


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
# RAVANA

Then one day, he saw a magnificent chariot descending from the sky in front of the great sage Vishrava.





Sumali came back to the Nether-world along with his daughter. But he was thinking about Kubera.

Kaikesi! go to Vishrava and win him over. If he agrees to marry you, you too have sons as mighty as Kubera.




Kaikesi went to Sage Vishrava. He was offering his evening prayers.
























Years passed by. Ravana and Kumbhakarna grew into arrogant and ambitious princes. One day, Kubera came to his father.









Ravana alongwith Kumbhakarna and Vibheeshana went to Gokarna to perform severe penances.





Ravana began performing penance by offering his heads in the holy fire.


Ravana was about to offer his tenth head, when Lord Brahma appeared.












Ravana! it is the right time to win back Lanka.


Encouraged by Sumali, Ravana along with his men set out for Lanka.

Brother! you should not do this.


Keep quiet, Vibheeshna. I don't need your advice.




Ravana camped in the jungle of the Trikoota mountains. He sent a messenger to the court of Kubera.

Kubera vacated Lanka. Ravana was crowned the king of Lanka.




Being arrogant and ambitious, Ravana started harassing the Gods, Sages and Gandharvas.










Kubera sent a messenger to Lanka.










Ravana along with his mighty army marched towards Kailash, the Kingdom of Kubera.

... But the Gods took him to safety in a heavenly chariot.







Ravana seized 'Pushpak', the flying chariot of Kubera and started exploring Mount Kailash.

As the mountain shook, there was a panic among the followers of Shiva.




Even Parvati, Lord Shiva's wife, was terrified.




Lord Shiva pressed the mountain with his toe. Ravana's hands were crushed below the toe of Shiva.






Ravana began singing hymns in praise of Shiva.




Pleased with Ravana, Shiva gave him a sword.




Ravana started conquering the whole world. One day he saw a beautiful maiden in the jungle of the Himalayas. She was engaged in meditation.









Vedavati took rebirth in a lotus.




Ravana took the baby to the palace.




Discard the baby as it will become the cause, of your death.





Ravana immediately threw her into the river.






When he tilled the soil, he found a beautiful baby.










A few years later, Janaka arranged a Swayamwara for Sita's marriage. Janaka declared—




Rama lifted the bow and married Sita. They came to Ayodhya where people welcomed them warmly.




Ravana's terror increased day-by-day. One day he saw a beautiful maiden. Ravana went to her.







Ravana seized her by her arm but Rambha escaped and went to Nalkoober.



One day Ranava, disguised as a monk, came to the Dandaka forest.










When Sita was to give him alms, Ravana lifted her.




And brought her in his chariot to Lanka.







Furious Ravana was about to move towards her .....








Nalkoober's curse may came true. I must not marry her.

Meanwhile Rama along with a huge army of monkeys and bears had reached the shore of the Ocean.












Soon a bridge was constructed across the ocean.




Rama along with his army reached Lanka.





A fierce battle started between the armies of Ravana and Rama.




One-by-one all the warriors of Ravana were killed.




The mighty Kumbhakarna caused a havoc in Rama's army. But he too was killed.




Ravana however carried on the battle.

Thus, Ravana, a great warrior met his death because of his pride.



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
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
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
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

















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
