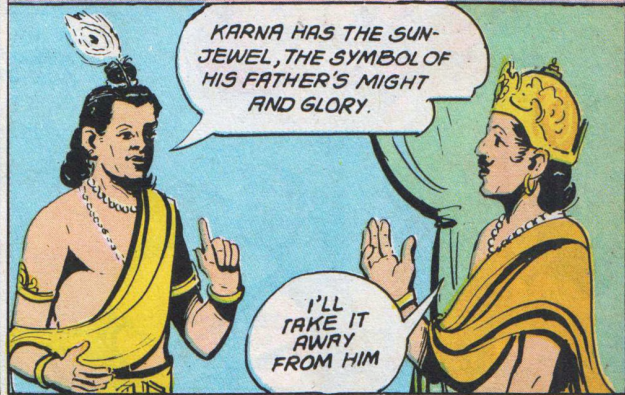

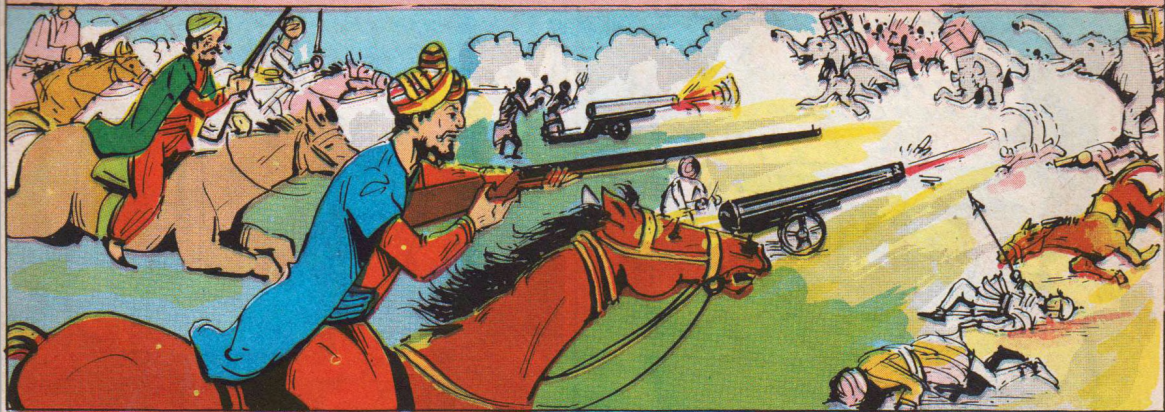

MAJIT.



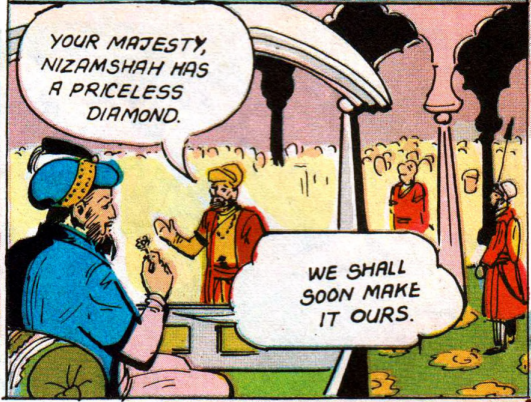
AFTER HIS DEFEAT AT THE HANDS OF SHERSHAH SURI IN THE BATTLE OF CHA-

SUN-JEWEL TO HIS PROTECTOR THE SHAH OF PERSIA.



