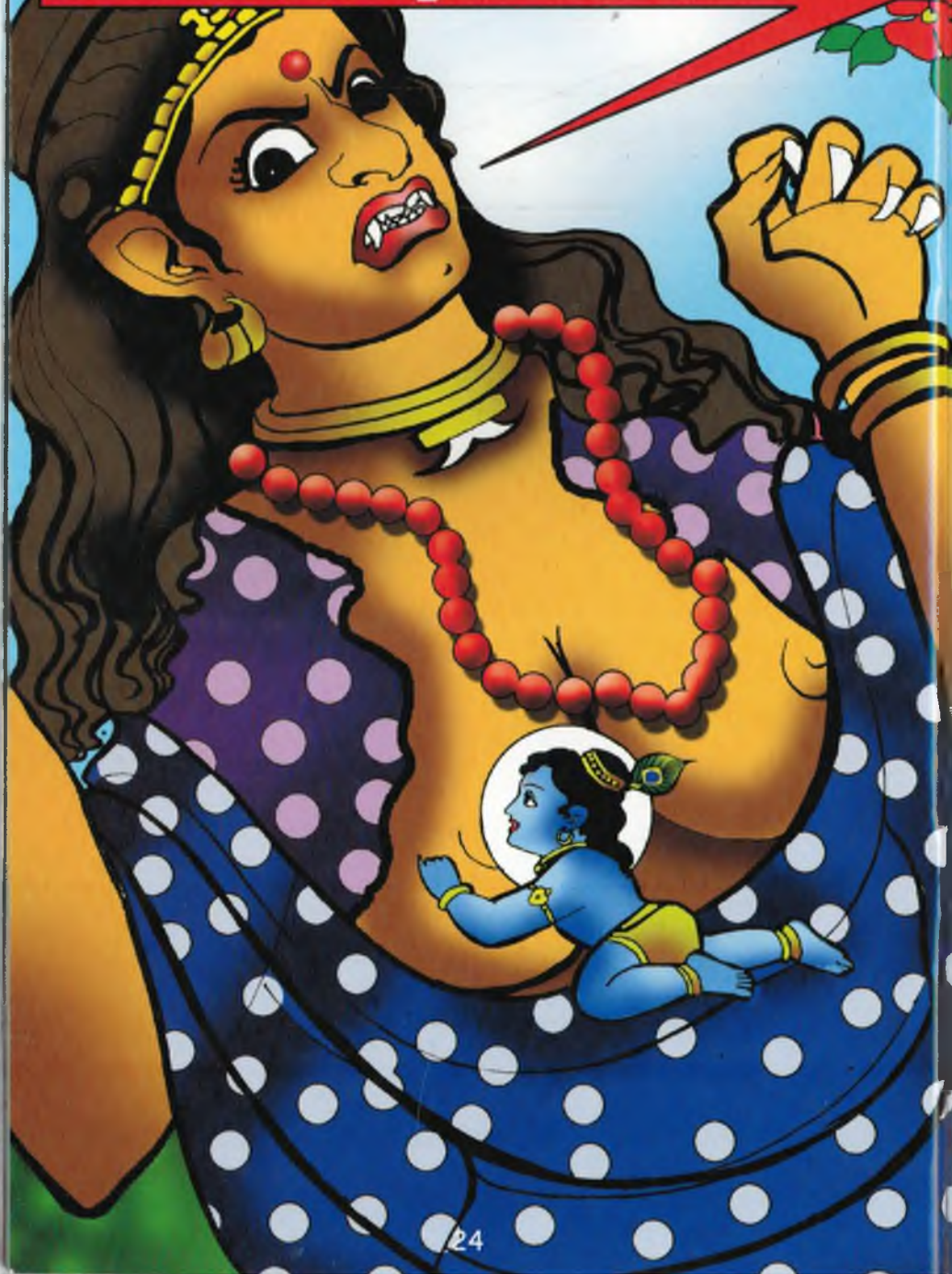
When she reached a secluded place in the courtyard, she started to feed Krishna. She