



























AS LONG AS NADIRSHAH STAYED IN DELHI HE WAS CALLED EMPEROR ON 1st



THE LION OF PUNJAB BEGAN TO WEAR THE KOHINOOR AS AN ARM-BAND.






TILL THE END OF MARCH 1849 THE KOH-I-NOOR REMAINED WITH THE SIKH KULERS.

ON 3rd JULY 1880 AT A GRAND CEREMONY, THE PRICELESS KOH-I-NOOR DIAMOND WAS PRESENTED TO QUEEN VICTORIA.



IN 1851 THE KOHINOOR WAS PUT ON DISPLAY AT A GREAT EXHIBITION IN LONDON.



IN THE YEAR 1852 THE CRAFTSMEN AT AMSTERDAM CUT THE DIAMOND INTO A NEW SHAPE.



DURING THE SECOND WORLD WAR, FOR FEAR OF THE GERMANS, THE BRITISH HID THE KOHINOOR IN A POTATO FIELD.



IN 1937 ON THE CORONATION OF GEORGE VI., THE KOHI- NOOR WAS SET IN THE CROWN OF HIS QUEEN.



TILL TODAY THE KOHINOOR REMAINS IN THE BRITISH CROWN AT THE TOWER OF LONDON.