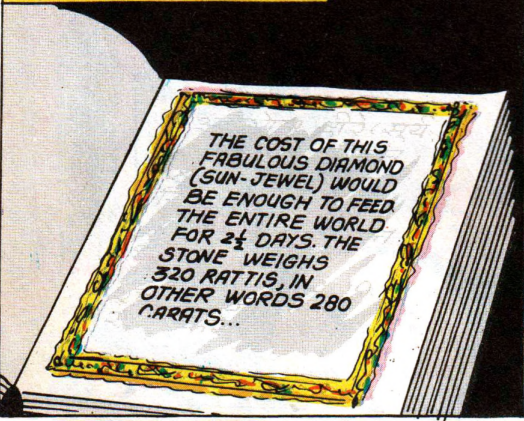

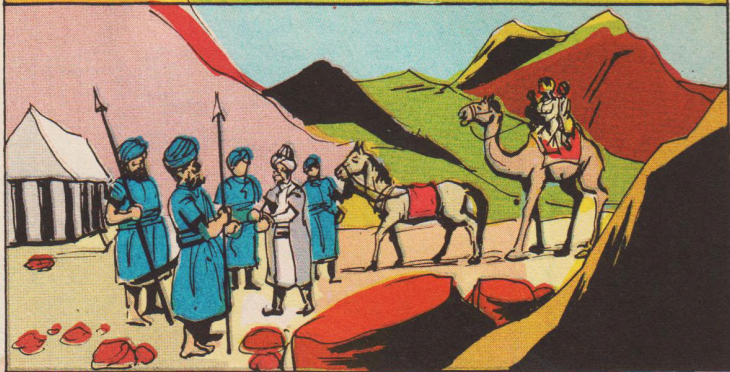

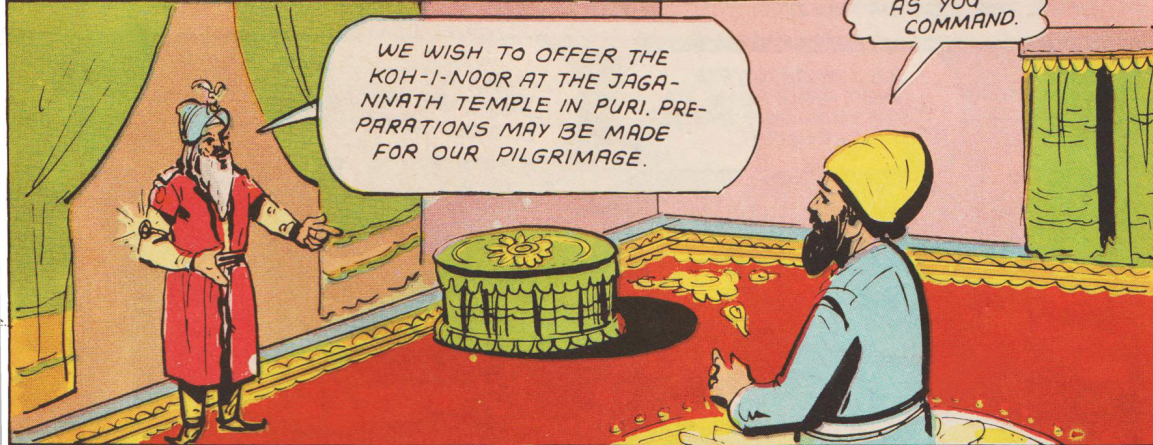
WAFI BEGUM PRESENTED THE KOH-I-NOOR DIAMOND TO MAHARAJ RANJIT SINGH.



THE LION OF PUNJAB BEGAN TO WEAR THE KOHINOOR AS AN ARM-BAND.