came, well prepared by smearing her breasts with **poison.**

DEAD. :-)

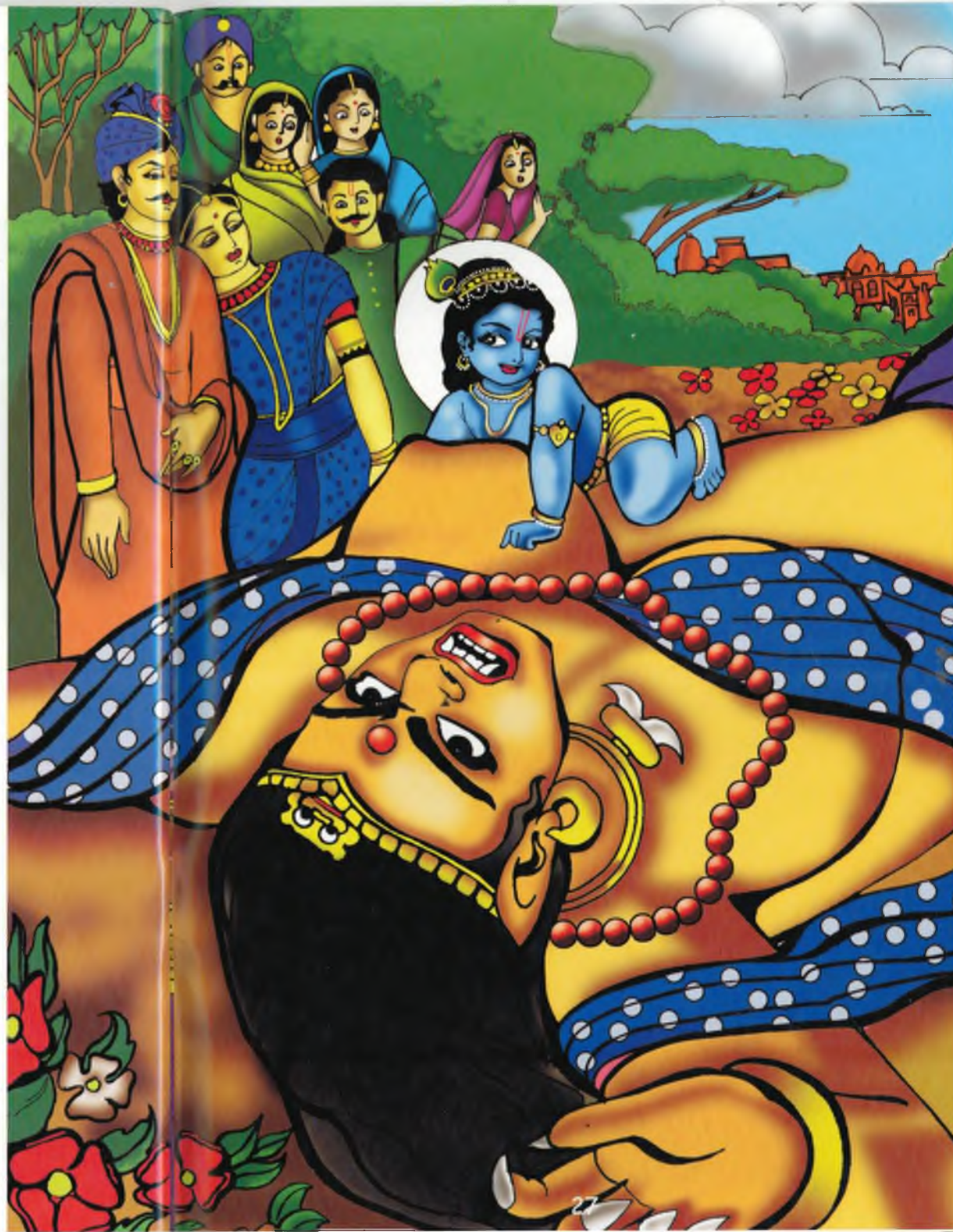
Hearing the
