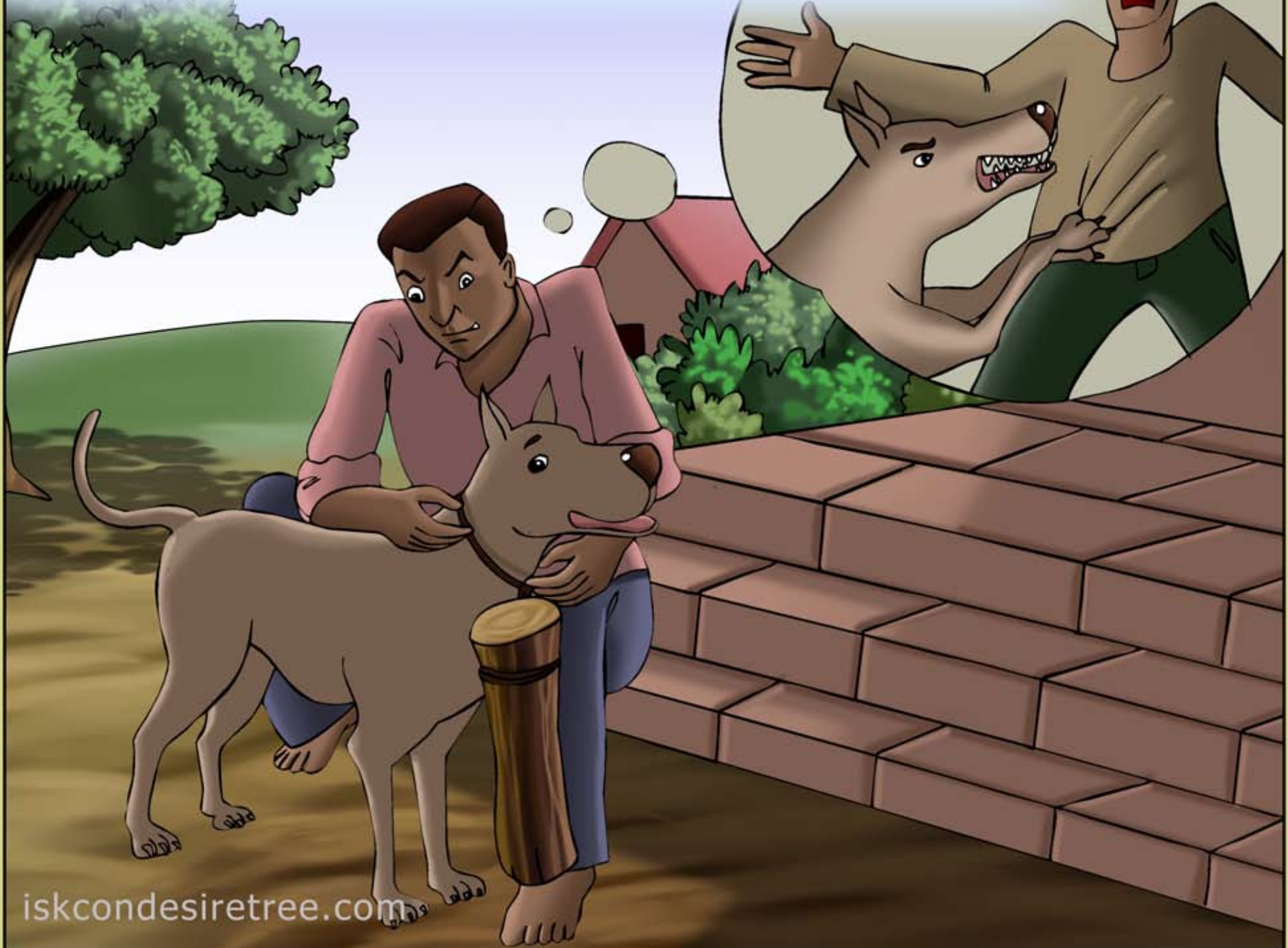


# THE MISCHIEVOUS DOG

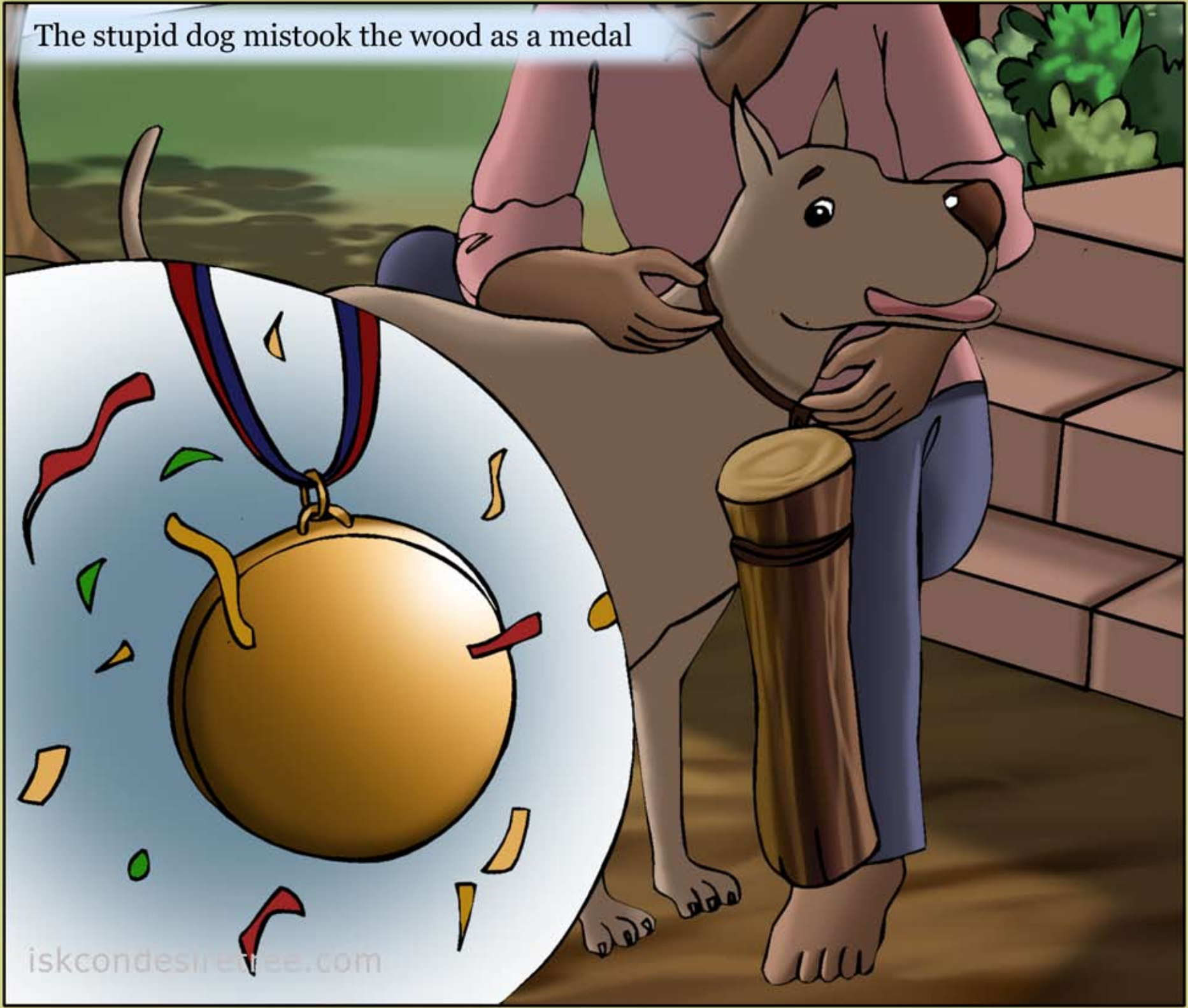


There was once a dog who was so mischievous that his master had to hang a heavy piece of wood around his neck to stop it biting people and chasing them