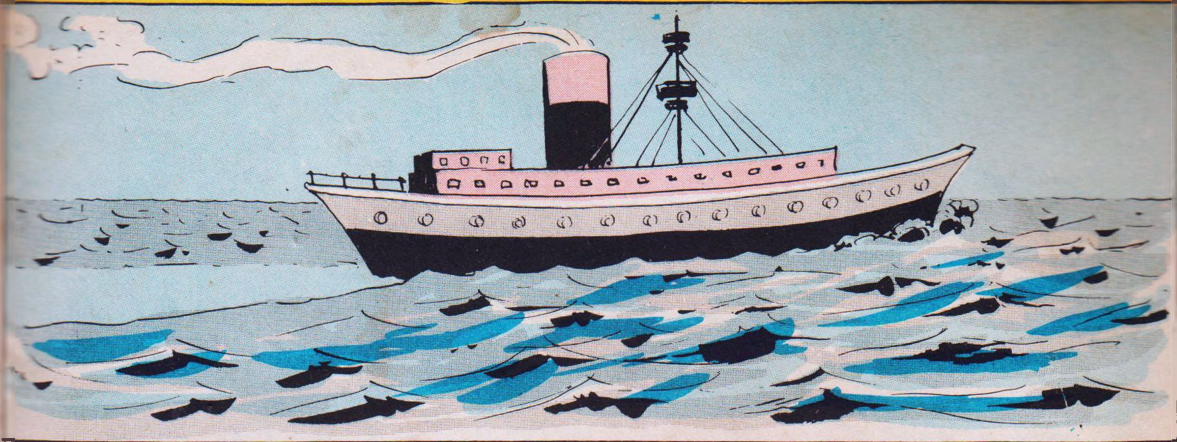
ONE DAY THE MAHARAJA MAD. AN ANNOUNCEMENT IN COURT—



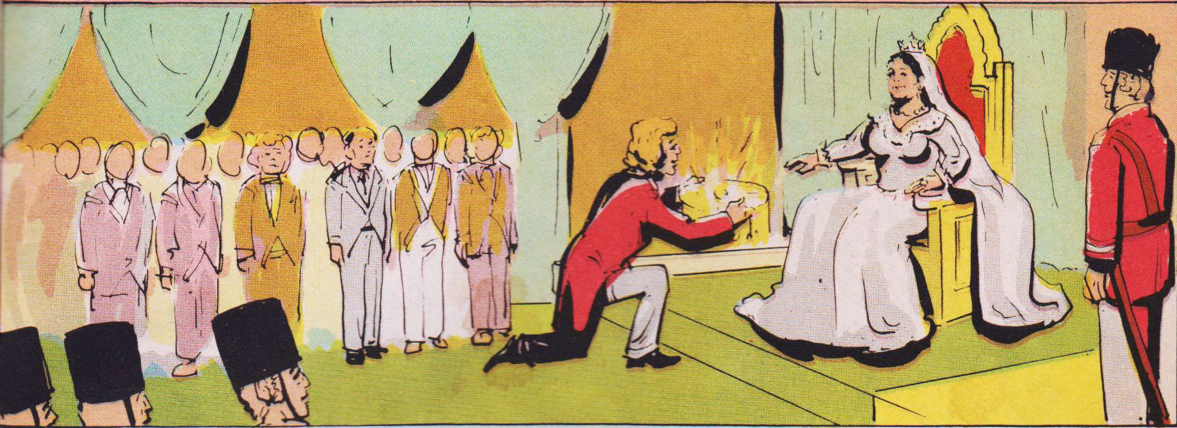

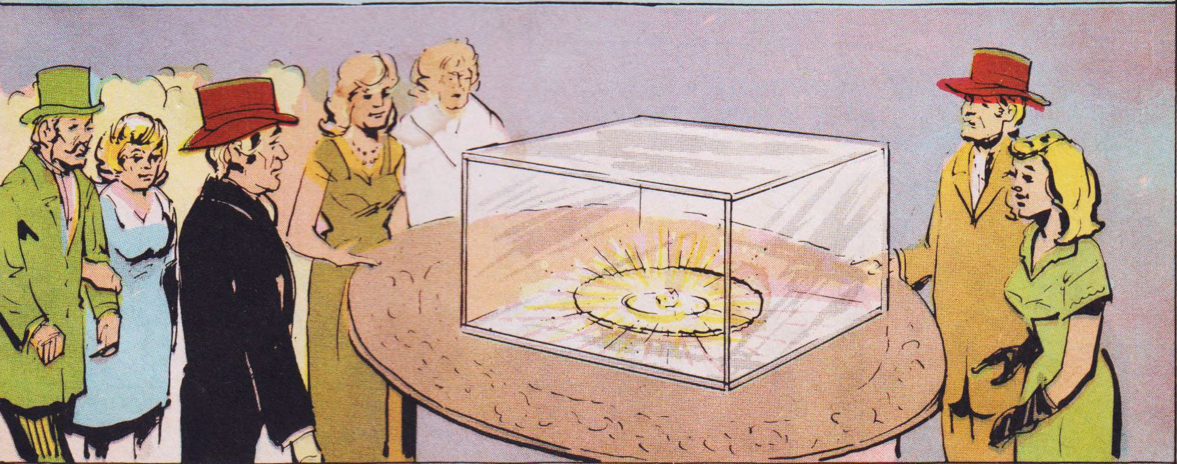

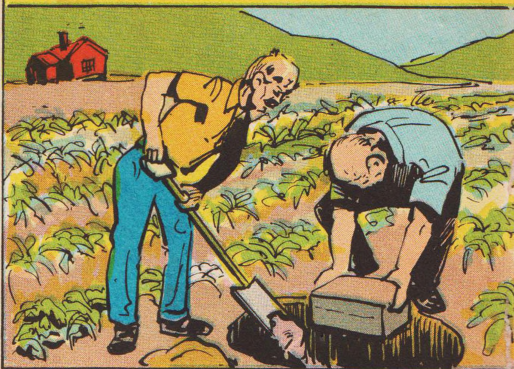
IN 1851 THE KOHINOOR WAS PUT ON DISPLAY AT A GREAT EXHIBITION IN LONDON.



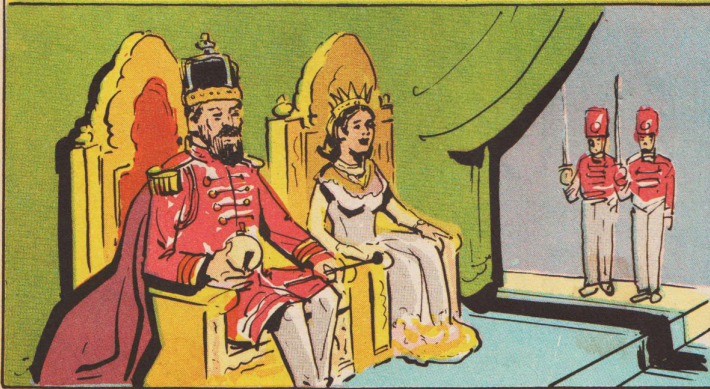
