

# *Thief in Vrindavan*

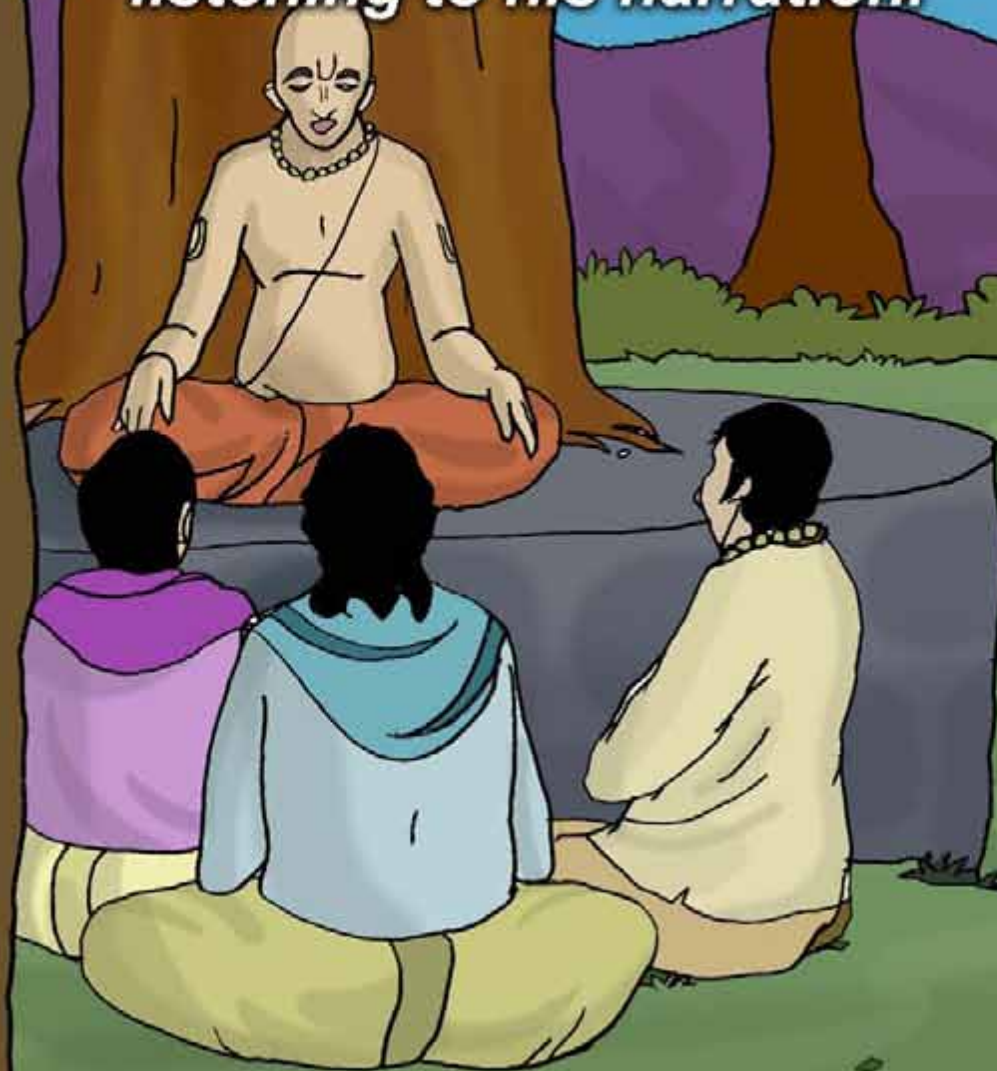

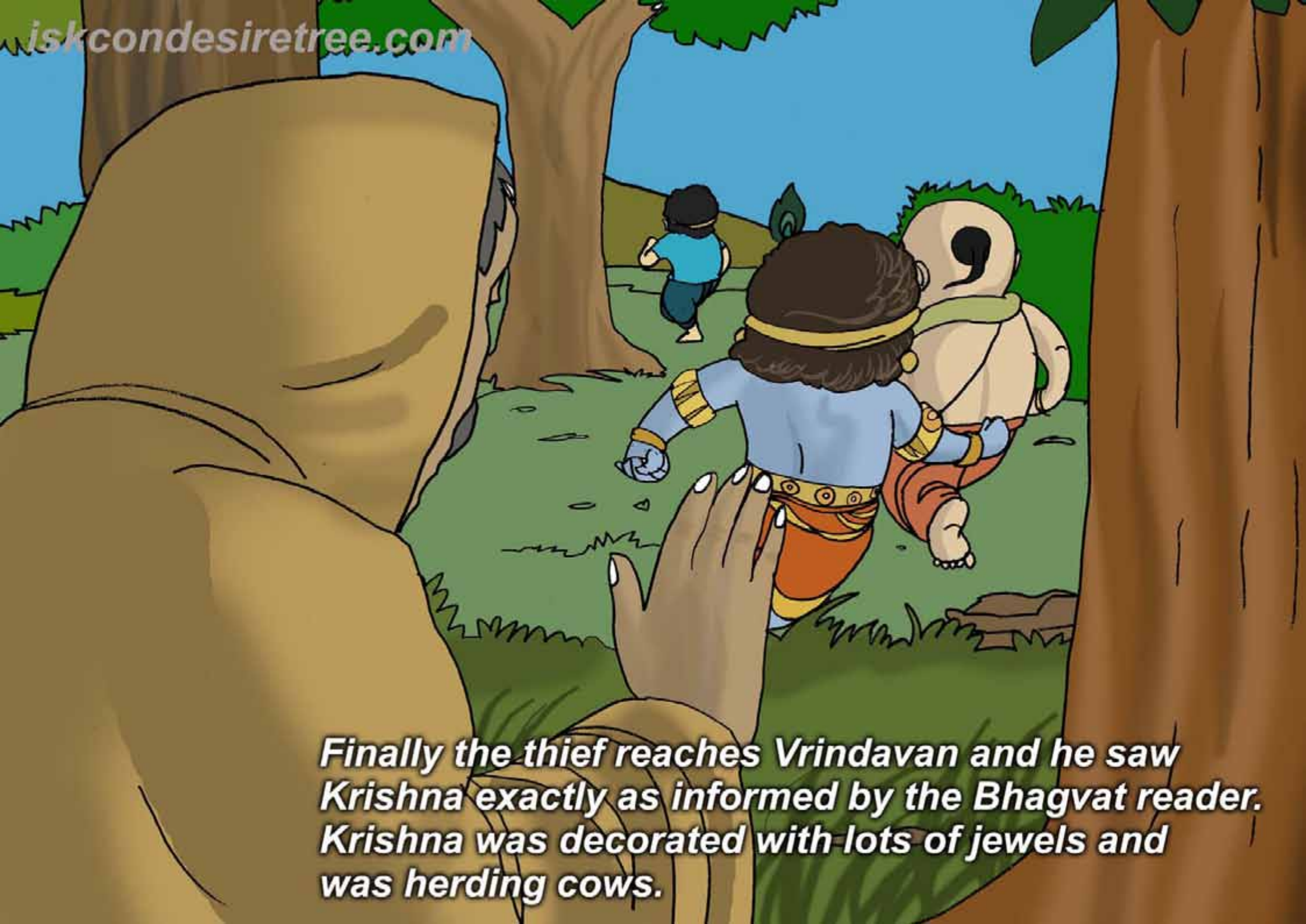
**Why not then go to Vrindavan and plunder this boy? He is in the forest with so many valuable jewels. I can catch the child and take all the jewels.**