IN THE YEAR 1852 THE CRAFTSMEN AT AMSTERDAM CUT THE DIAMOND INTO A NEW SHAPE.



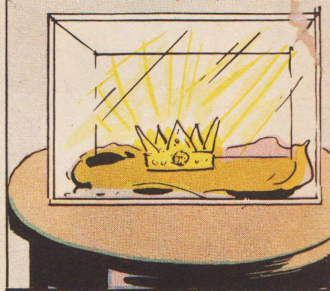

IN 1937 ON THE CORONATION OF GEORGE VI, THE KOHINOOR WAS SET IN THE CROWN OF HIS QUEEN.

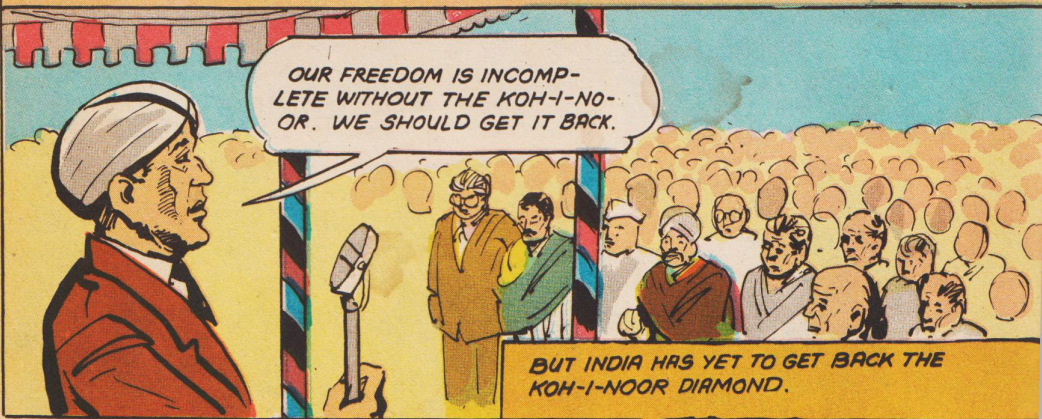


TILL TODAY THE KOHINOOR REMAINS IN THE BRITISH CROWN AT THE TOWER OF LONDON.
